






Fire Weather Outlook








Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3










Western U.S. River Forecasts






Forecast Snowfall – Days 1-3





Hazards Outlook – Feb 13-17







- FCO is John Long




Declaration Request

 - o Hazard Mitigation statewide






