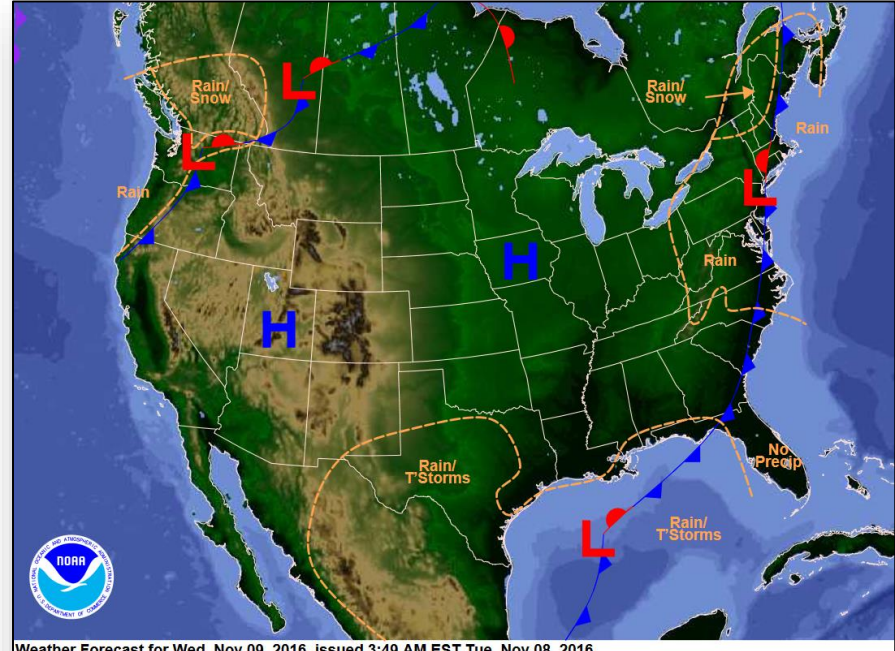


National Weather Forecast

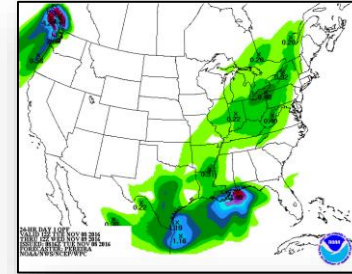
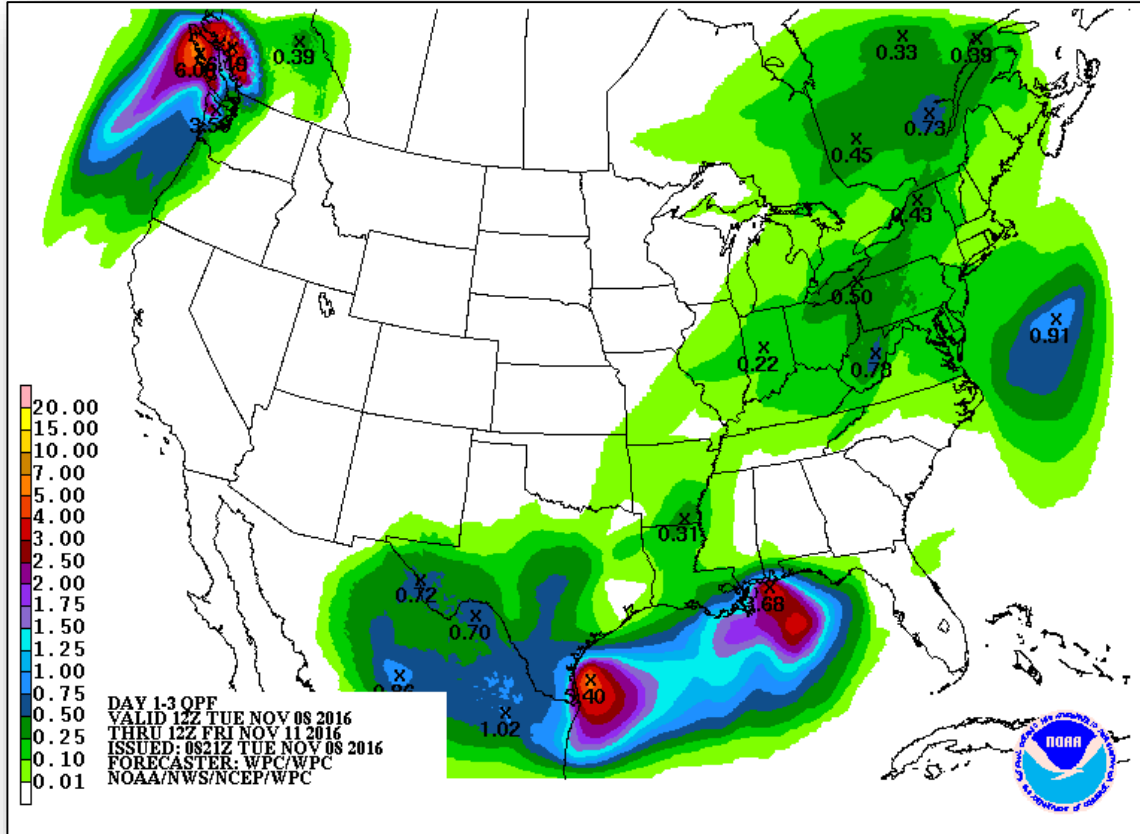

