# Significant Activity – Jan 13-16



## **Significant Events:**

- Winter storm – Central U.S.

## **Significant Weather:**

- Freezing rain possible – Northern Intermountain; Central Plains to Great Lakes & Mid-Atlantic
- Snow – Central Rockies to Central Plains; Northeast
- Heavy snow possible – Central Plains
- Rain and snow – Southwest to Great Lakes and Mid-Atlantic
- Rain and thunderstorms – Southern Plains to Lower/Middle Mississippi valleys, Central Plains, Great Lakes & Tennessee Valley
- Rain – Pacific Northwest; Southeast; Southern Appalachians to Mid-Atlantic
- Space Weather – Past 24 hours – none; next 24 hours – none

**Earthquake Activity:** No significant activity

**Declaration Activity:** None

# Winter Storm – Central U.S.



## Current Situation:

- A major winter storm continues to affect parts of the central U.S. and Upper Midwest
- Moderate to locally heavy ice accumulation began Saturday; additional accumulation possible today with freezing rain and sleet from KS to IA and snow from CO to NE
- Ice Storm Warnings and Winter Weather Advisories are in effect across much of the Central Plains to the upper Midwest

## State Response:

- MO & KS EOCs at Full Activation; Governors declared States of Emergency
- OK EOC at Monitoring
- Shelters: TX: 1 open with 11 occupants; OK: 7 open with 7 occupants; MO: 1 open with no occupants (*ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 4:30 a.m. EST*)
- Minimal power outages remain across TX, OK, KS & MO

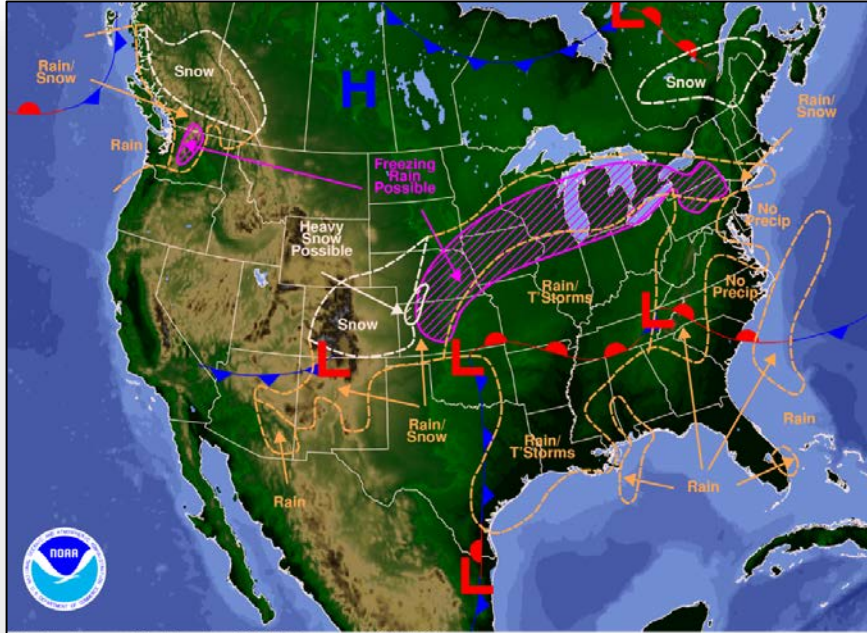
## Federal Response:

- FEMA Region VI RWC at Enhanced Watch (day shift only)
  - IMAT demobilized from OK
- FEMA Region VII RRCC deactivated; RWC at Enhanced Watch (24/7)
  - LNO remains deployed to KS EOC; LNO to MO EOC demobilized
- ISB staging team and MERS assets deployed to Norman, OK



