- Below normal temperatures NE States
- Red Flag Warnings: CA, NV, UT, AZ, CO, NM, KS, WY & AK
- Critical Fire Weather Areas: CA, NM, NV, CO, UT & AZ
- Space Weather: No space weather storms observed or predicted



Atlantic – Tropical Outlook






Atlantic – Tropical Depression Two As of 2:00 a.m. EDT

- Located 85 miles NNE of Coatzacoalcos, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 9 mph
- A turn toward the W with decrease speed expected Thursday
- Center will move over the coast of Veracruz Thursday morning
- Max sustained winds 35 mph, with higher gusts
- Expected to become a tropical storm prior to landfill
- No threat to U.S.









Eastern Pacific – Tropical Outlook





Central Pacific – Tropical Outlook





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
Western Pacific-Tropical Storm 04W (Leepi)







- Closest point of approach to Kadena is 161 miles at 10:00 am EDT on June 20




National Weather Forecast






Active Watches/Warnings





Precipitation Forecast Days 1-3






River Forecast – 7 Day






Convective Outlooks Days 1-3






Critical Fire Weather Areas Days 1 - 8






U.S. Wildland Fire Preparedness Levels



National Preparedness Level: 2

Description: Several Geographic Areas are experiencing high to extreme fire danger. Wildland fire activity is increasing and large fires are occurring in one or more Geographic Areas. Minimal mobilization of resources from other Geographic Areas is occurring. There is moderate commitment of national resources with the potential to mobilize additional resources from other Geographic Areas.
