- Space Weather – Past 24 hours: none; Next 24 hours: Minor, Geomagnetic storms reaching G1 level expected

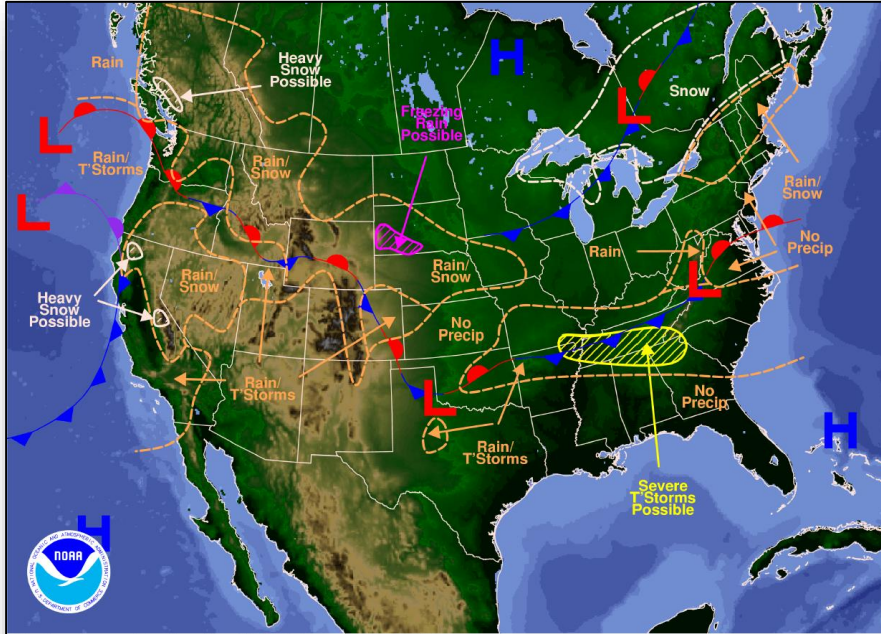

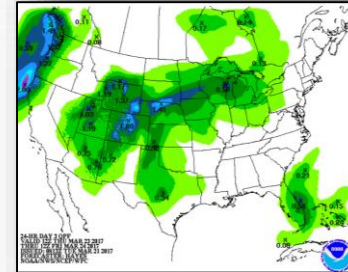
Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3

