THIS REPORT IS BASED ON INDIVIDUAL REPORTS SUBMITTED BY PRIVATE EXPORTERS AND IDENTIFIES OUTSTANDING SALES AND ACCUMULATED EXPORTS OF SELECTED U.S. AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES. THE REPORT IS PUBLISHED WEEKLY, NORMALLY ON THURSDAY MORNING AT 8:30 A.M..

OUTSTANDING EXPORT SALES AS REPORTED AND COMPILED WITH OTHER DATA GIVE A SNAPSHOT VIEW OF THE CURRENT CONTRACTING SCENE. AT ANY GIVEN TIME IN THE COURSE OF A MARKETING YEAR, OUTSTANDING SALES DO NOT BEAR A CONSISTENT RELATIONSHIP TO EVENTUAL EXPORT SHIPMENTS. A MEANINGFUL EXPORT PROJECTION IS NOT OBTAINABLE BY SIMPLY ADDING OUTSTANDING SALES TO EXPORTS TO DATE. THE LATTER DATA, ALONE, PROVIDE A MORE RELIABLE MEASURE OF CURRENT EXPORT ACTIVITY THAN MAY BE DERIVED FROM A YEAR-TO-YEAR COMPARISON OF OUTSTANDING SALES.

THIS REPORT INCLUDES ALL COUNTRIES WITH OUTSTANDING SALES OR ACCUMULATED EXPORTS FOR EACH CLASS OF WHEAT, ALL WHEAT, WHEAT PRODUCTS, BARLEY, CORN, SORGHUM, SOYBEANS, SOYBEAN CAKE AND MEAL, SOYBEAN OIL, SUNFLOWERSEED OIL, AMERICAN PIMA COTTON, ALL UPLAND COTTON, ALL RICE, CATTLE HIDES AND SKINS, WET BLUES, BEEF, AND PORK. THE COUNTRY BREAKDOWN BY CLASSES FOR RICE AND COTTON CAN BE ACCESSED ON THE INTERNET.

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Export Sales Highlights

This summary is based on reports from exporters for the period March 16-22, 2018.

Wheat: Net sales of 353,800 metric tons for delivery in marketing year 2017/2018 were up 33 percent from the previous week and 40 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were for Japan (105,800 MT), Nigeria (76,200 MT, including decreases of 1,800 MT), Indonesia (49,600 MT, including decreases of 400 MT), the United Arab Emirates (36,000 MT, including 33,000 MT switched from unknown destinations), and Algeria (31,800 MT, including 30,000 MT switched from unknown destinations). Reductions were primarily reported for unknown destinations (11,000 MT), Ecuador (3,500 MT), and Guatemala (1,300 MT). For 2018/2019, net sales of 121,800 MT were reported for South Korea (77,700 MT), the Philippines (22,000 MT), unknown destinations (21,800 MT), and Nigeria (1,800 MT), were partially offset by reductions for Honduras (1,500 MT). Exports of 328,700 MT were down 31 percent from the previous week and 12 percent from the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were to Japan (59,800 MT), Mexico (46,800 MT), the United Arab Emirates (36,000 MT), Algeria (31,300 MT), and Venezuela (30,000 MT).

Corn: Net sales of 1,353,100 MT for 2017/2018 were down 8 percent from the previous week and 28 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were reported for South Korea (623,100 MT, including 255,000 MT switched from unknown destinations and decreases of 68,300 MT), Mexico (208,000 MT, including decreases of 64,600 MT), Japan (183,400 MT, including 36,000 MT switched from unknown destinations and decreases 4,700 MT), Peru (147,000 MT, including 38,000 MT switched from unknown destinations and decreases of 3,300 MT), and Colombia (102,300 MT, including 90,000 MT switched from unknown destinations and decreases of 100 MT). Reductions were reported for unknown destinations (283,200 MT), Spain (4,000 MT), Costa Rica (1,500 MT), and Guatemala (800 MT). For 2018/2019, net sales of 287,000 MT were primarily reported for Japan (207,000 MT) and Mexico (76,100 MT). Exports of 1,376,100 MT were unchanged from the previous week, but up 8 percent from the prior 4-week average. The destinations were primarily to Mexico (294,500 MT), South Korea (255,300 MT), Japan (195,400 MT), Colombia (154,500 MT), and Vietnam (136,500 MT).

Optional Origin Sales: For 2017/2018, new optional origin sales of 68,000 MT were reported for South Korea. Options were exercised to export 133,000 MT to unknown destinations (67,000 MT) and Vietnam (66,000 MT) from the United States. The current optional origin outstanding balance of 781,000 MT is for South Korea (482,000 MT), unknown destinations (179,000 MT), and Vietnam (120,000 MT).

