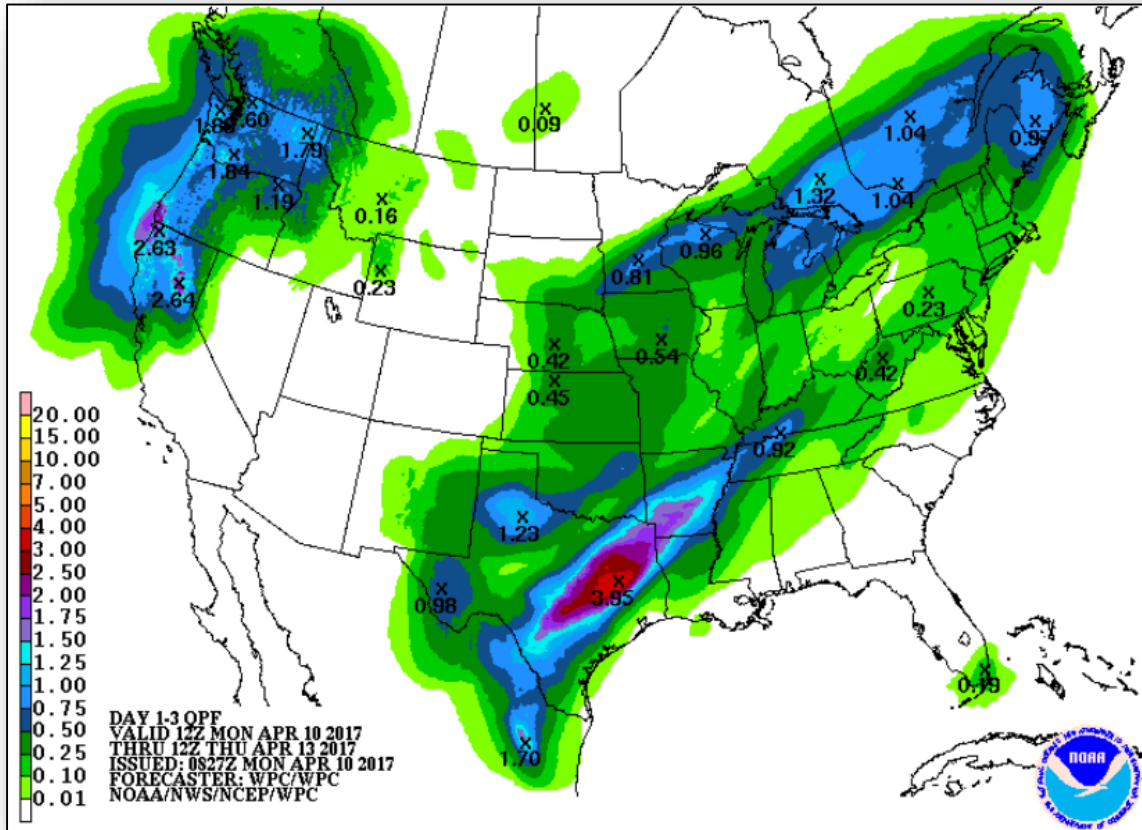

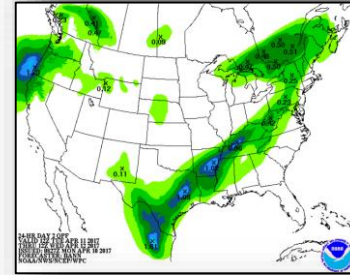
# Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3



