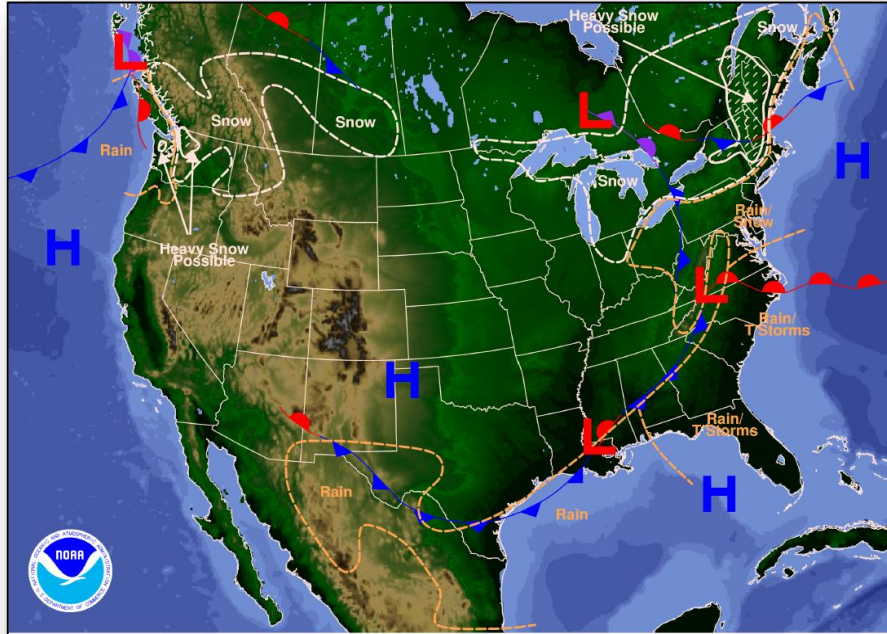
- Heavy snow/high winds – interior New England, Cascades to Northern High Plains

**Earthquake Activity:** No significant activity

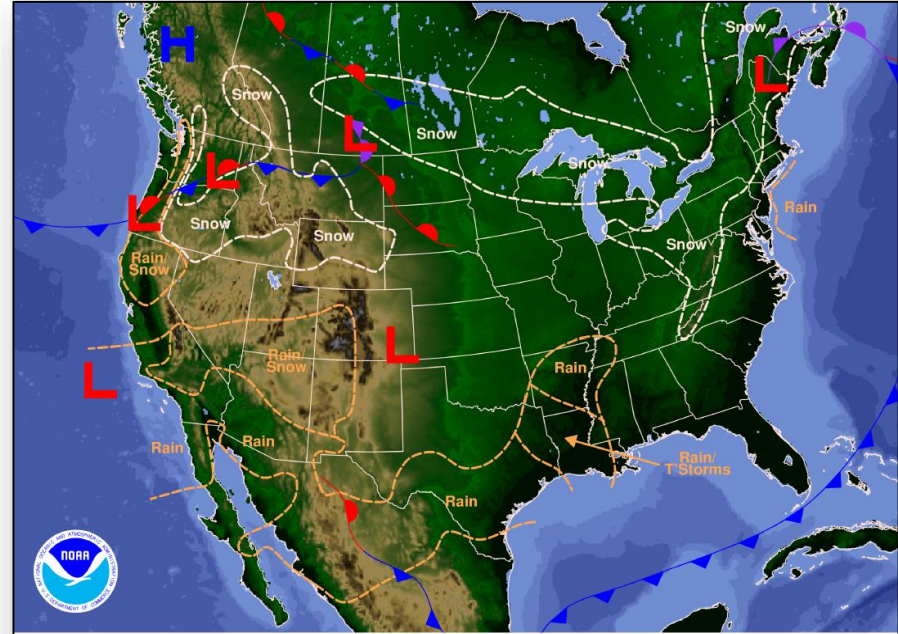

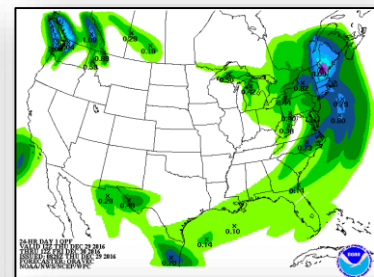

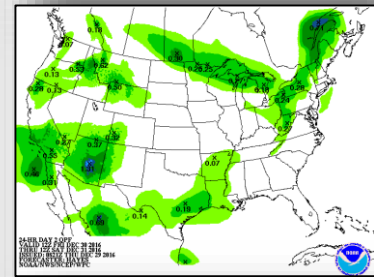

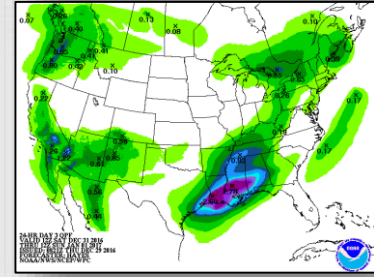
# Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3

