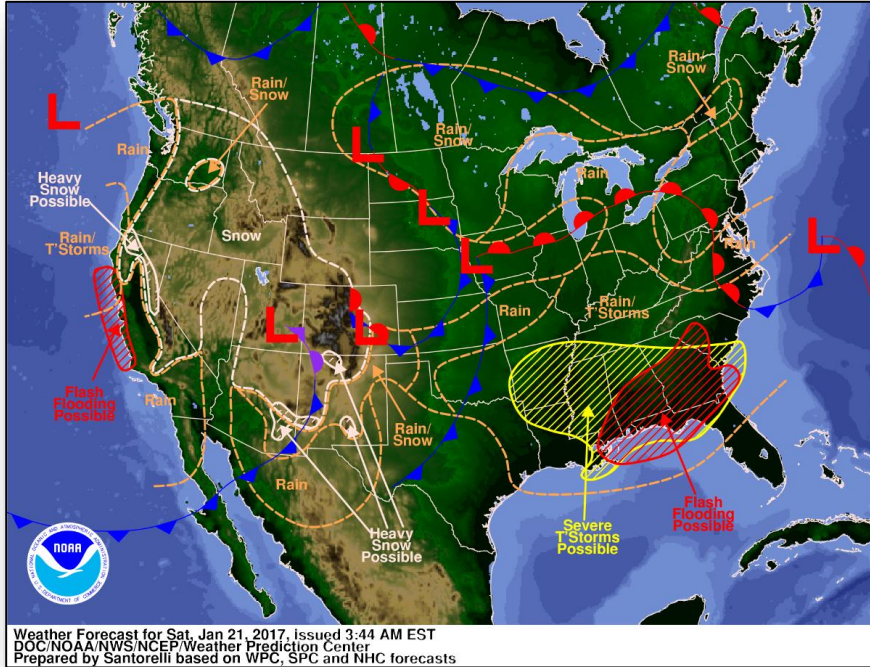
- Flash Flooding – California, Lower Mississippi Valley, and Southeast