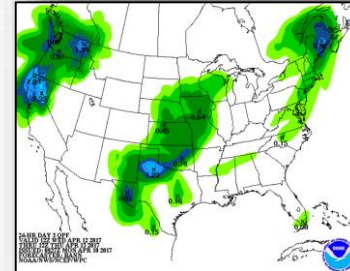

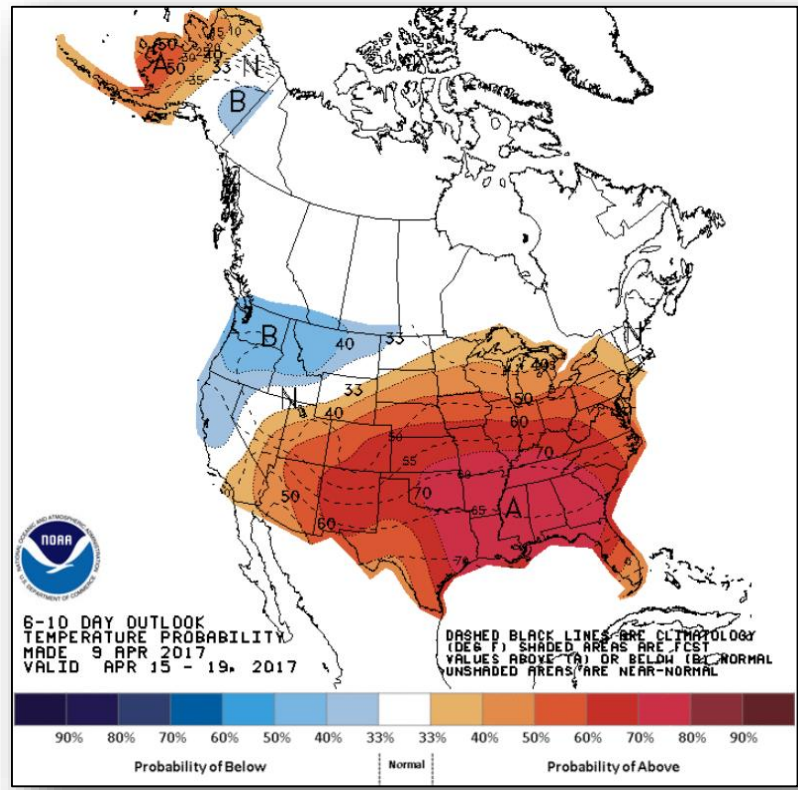

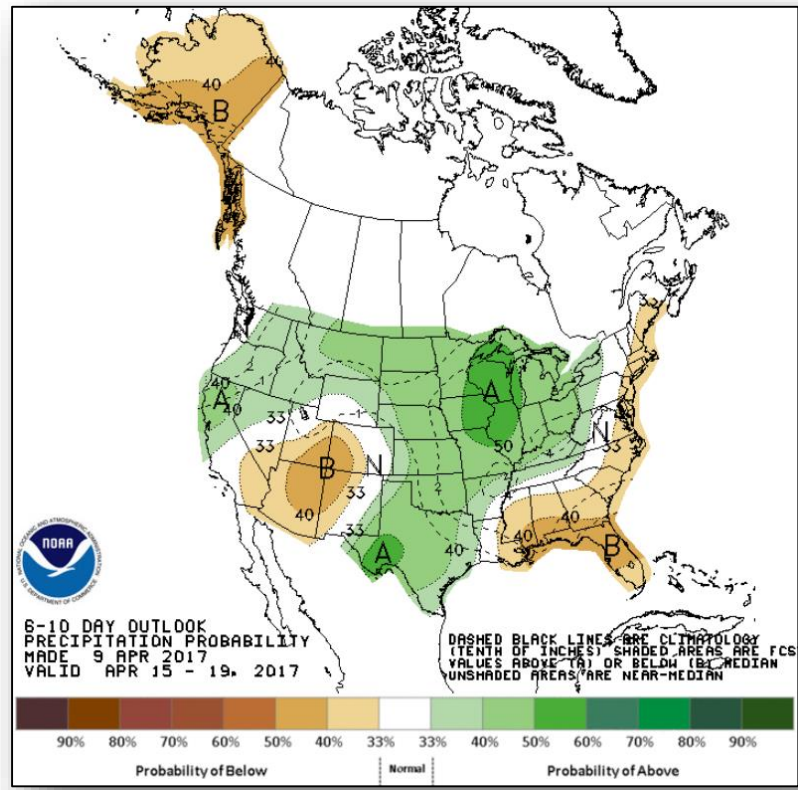
# Severe Weather Outlook – Days 1-3

**6-10 Day Temperature Probability**



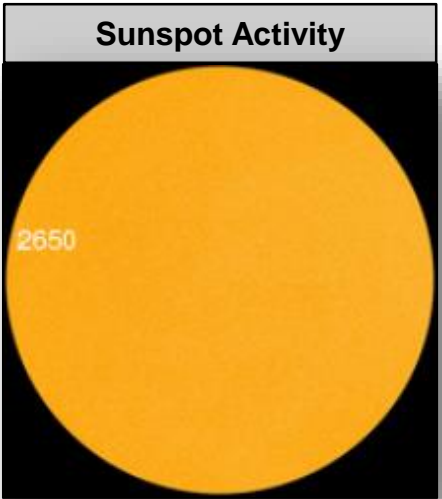
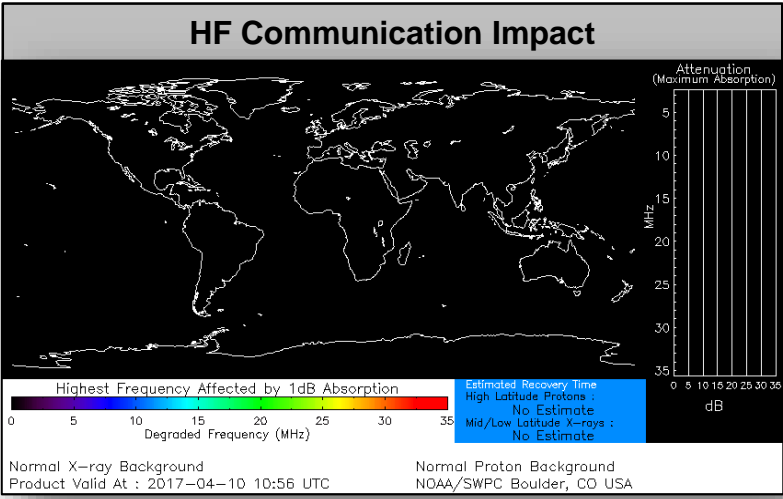
**6-10 Day Precipitation Probability**

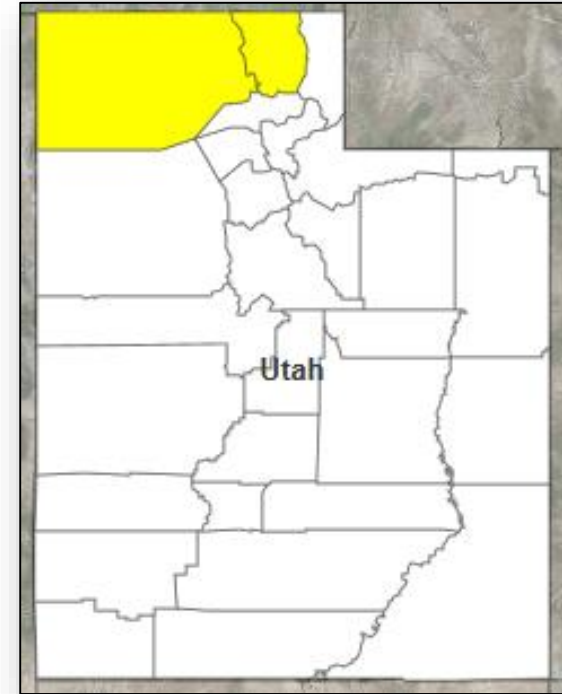


# Declaration Request
