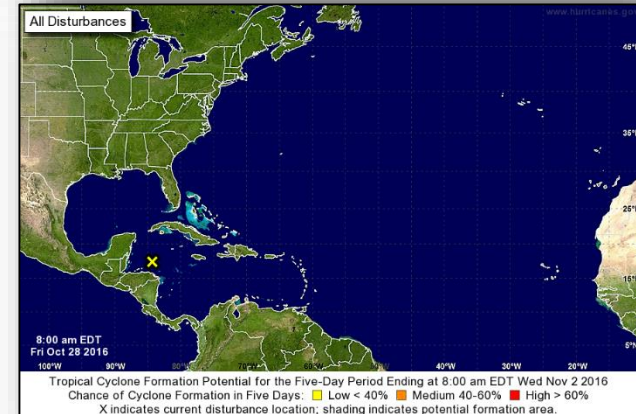
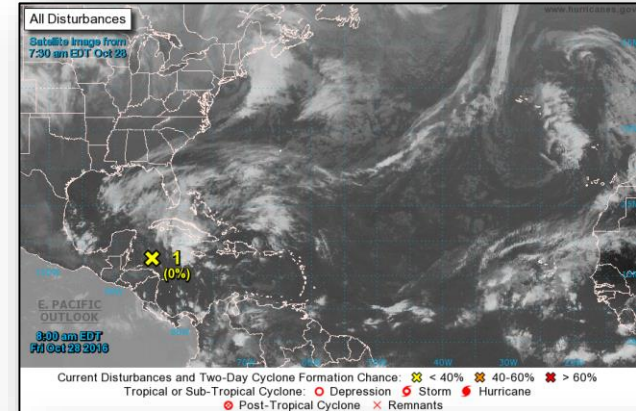

Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located over the northwestern Caribbean Sea; about 100 miles N of the coast of Honduras
- Moving little over the next few days
- Development not expected due to strong upper-level winds
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (near 0%)



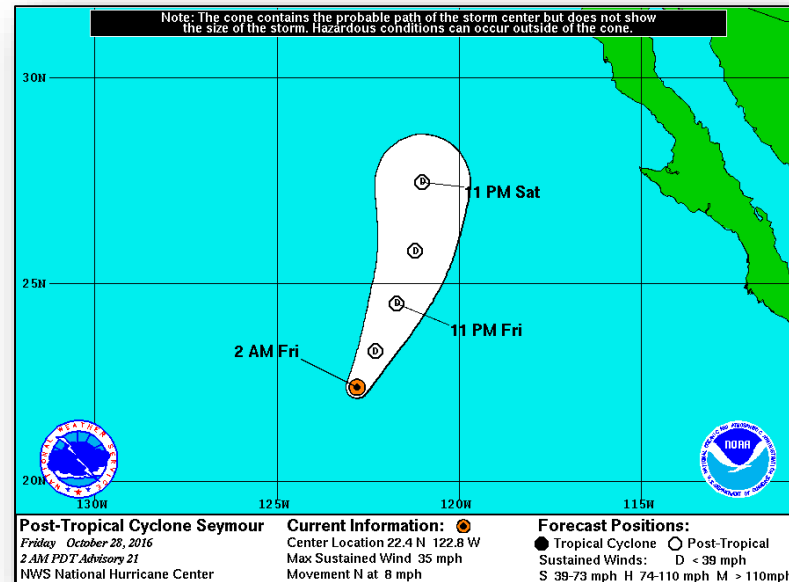
Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



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Post-Tropical Cyclone Seymour (Advisory #21 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

