Protect your organization from intentional or unintentional data loss

An accidental insider threat is unintentional loss caused by honest mistakes such as being tricked, procedural errors, or a degree of negligence. Being the victim of an email phishing attack is an accidental insider threat!



Be sure to notify your IT security professional immediately if you experience intentional or accidental data loss. Protect your patient's protected health information and do not give out information unless you have *thoroughly* identified the requestor's identity!