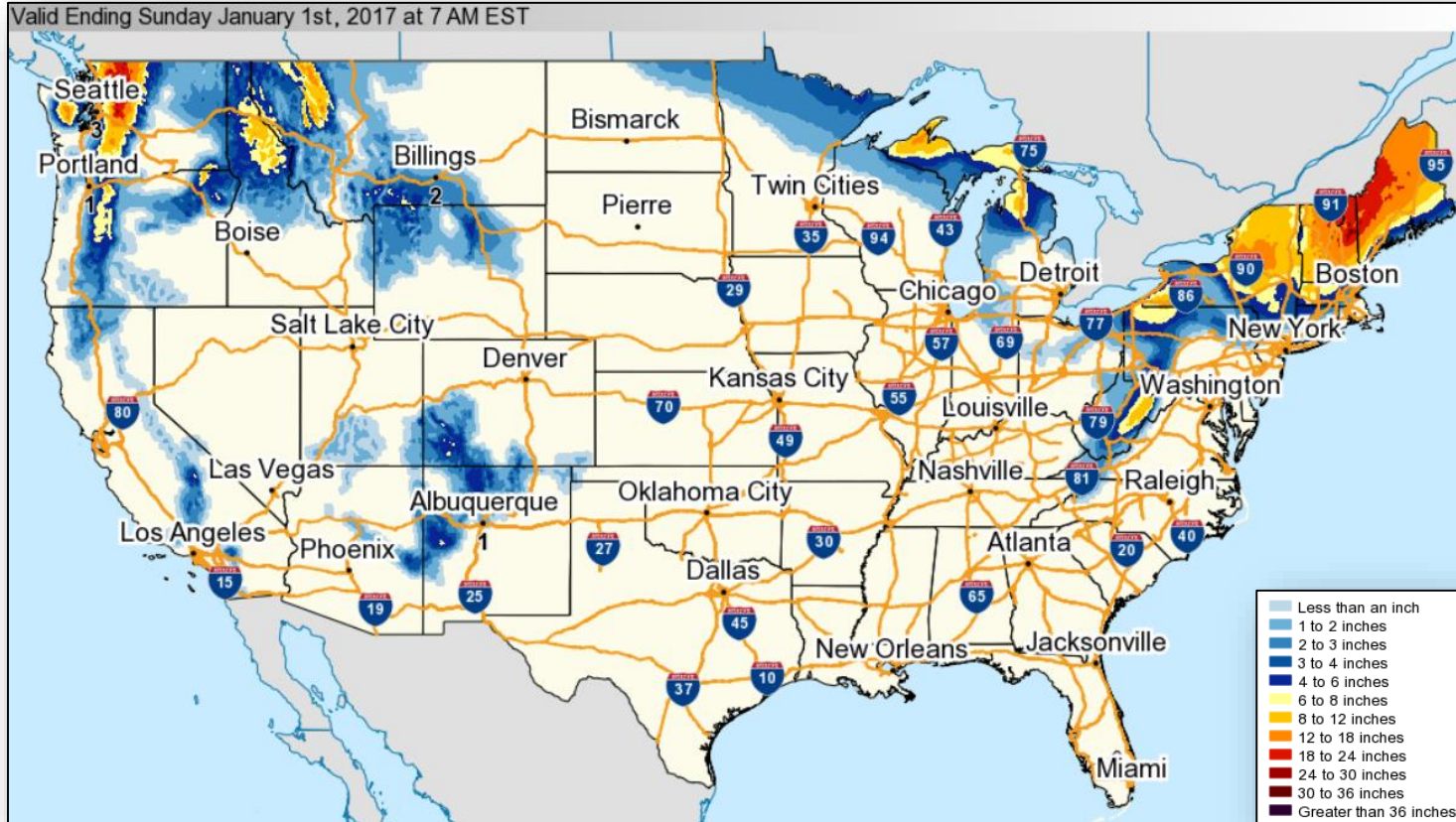

