- Space Weather Past 24 hours: no space weather storms observed; next 24 hours: Minor, G1 geomagnetic storms likely





### Tropical Outlook – Atlantic








#### Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific




#### Disturbance 1 (as of 7:00 a.m. EST)

#### Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific






#### Tropical Outlook – Western Pacific




#### Tropical Depression 28W (Warning #6 as of 4:00 a.m. EST) - FINAL


- Located 214 miles NW of Pohnpei, Federated States of Micronesia (FSM)










#### Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3











6 - 10 Day Temperature Probability




6 - 10 Day Precipitation Probability





#### **Current Situation**

- Fires began on November 5, 2016 and is burning in and around communities of Lake Lure, Chimney Rock and Shumont (pop 3,210)
- Mandatory evacuations in effect for 780 residents
- 4 shelters open statewide with 4 occupants (ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 4:54 am EST)

#### <u>Response</u>

- FMAG approved November 11, 2016
- NC EOC at Full Activation (Hurricane Matthew)
- FEMA Region IV RWC remains at Watch/Steady State