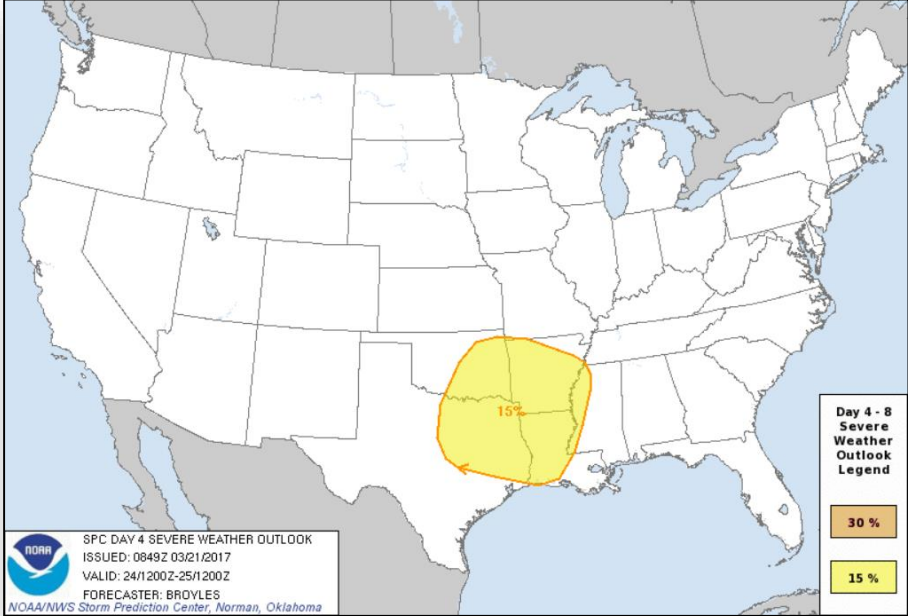

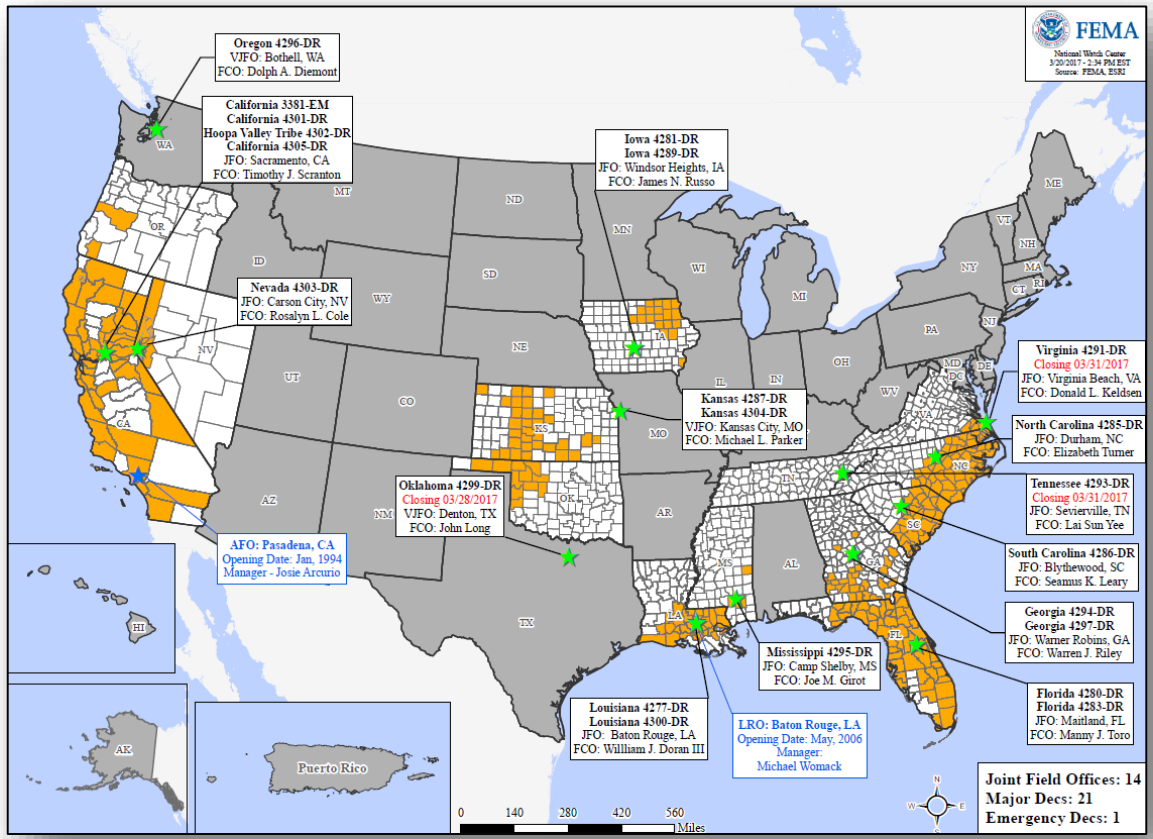


California

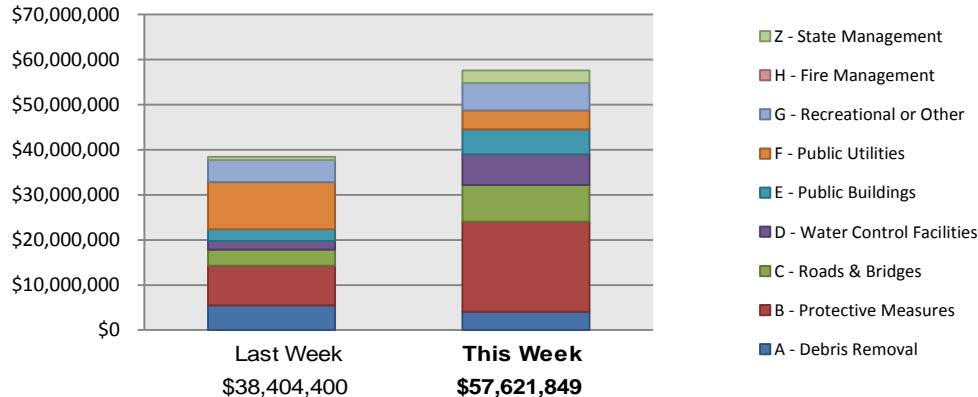