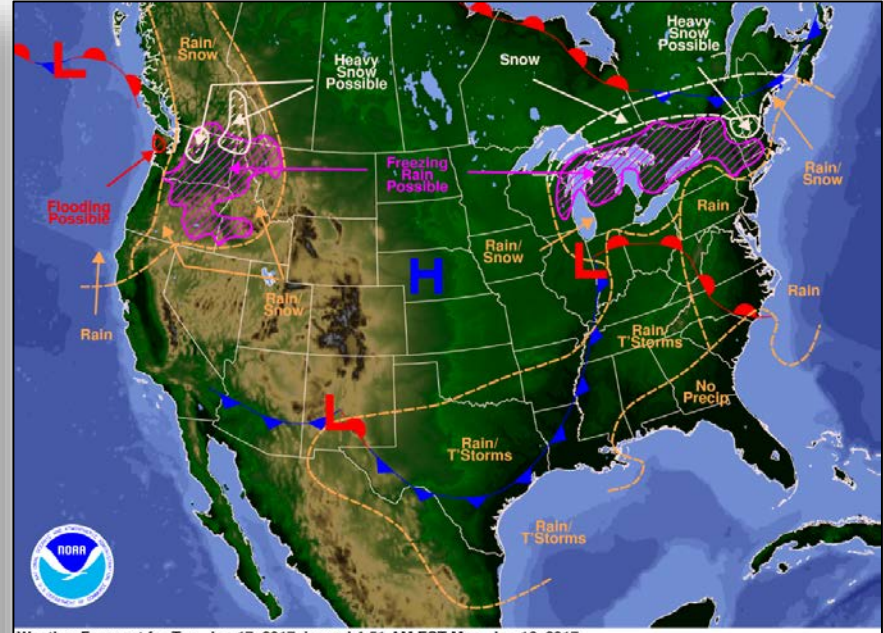

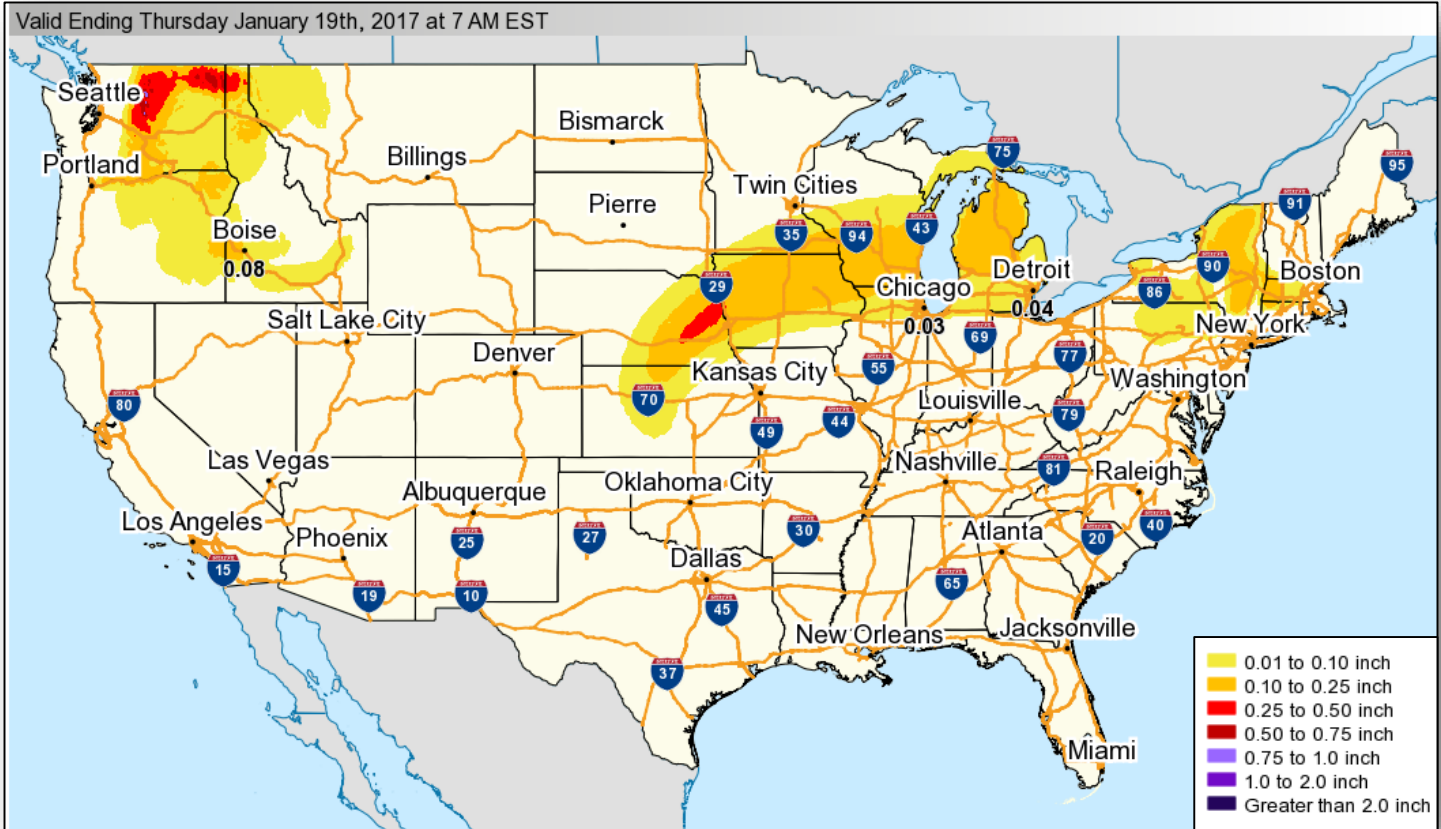

