The Seventh Coast Guard District is one of nine district offices nationwide and has responsibility for all Coast Guard operations in South Carolina, Georgia, the Florida Peninsula, Puerto Rico and the entire Caribbean basin, which includes Puerto Rico, the U.S. Virgin Islands and 32 other countries and territories. This encompasses an area of 1.8 million square miles and includes the largest concentration of cutters and aircraft in the Coast Guard. D7 handles one-quarter of all Coast guard search and rescue cases and two-thirds of all law enforcement cases. D7 includes eight of the nation's largest container ports and the three largest multi-day cruise ports in the world: Port Miami; Port Everglades; and Port Canaveral and three Space Ports.