Tropical Activity Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

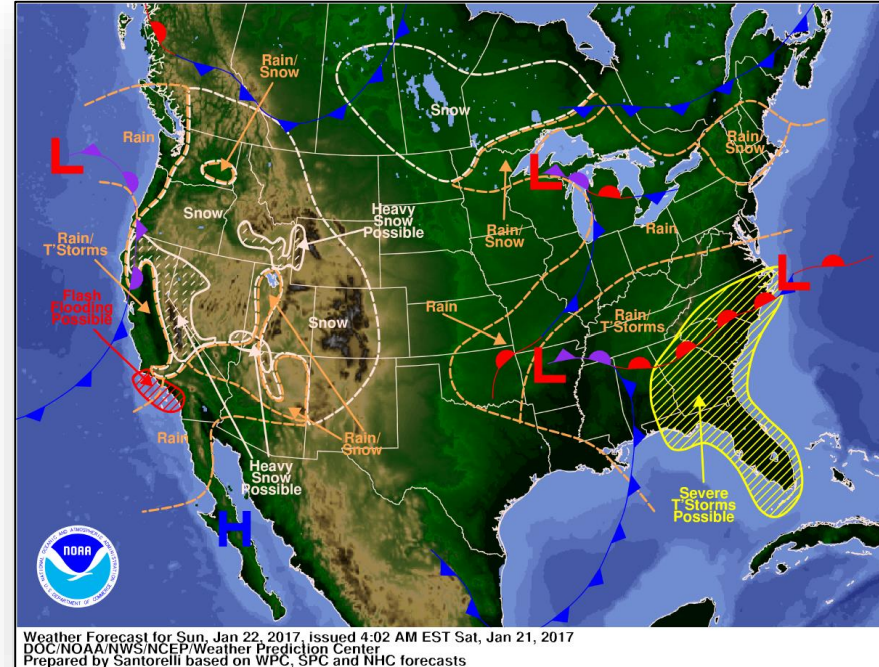

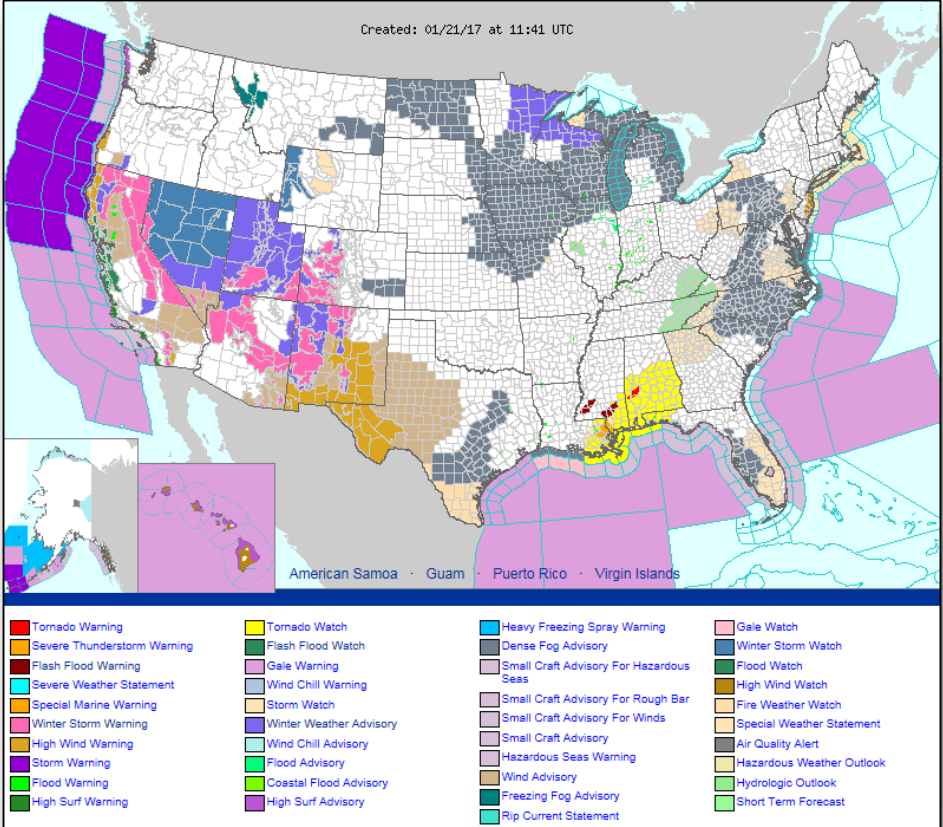

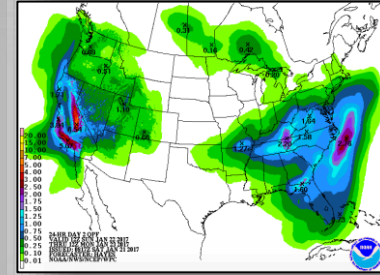
Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3



