- Rain and Snow Pacific Northwest, Great Lakes and Northeast
- Rain and Thunderstorms –Southern Plains through the Tennessee/Ohio Valleys into the Southeast, Appalachians and Mid-Atlantic to Northeast
- Space Weather Minor (G1 level) storms observed past 24 hours; no storms predicted for the next 24 hours

**Tropical Activity Western Pacific:** No activity affecting U.S. interests






# Active Watches and Warnings






# Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3