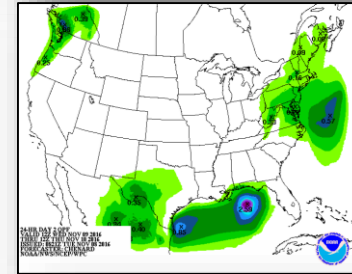
Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3



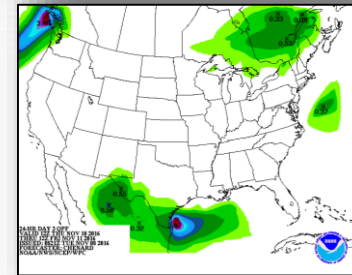

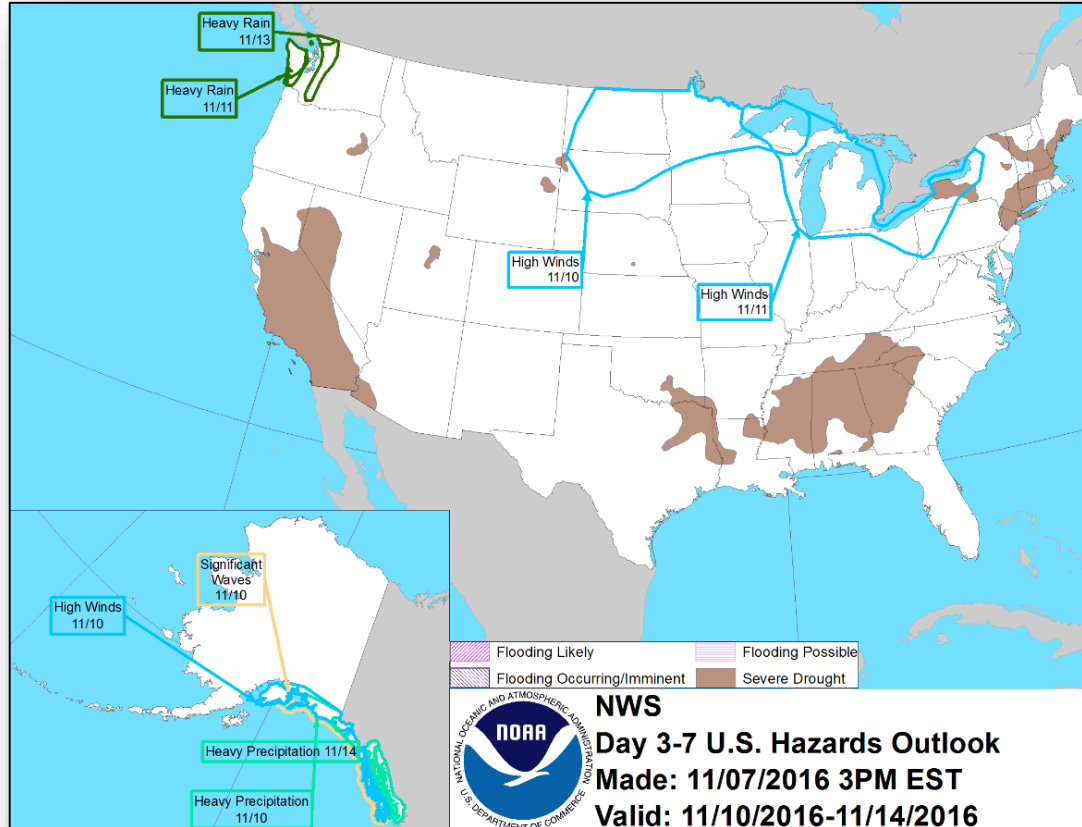

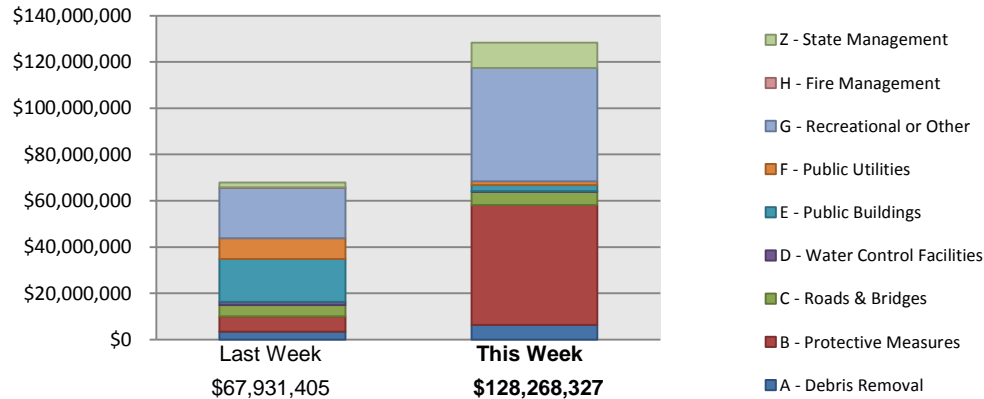

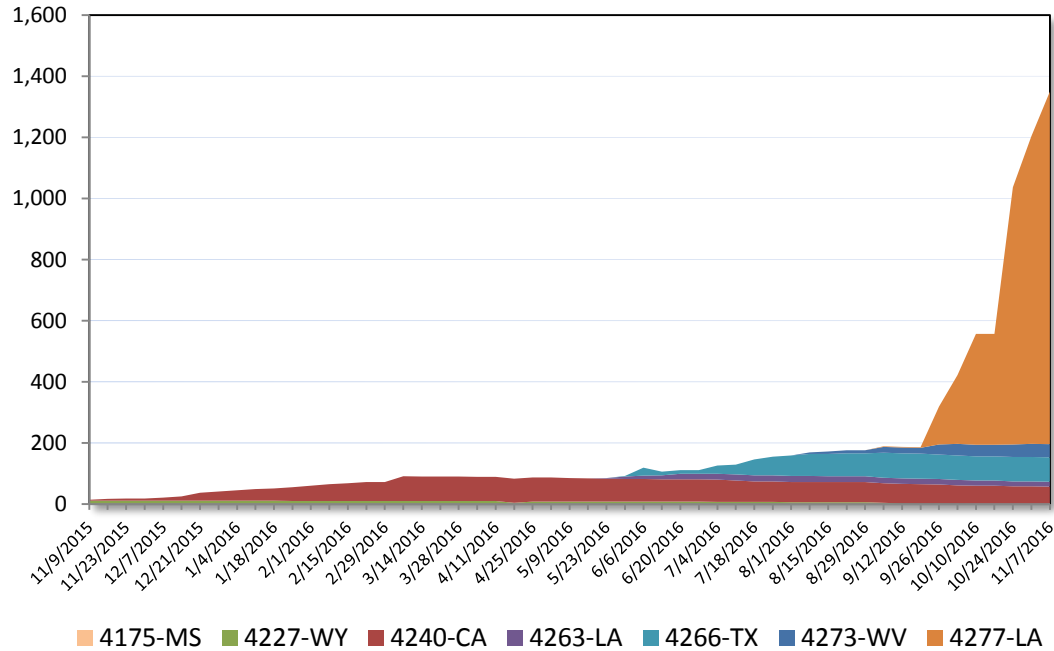

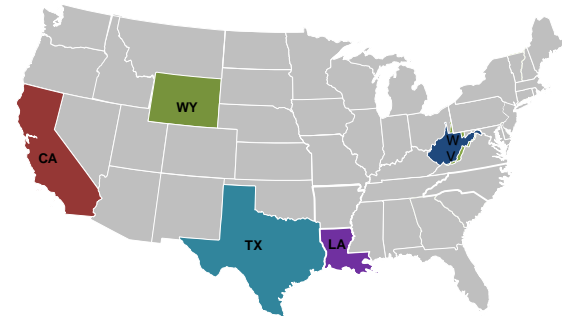