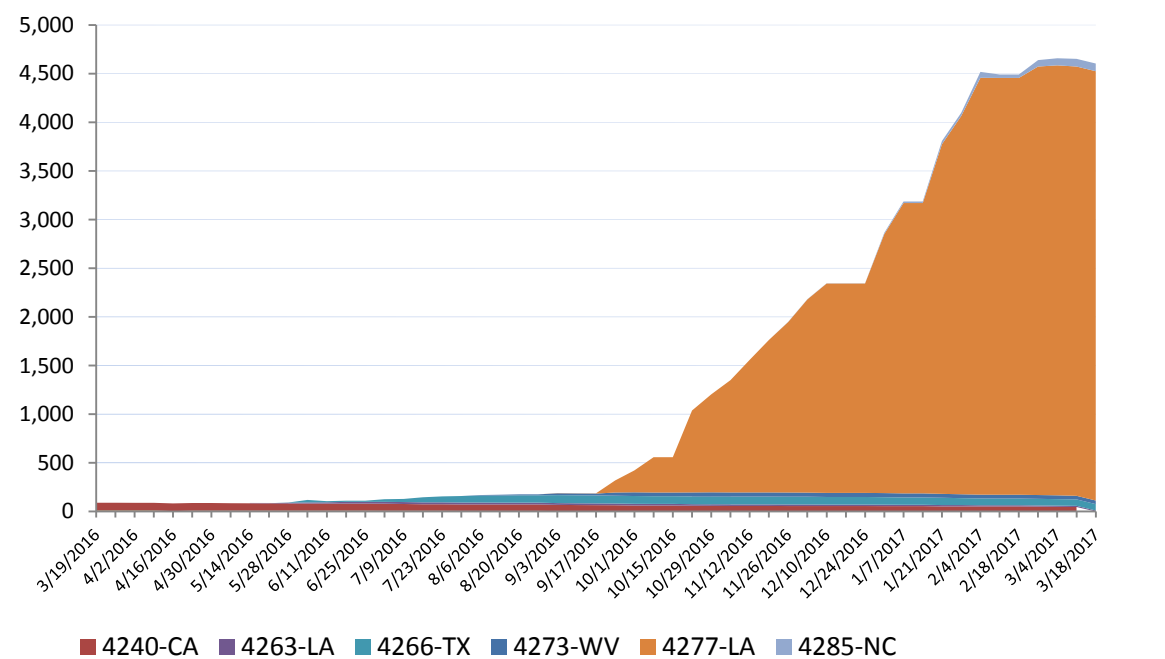

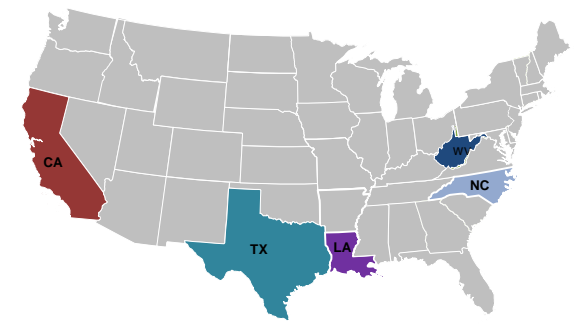

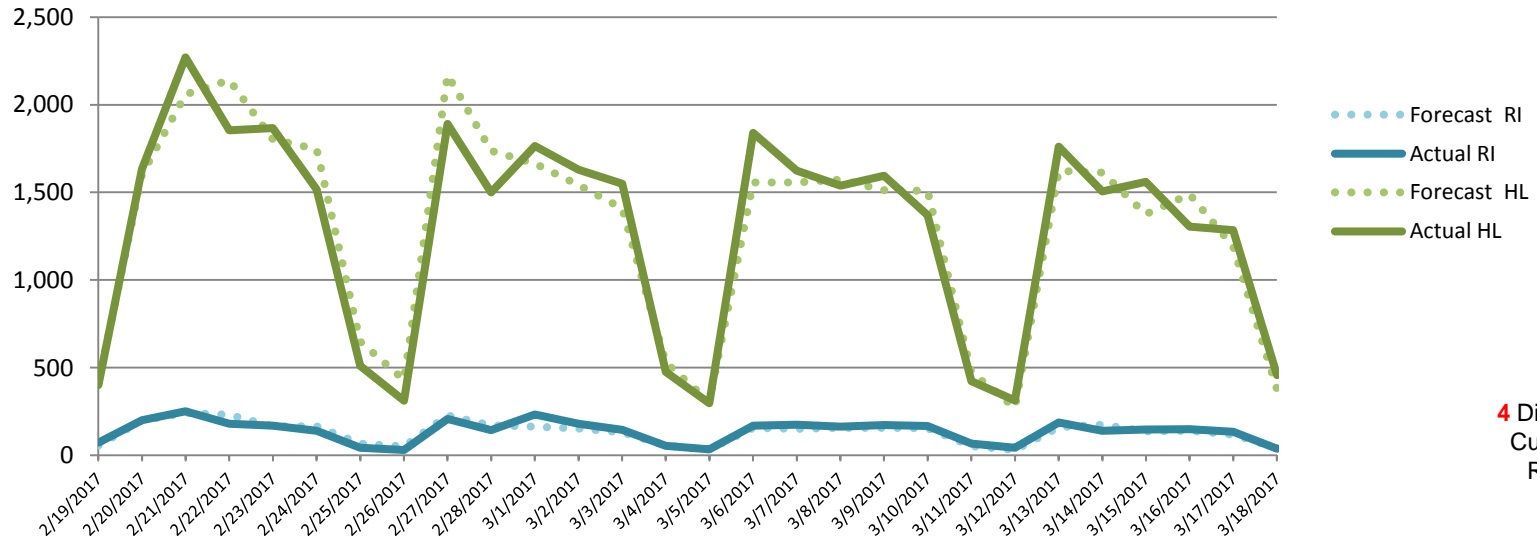