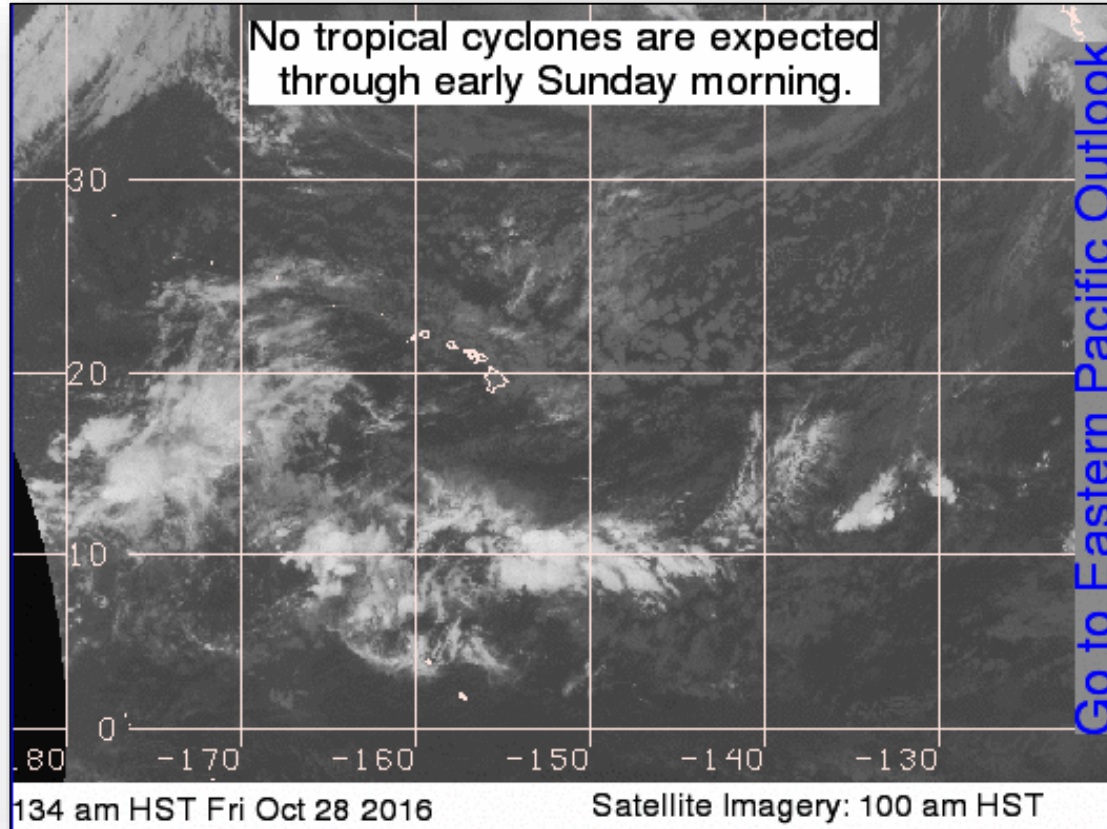
- Located 820 miles W of southern tip of Baja California
- Moving N at 8 mph
- NNE motion expected to begin later today and continue into Saturday
- Maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- Continued weakening is forecast
- Likely to dissipate by Sunday
- No coastal watches or warnings in effect

