- Rain and Thunderstorms Southern/Central Plains, Mississippi Valley, Great Lakes, Ohio/Tennessee valleys & Southeast
- Critical/Elevated Fire Weather AZ, CA, & TX
- Red Flag Warnings AZ, CO, FL, KS, NM, OK, TX, & WY
- Space Weather:
 - Past 24 hours: No space weather storms observed
 - Next 24 hours: Moderate Geomagnetic storms reaching G2 level likely




Severe Weather Outlook – Days 1-3






Severe Weather Outlook – Days 4-6






National Weather Forecast








Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3





Fire Weather Outlook





Hazards Outlook – March 31 – April 4









