Significant Activity – Jan 18-19



Significant Events: 58th Presidential Inauguration

Significant Weather:

- Flash flooding possible Lower Mississippi Valley
- Freezing rain possible Northern Intermountain, Northern Plains, Great Lakes
- Heavy snow possible Northern Intermountain, northern California, Central Great Basin, Southwest
- Snow Northern Intermountain to Northern/Central Plains, Central Great Basin and Central Rockies
- Rain and snow Northern Intermountain to Northern Plains, CA, Central Great Basin to Southwest and Southern Rockies;
 Northeast
- Rain and thunderstorms Southern Plains to Southeast, Upper Mississippi and Ohio valleys to Southern Appalachians
- Rain Pacific Northwest; central to southern CA; Southwest; Upper Mississippi Valley to Great Lakes and Mid-Atlantic
- Space Weather Past 24 hours none; next 24 hours minor; geomagnetic storms reaching G1 level likely

 - NWC will activate to Enhanced Watch at 8:00 am EST on January 20
 - NRCC placed on Alert on January 18
 - National IMAT East-1 placed on Alert on January 18
 - US&R issued an ESF#9 Advisory
- FEMA Region III
 - RWC returned to Watch/Steady State
 - RRCC at Level III (day shift only) on 19 Jan 2017; will go to Level III (24/7) at 7:00 am EST, starting January 20
- States/DC
 - DC EOC at Full Activation
 - VA EOC at Partial Activation
 - MD EOC will go to Partial Activation on January 20








Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3






Severe Weather Outlook – Days 1-3






Severe Weather Outlook – Day 4


