**SUBJECT:** Notice of Centralized Examination Station Applications Received and Invitation to Submit Comments

**PURPOSE:**

To advise the public of applications received from potential operators of a Centralized Examination Station (CES) for the Port of Miami International Airport, Miami, Florida, and to invite the public to submit any relevant written comments.

**BACKGROUND:**

On September 24, 2025, Miami International Airport issued Information Bulletin MTFO 25-TO-004, announcing that applications for operating a CES would be accepted in accordance with the procedures set forth in 19 CFR § 118.2.

The 60-day application period for submission of applications ended on November 23, 2025. Four (4) applications were received. Pursuant to 19 CFR § 118.12, the port director is hereby advising the public of the applications received and inviting comments regarding the applications.