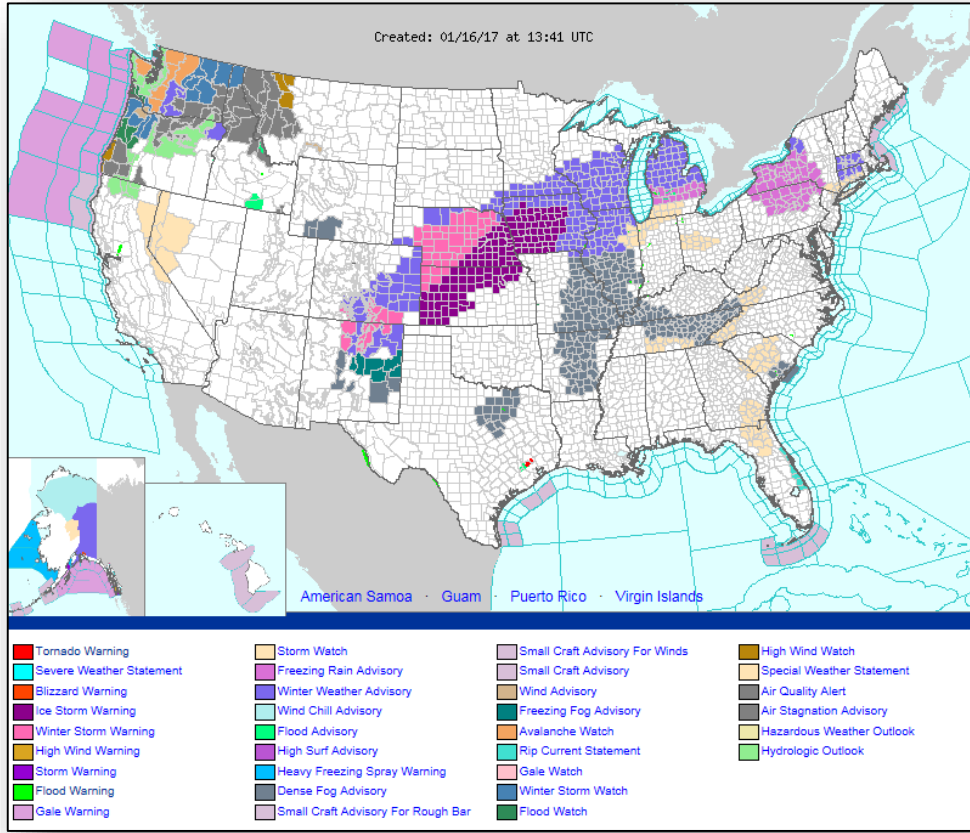
# Forecast Ice – Days 1-3