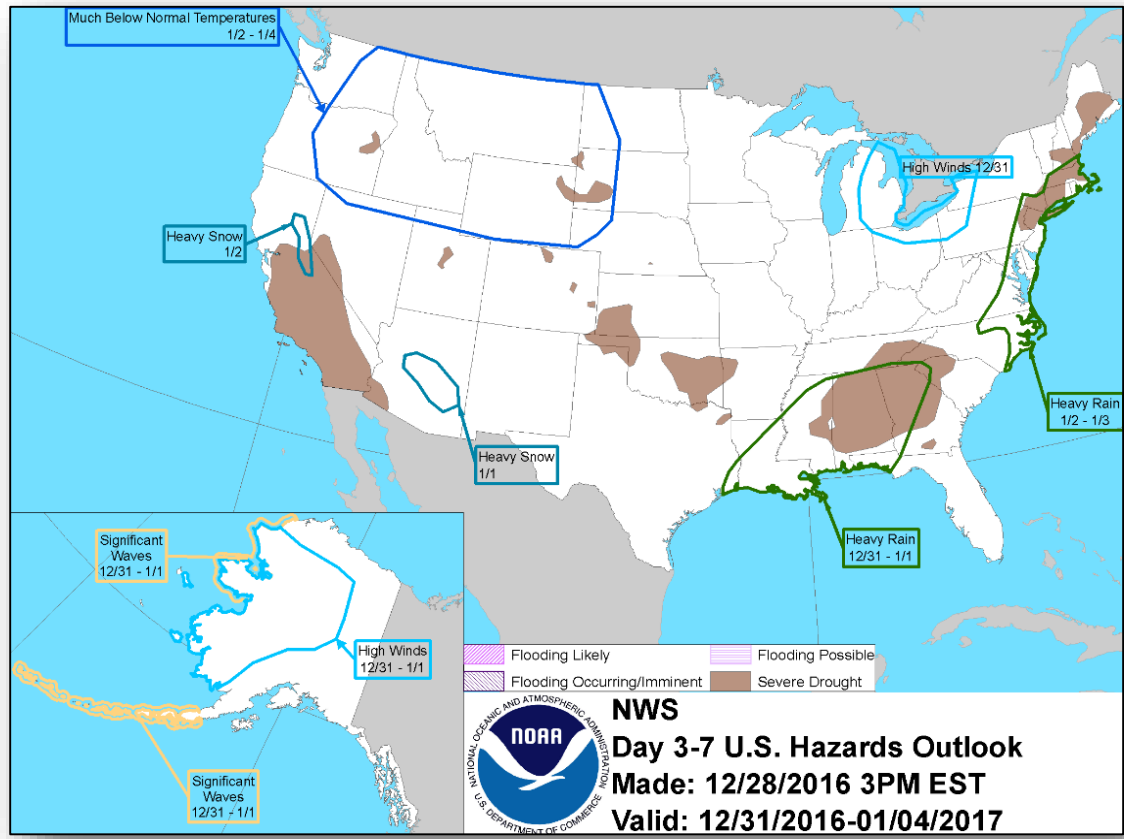

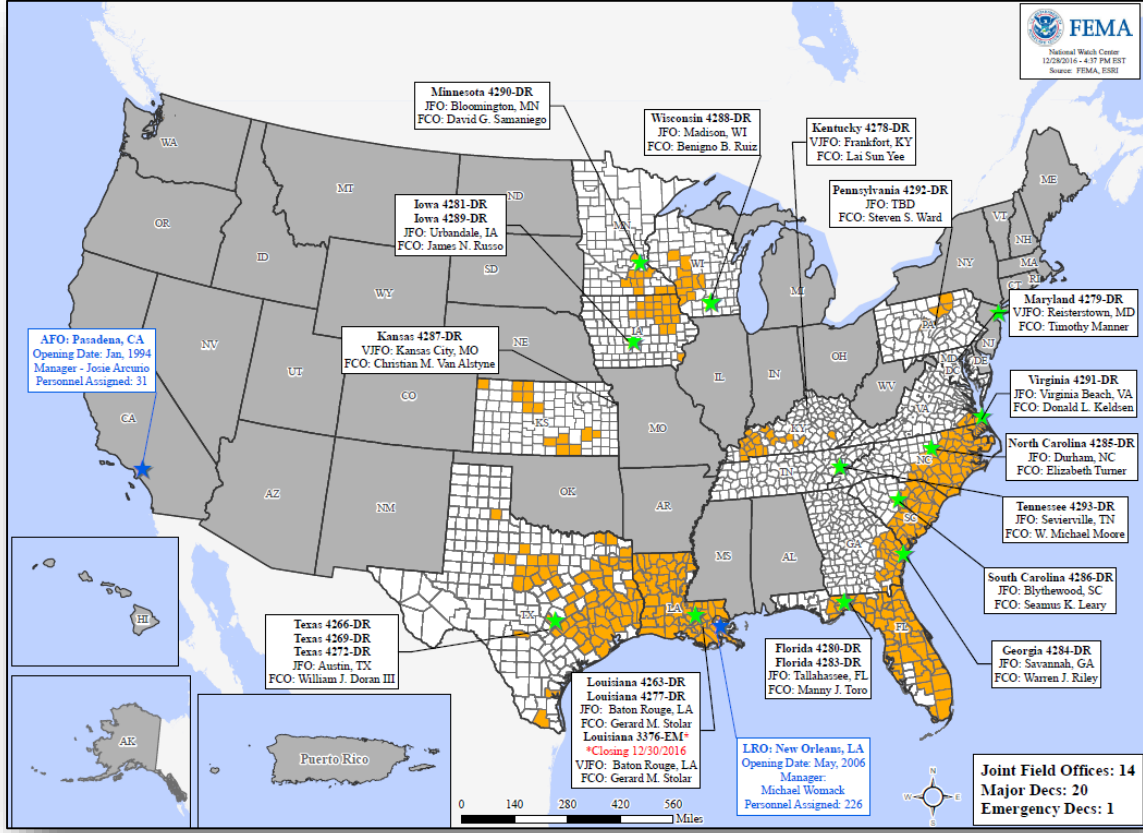