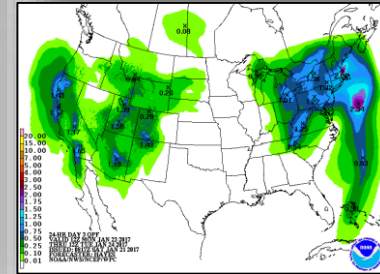

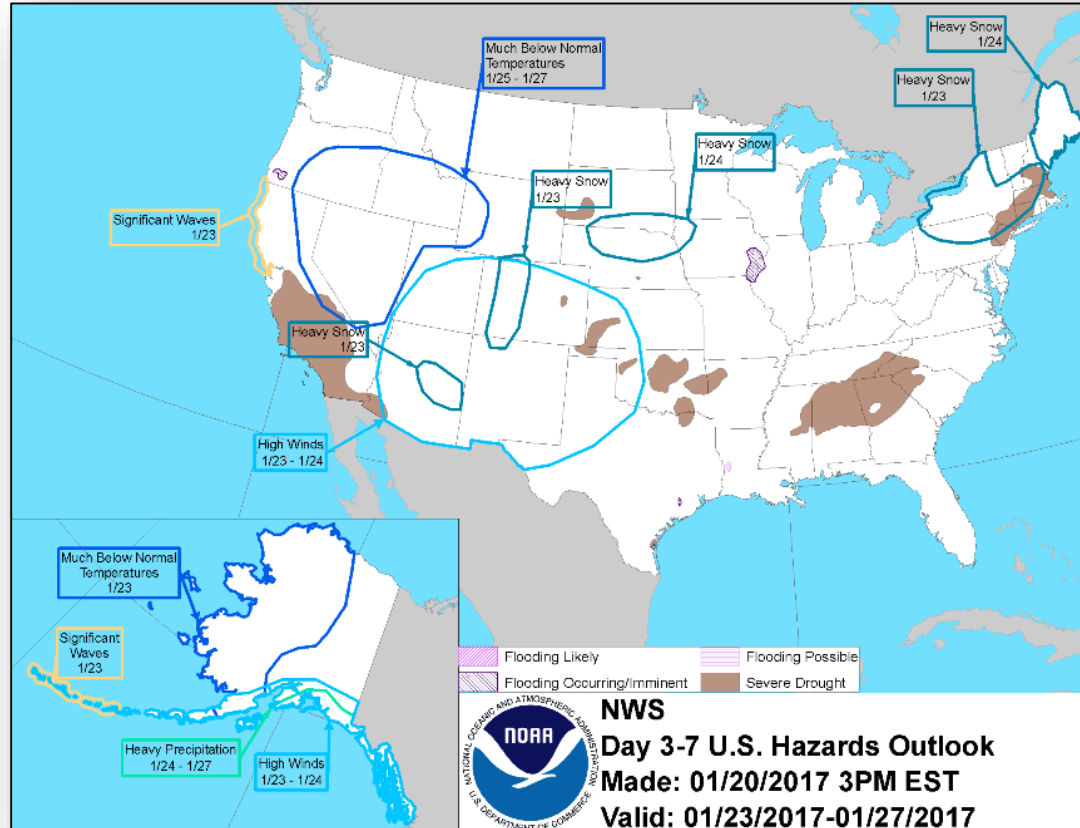
Severe Weather Outlook – Days 1-3

Hazards Outlook – Jan 23-27



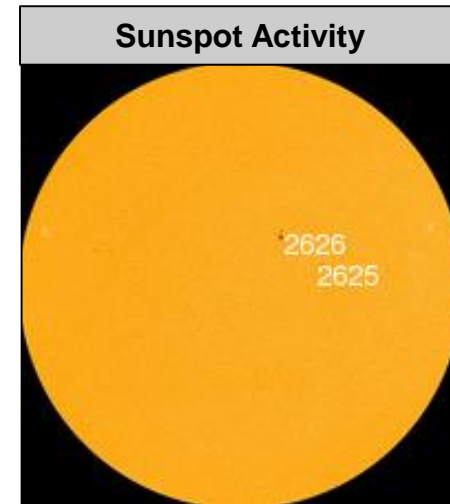
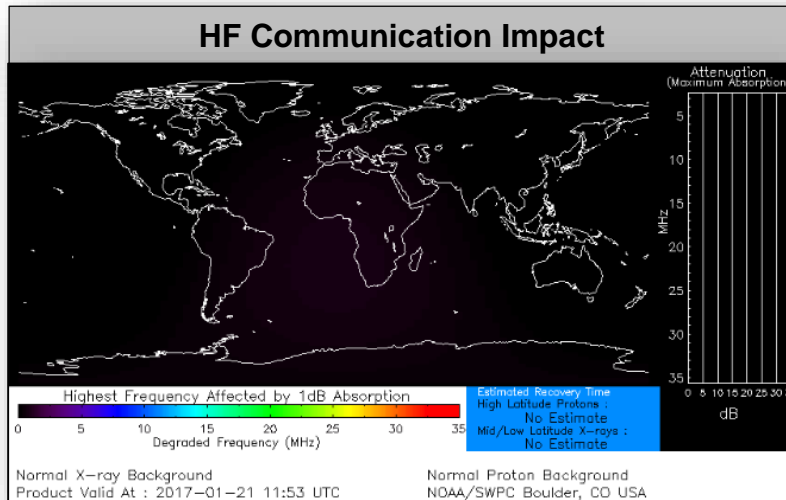