Barley: Net sales reductions of 14,900 MT--a marketing-year low-- were down noticeably from the previous week and from the prior 4-week average. Increases for South Korea (700 MT) and Taiwan (500 MT) were more than offset by reductions for Canada (16,100 MT). Exports of 100 MT were reported to Taiwan.

Sorghum: Net sales of 19,300 MT for 2017/2018 resulted as increases for China (70,300 MT, including 66,000 MT switched from unknown destinations and decreases of 4,800 MT) and Japan (36,000 MT), were partially offset by reductions for unknown destinations (87,000 MT). Exports of 211,700 MT were down 15 percent from the previous week, but up 5 percent from the prior 4-week average. The destinations were China (201,100 MT) and Japan (10,600 MT).

Rice: Net sales of 77,600 MT for 2017/2018 were up 1 percent from the previous week and 12 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were reported for Japan (26,000 MT), Honduras (15,900 MT), El Salvador (12,400 MT), Saudi Arabia (9,900 MT), and Mexico (7,200 MT). For 2018/2019, net sales of 7,500 MT were reported for Honduras. Exports of 22,600 MT were down 67 percent from the previous week and 70 percent from the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were Saudi Arabia (9,900 MT), Mexico (3,100 MT), Japan (2,100 MT), Canada (2,100 MT), and South Korea (1,500 MT).

Soybeans: Net sales of 317,500 MT for 2017/2018 were down 58 percent from the previous week and 77 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were reported for the Netherlands (113,600 MT, including 66,000 MT switched from unknown destinations and decreases of 9,000 MT), Indonesia (106,500 MT, including 75,000 MT switched from unknown destinations), South Korea (51,400 MT, including 50,000 MT switched from unknown destinations), and Egypt (42,800 MT, including 36,900 MT switched from unknown destinations and decreases of 400 MT). Reductions were reported for unknown destinations (244,000 MT). For 2018/2019, net sales of 69,700 MT were reported for China (60,000 MT), Thailand (6,000 MT), Japan (2,900 MT), and South Korea (800 MT). Exports of 782,900 MT were up 43 percent from the previous week, but down 7 percent from the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were China (139,600 MT), the Netherlands (113,600 MT), Indonesia (111,800 MT), Mexico (101,700 MT), and Egypt (92,800 MT).

Export for Own Account: The current outstanding balance of 12,200 MT is for Canada.

Soybean Cake and Meal: Net sales of 184,100 MT for 2017/2018 were down 5 percent from the previous week, but up 4 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were reported for Vietnam (50,000 MT), Morocco (43,500 MT, including 15,000 MT switched from unknown destinations), Indonesia (33,200 MT, including 27,100 MT switched from unknown destinations), Thailand (21,400 MT, switched from unknown destinations), and Canada (12,300 MT). Reductions were primarily reported for Egypt (9,000 MT), Israel (8,000 MT), and Guatemala (6,900 MT). Exports of 286,600 MT were up 94 percent from the previous week and 15 percent from the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were Colombia (69,900 MT), the Philippines (49,400 MT), Indonesia (32,500 MT), Vietnam (19,500 MT), and Canada (19,000 MT).

Soybean Oil: Net sales of 34,600 MT were down 5 percent from the previous week, but up 17 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were reported for Malaysia (15,000 MT), unknown destinations (9,000 MT), South Korea (8,000 MT), and Mexico (2,000 MT). Reductions were reported for the Dominican Republic (200 MT). Exports of 30,400 MT were up noticeably from the previous week and up 82 percent from the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were the Dominican Republic (10,200 MT), Cuba (7,600 MT), Colombia (6,800 MT), and Mexico (5,200 MT).

