- Space Weather – Past 24 hours: none observed; next 24 hours: none predicted

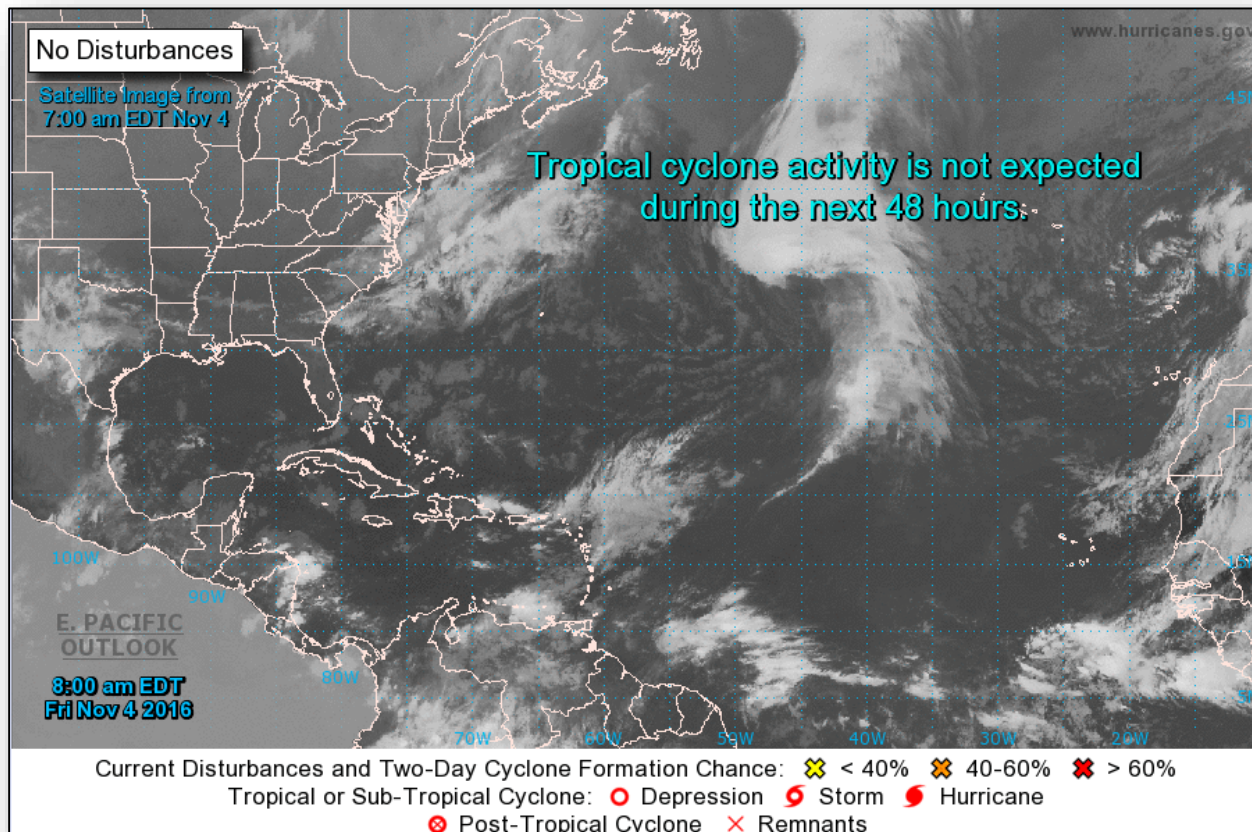

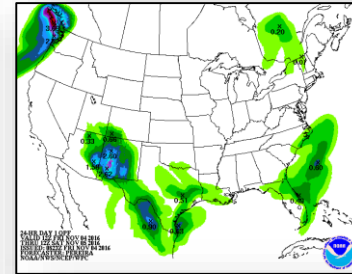
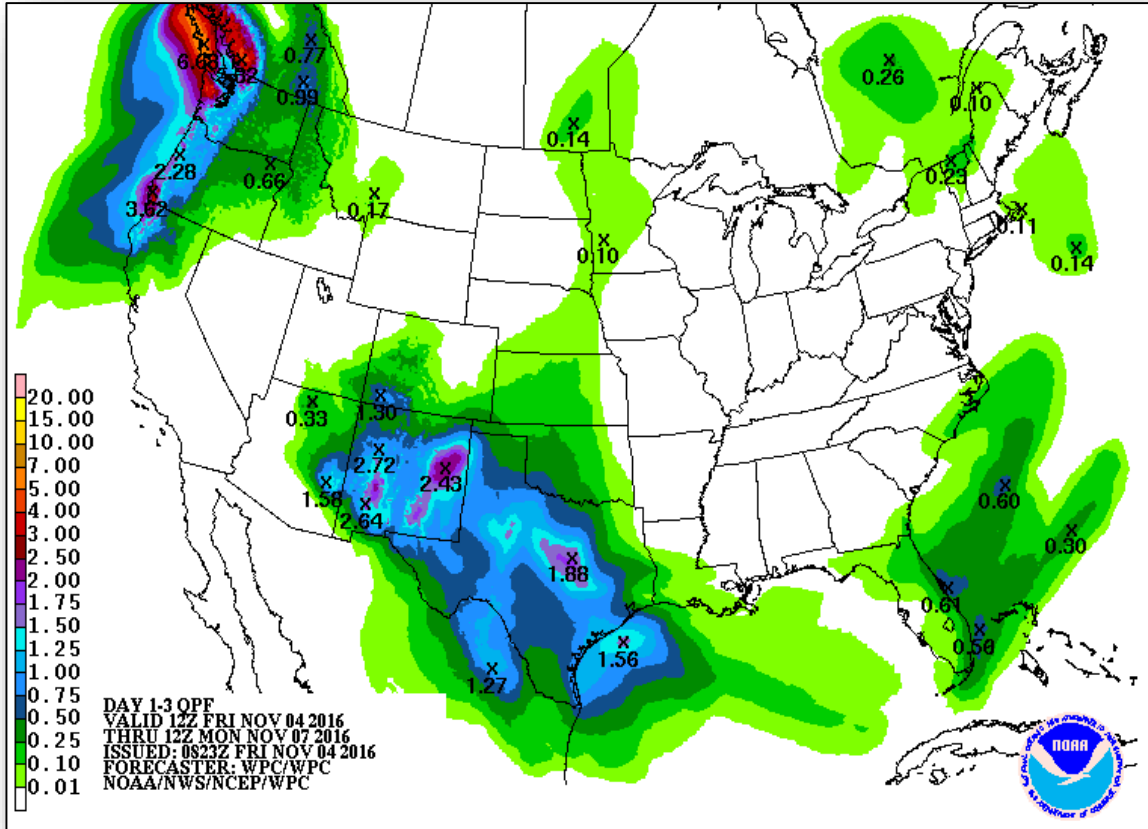
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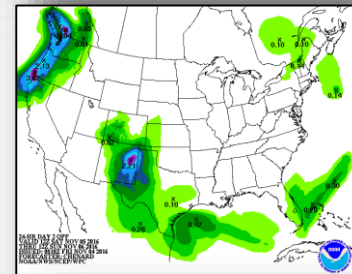
# Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3



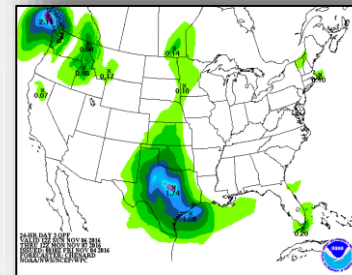