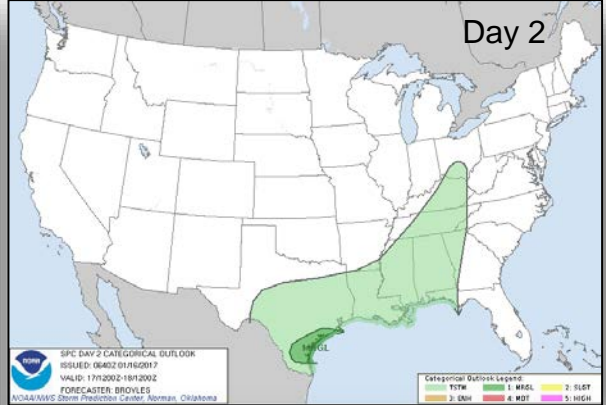
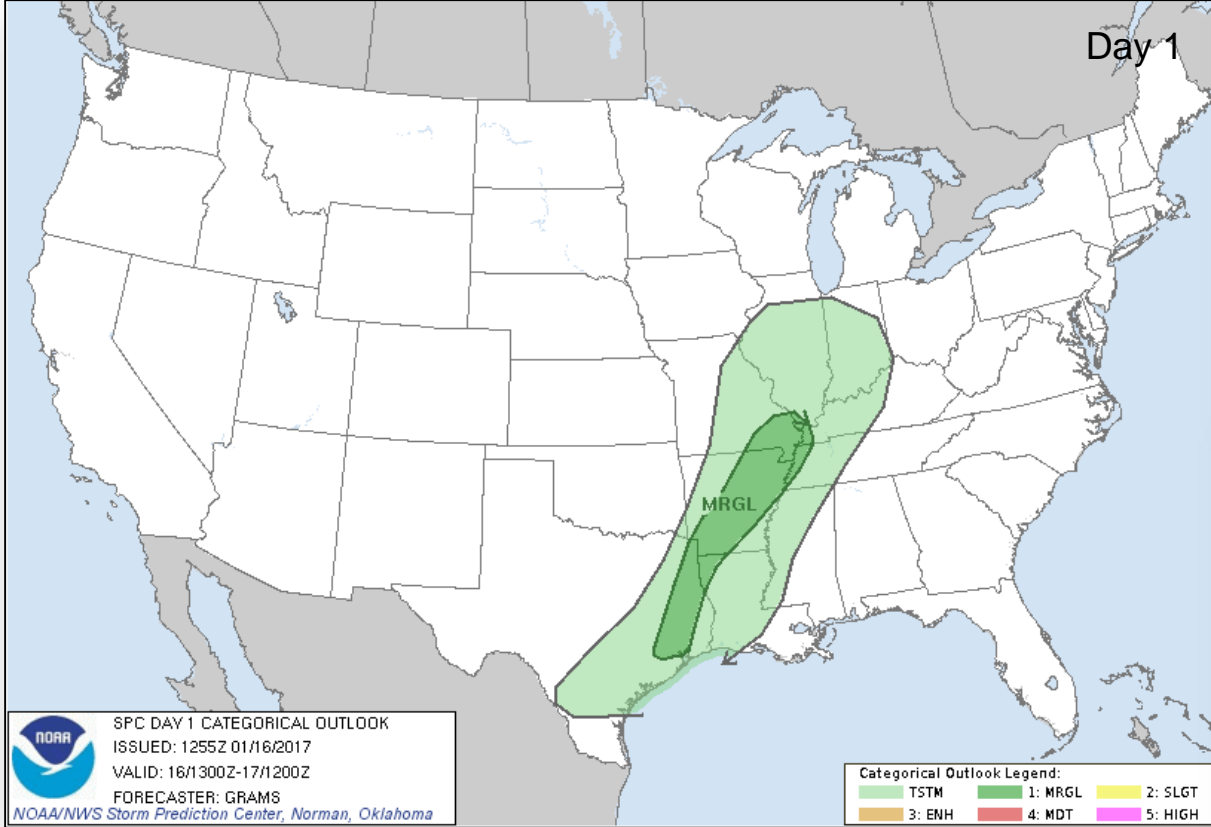

