CISA is partnering with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Center for Prevention Programs and Partnerships (CP3) on March 19, 2024 to educate first responders on how to apply to the Targeted Violence and Terrorism Prevention (TVTP) grant program to develop prevention capabilities in their community. CP3 released a forecasted funding opportunity for the Fiscal Year 2024 TVTP Grant Program. Prospective applicants are encouraged to use this forecast and application guidance to begin to register and maintain their accounts with the required grants systems, find project partners, and draft their applications for this anticipated funding opportunity.

Anticipated Award Announcement: September 2024