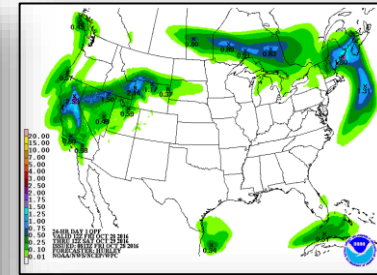
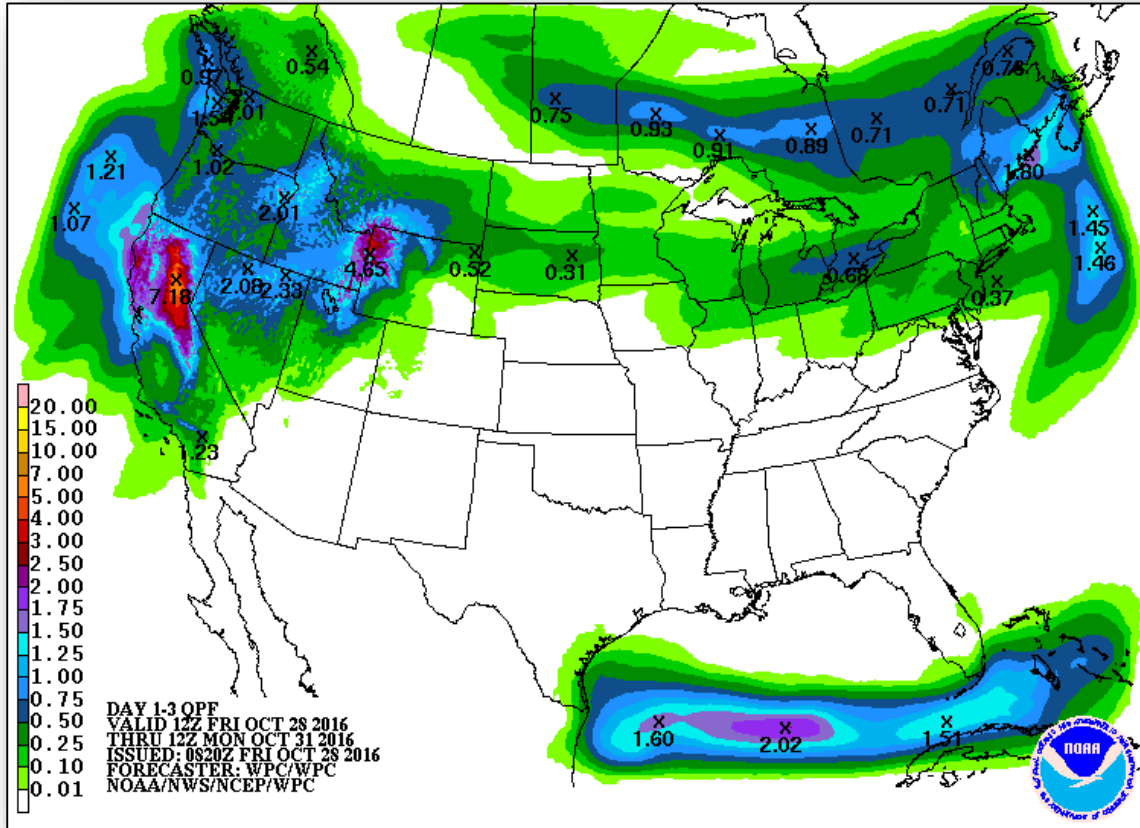
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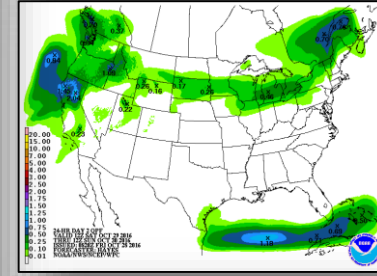
Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3



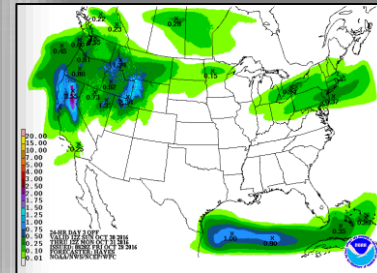

U.S. Drought Monitor

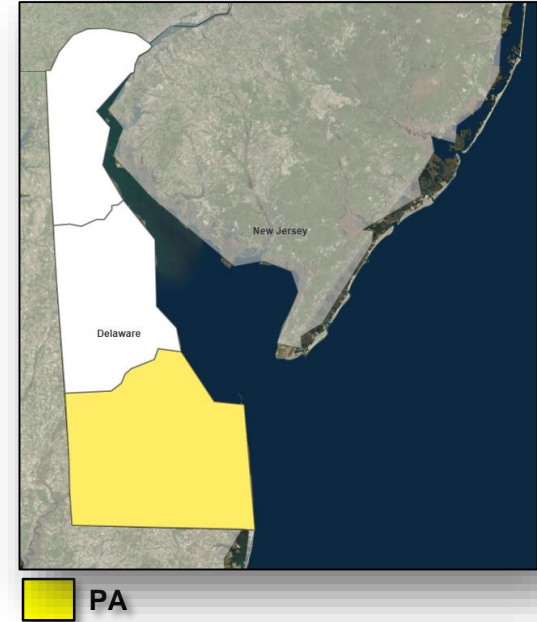


Declaration Request