Cotton: Net sales of 304,300 running bales for 2017/2018 were down 10 percent from the previous week and 9 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were reported for Vietnam (96,100 RB, including 400 RB switched from Japan and decreases of 900 RB), Indonesia (82,600 RB, including 900 RB switched from Japan, 300 RB switched from China, and decreases of 500 RB), China (33,900 RB, including 13,200 RB switched from Turkey, 900 RB switched from Hong Kong, and decreases of 2,200 RB), Thailand (21,200 RB, including 300 RB switched from Japan and decreases of 100 RB), and Bangladesh (17,700 RB). Reductions were reported primarily for Mexico (3,400 RB), India (3,300 RB), and Japan (2,800 RB). For 2018/2019, net sales of 62,100 RB were primarily for Thailand (25,100 RB), China (15,400 RB), and Vietnam (10,100 RB). Exports of 438,400 RB were up 3 percent from the previous week and 7 percent from the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were Vietnam (79,700 RB), China (58,500 RB), Turkey (57,400 RB), Pakistan (42,100 RB), and Indonesia (41,900 RB). Net sales of Pima totaling 5,200 RB for 2017/2018 were up 28 percent from the previous week, but down 20 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were primarily reported for China (2,000 RB), Peru (1,000 RB), and India (1,000 RB). For 2018/2019, net sales of 1,600 RB were reported for India. Exports of 14,800 RB were down 25 percent from the previous week and 30 percent from the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were India (6,700 RB), China (4,400 RB), Peru (2,100 RB), and Indonesia (1,000 RB).

Optional Origin Sales: For 2017/2018, the current optional origin outstanding balance is 16,500 RB, all Indonesia.

Exports for Own Account: New exports for own account totaling 1,400 RB were reported to Indonesia. Exports to Indonesia (100 RB) were applied to new or outstanding sales. The current outstanding balance of 20,300 RB is for Vietnam (10,300 RB), Indonesia (5,700 RB), China (3,800 RB), and Bangladesh (500 RB).

Hides and Skins: Net sales of 561,500 pieces reported for 2018 were up noticeably from the previous week and up 76 percent from the prior 4-week average. Whole cattle hide sales totaling 538,600 pieces were primarily for China (372,800 pieces, including decreases of 10,100 pieces and 122,200 pieces late reporting), South Korea (65,600 pieces,

including decreases of 3,300 pieces), Thailand (35,400 pieces, including decreases of 66,300 pieces), Mexico (28,800 pieces, including decreases of 6,400 pieces), and Taiwan (11,000 pieces, including decreases of 100 pieces). Exports of 478,600 pieces, all whole cattle hides, were up 45 percent from the previous week and 35 percent from the prior 4-week average. Exports were primarily to China (285,500 pieces, including 98,900 pieces late reporting), South Korea (104,300 pieces), Thailand (41,500 pieces), Mexico (25,600 pieces), and Taiwan (5,800 pieces).

Net sales of 208,500 wet blues for 2018 were up noticeably from the previous week and from the prior 4-week average. Increases were reported for China (101,600 unsplit and 3,900 grain splits), Italy (71,800 unsplit and 1,800 grain splits), Vietnam (21,200 unsplit), and Mexico (5,600 grain splits and 100 unsplit). Reductions were reported for Hong Kong (100 grain splits and 100 unsplit). Exports of 156,600 wet blues for 2018 were up noticeably from the previous week and up 40 percent from the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were China (48,300 unsplit and 3,800 grain splits), Italy (40,000 unsplit and 5,200 grain splits), Vietnam (19,200 unsplit), Hong Kong (8,400 grain splits and 3,100 unsplit), and Mexico (7,600 grain splits and 3,300 unsplit). Net sales reductions of splits totaling 1,400 pounds for 2018 resulted as increases for China (10,200 pounds), were more offset by reductions for Vietnam (11,600 pounds). Exports of 259,000 pounds were down 61 percent from the previous week and 34 percent from the prior 4-week average. The destinations were Vietnam (197,000 pounds), China (50,000 pounds), and South Korea (12,000 pounds).

Beef: Net sales of 23,600 MT for 2018 were up noticeably from the previous week and up 40 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were primarily for Japan (11,400 MT, including decreases of 1,900 MT), South Korea (6,000 MT, including decreases of 300 MT), Hong Kong (3,200 MT, including decreases of 200 MT), Mexico (900 MT), and Canada (700 MT, including decreases of 200 MT). Reductions were reported for the Republic of South Africa (100 MT). Exports of 15,600 MT were down 7 percent from the previous week and 2 percent from the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were Japan (5,100 MT), South Korea (3,600 MT), Hong Kong (1,900 MT), Mexico (1,600 MT), and Taiwan (1,100 MT).

Pork: Net sales of 19,600 MT for 2018 were up 1 percent from the previous week, but down 16 percent from the prior 4-week average. Increases were reported for Mexico (7,500 MT), South Korea (5,100 MT), Japan (2,200 MT), Australia (900 MT), and Canada (800 MT). Exports of 24,200 MT were unchanged from the previous week, but up 2 percent from the prior 4-week average. The primary destinations were Mexico (8,700 MT), South Korea (4,600 MT), Japan (3,700 MT), Colombia (1,300 MT), and Hong Kong (1,300 MT).