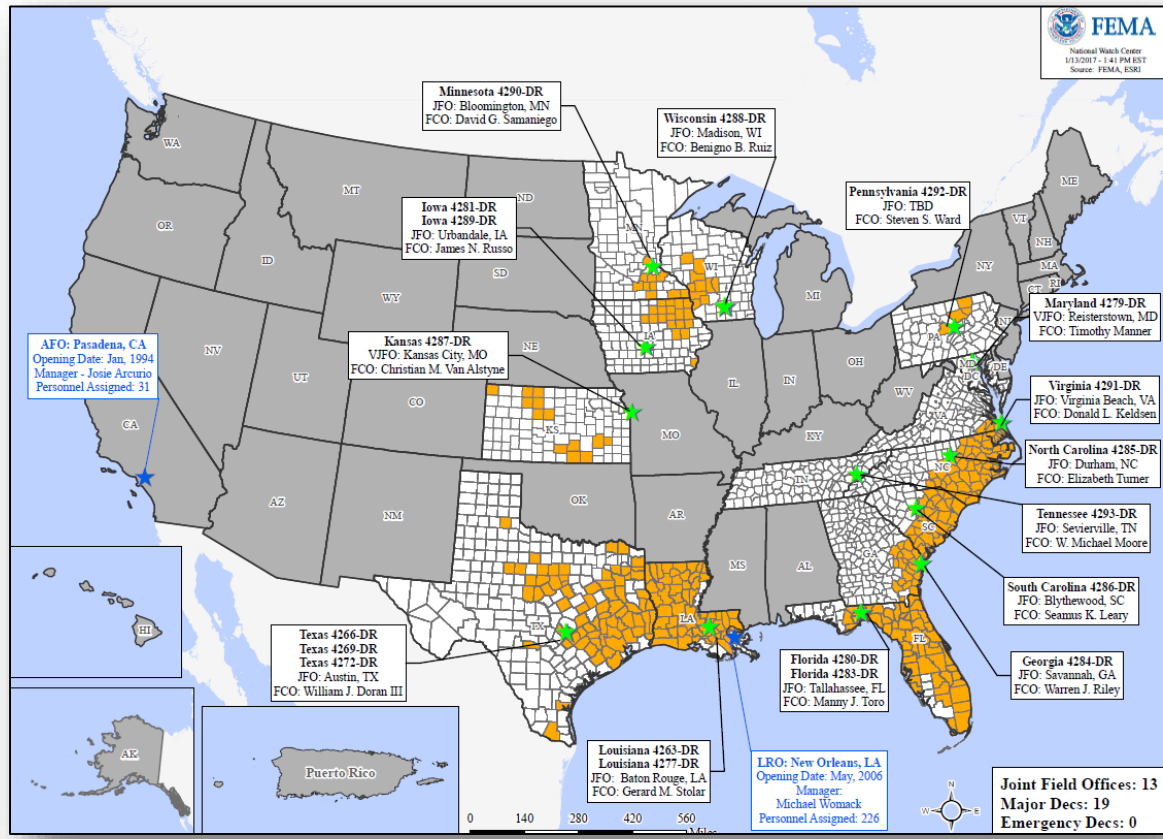
