



#### ACE Collections Release 6 - Refunds

ACE Collections Release 6 Refunds will **enhance the refunds management workflow** and provide the ability to search, create, and certify/approve refunds. This release **will include all refunds** (ex. Manual refunds, Drawback AP refunds, SEACATS refunds, and Liquidation refunds). This release will also contain funds certification to ensure the availability of funds. Members of the trade will be able to view their refund details in ACE Reports.



# **Release 6 Refunds Impact**

On August 27, 2022, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) will deploy Collections Release 6 to the Automated Commercial Environment (ACE). This release will impact CBP and trade community users. For users in the trade community, this release will:

- Provide visibility into refund history within ACE Reports starting with refunds issued after August 29, 2022.
  - The Trade community will be able to access their Trade Refund Report through the ACE Secure Data Portal.
  - The Trade Refund Report provides Importers with insights into CBP refunds once they have been processed and send to Treasury.
- Automated Clearinghouse (ACH) refunds will no longer override the 4811 on file when an Importer is signed up for ACH refunds.
- No changes to refund timelines.
- No updates to the CATAIR.

# Release 6 How to Apply for an ACE Secure Data Portal Account

## **Please Note**

- Before gaining access to ACE Reports, you need to apply for an ACE Secure Data
  Portal account using the web address: <a href="https://www.cbp.gov/trade/automated/getting-started/portal-applying">https://www.cbp.gov/trade/automated/getting-started/portal-applying</a>
- Your ACE Reports access will be automatically provisioned once you have an ACE Portal account.
- Once you have an ACE Portal account, access ACE Reports, by logging into the ACE Secure Data Portal <a href="https://ace.cbp.dhs.gov">https://ace.cbp.dhs.gov</a>, and selecting the Reports icon from the top right toolbar