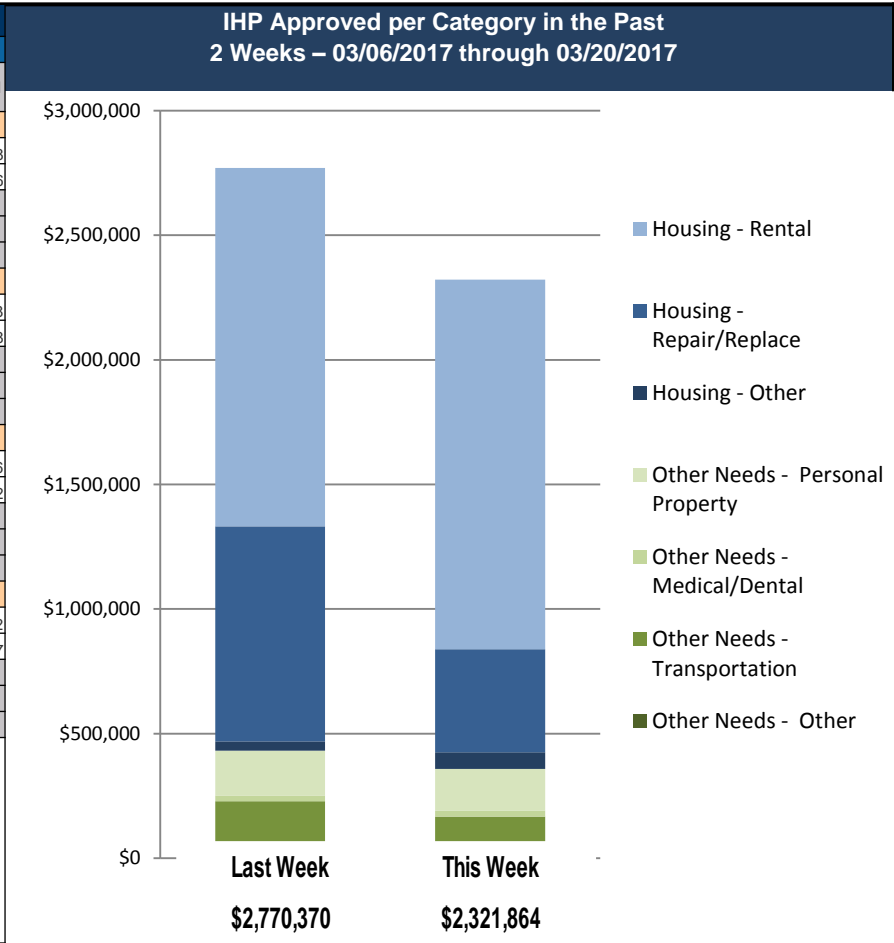
NPSC Call Forecasting and Actual Calls Over the Past 4 Weeks 02/19/2017 through 03/18/2017