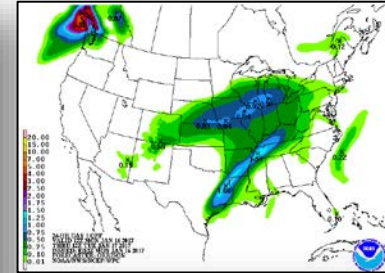
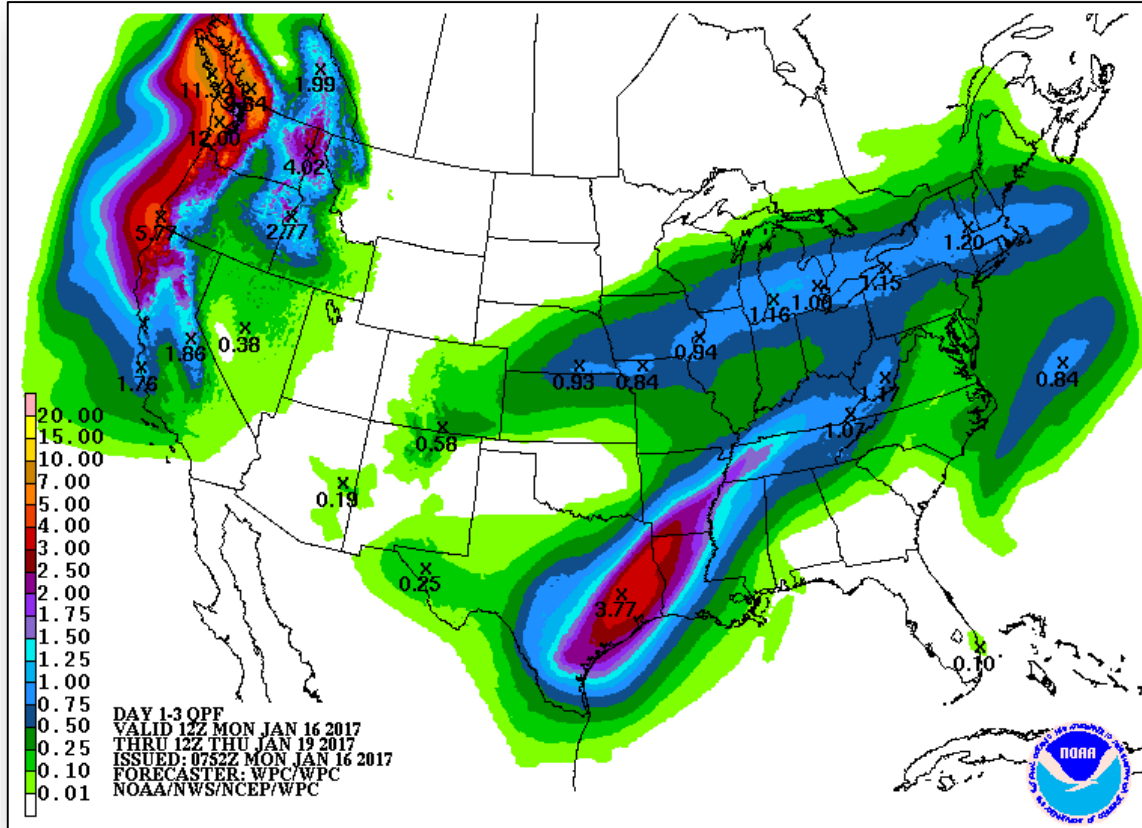
# Severe Weather Outlook – Days 1-3



# Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3



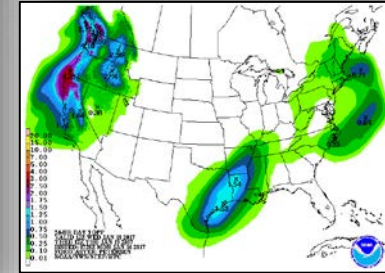

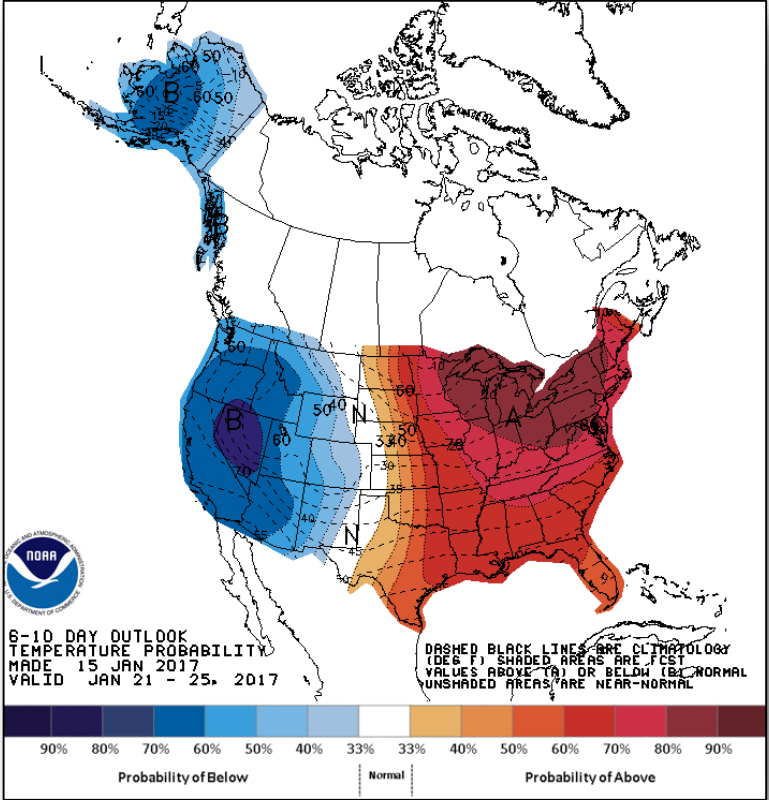

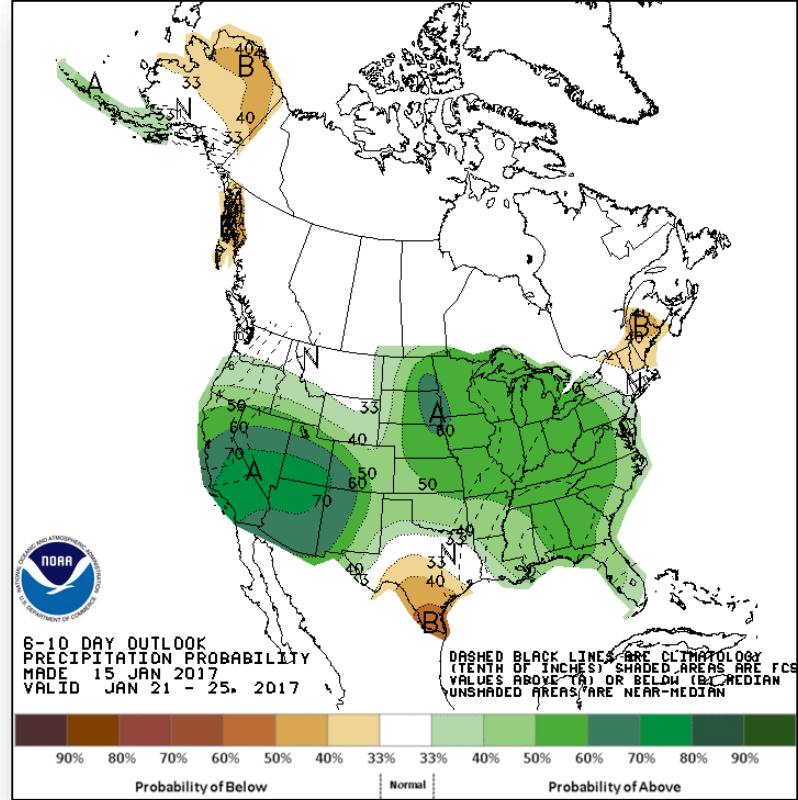
