



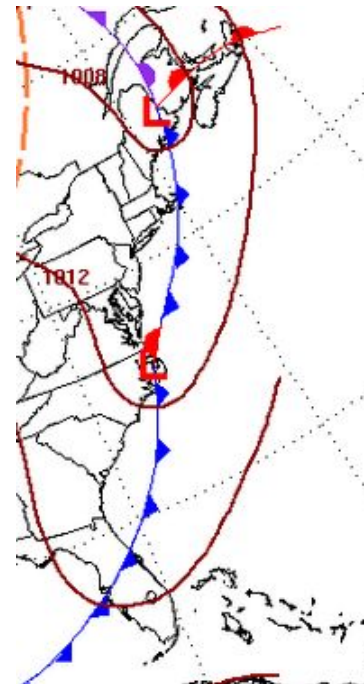
Area to Watch

KEY MESSAGES:

- A cold front is expected to move off the eastern seaboard next Wednesday.
- While no hazards are currently expected, this area should be watched. S to SW flow ahead of the cold front could produce gusts to gale force, mainly in the vicinity of thunderstorms. Otherwise winds to 25 kt are expected.
