


SOUTH FORK SALMON RIVER ROAD REHABILITATION PROJECT—September 23—27



The Payette and Boise National Forests are rehabilitating the South Fork Salmon River Road (FS Road 474/674)



Multiple closure points will occur throughout the week as paving is taking place. If paving goes as planned, this will be the last week of work for this fall. Operations will shut down for the winter and resume next spring.

Closures are: Monday closed from MP 11 to MP 17; Tuesday closed from MP 4 to MP 7; Wednesday closed from MP 3 to MP 5; Thursday closed at MP 3. No closures over the weekends. Access to all sites along the river will remain open, but the route to reach those sites will be determined by the point closure locations. Refer to the map for daily closure locations.

Please use the map to determine the daily closure locations and the best route to reach designations along the South Fork Salmon River Road.

Closures are:

Monday closed from MP 11 to MP 17;

Tuesday closed from MP 7 to MP 4

Wednesday closed from MP 3 to MP 5

Thursday closed at MP 3

Friday—to be determined. AN update will be set out once this information is received.

Access to all sites along the river will remain open, but the route to reach those sites will be determined by the point closure locations. Refer to the map for daily closure locations.



WHAT WORK IS BEING DONE?

The purpose of the project is the repair asphalt, surface drainage, and subgrade issues. Roadway safety will also be improved by curve realignments and conducting fill slope repairs.

- Works is being done on the Boise and the Payette National Forest sections of the road.
- Construction is expected to go into the spring and summer of 2020, with a winter shutdown.