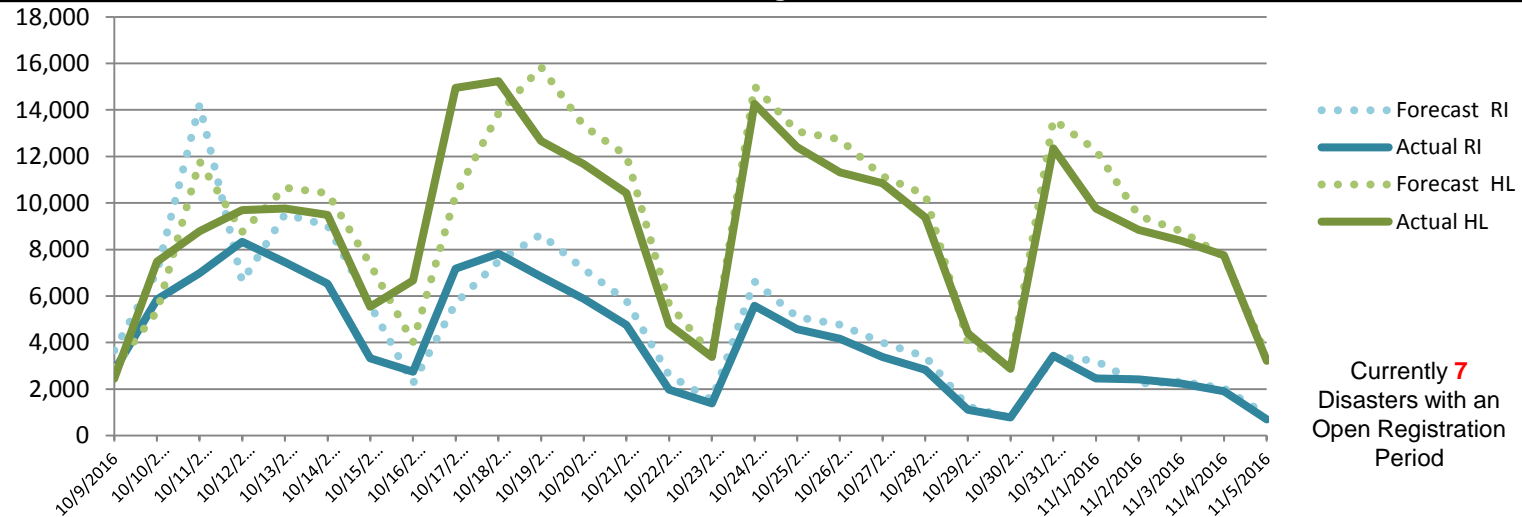

NPSC Call Forecasting and Actual Calls Over the Past 4 Weeks 10/02/2016 through 10/29/2016



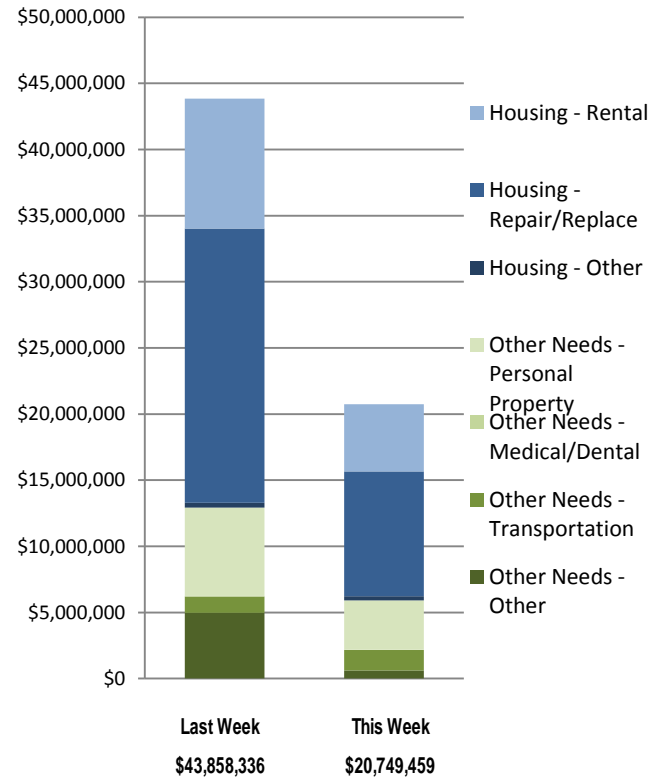
