**Earthquake Activity:** No significant activity

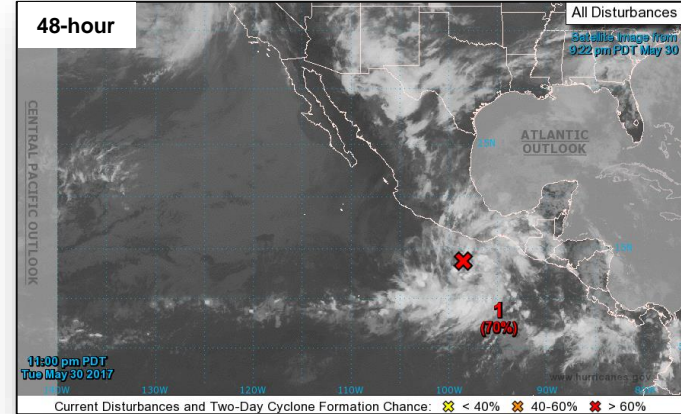

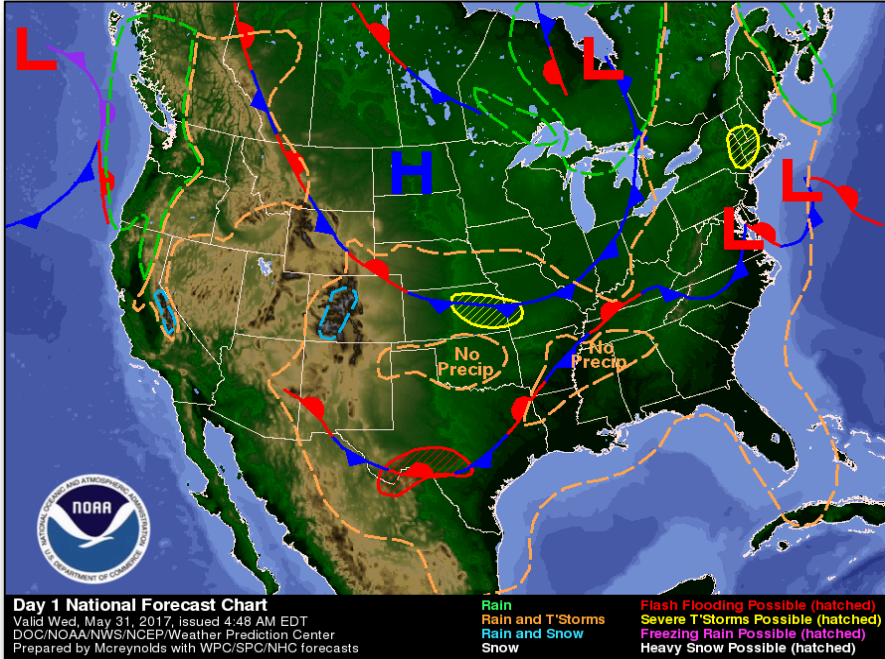


## Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

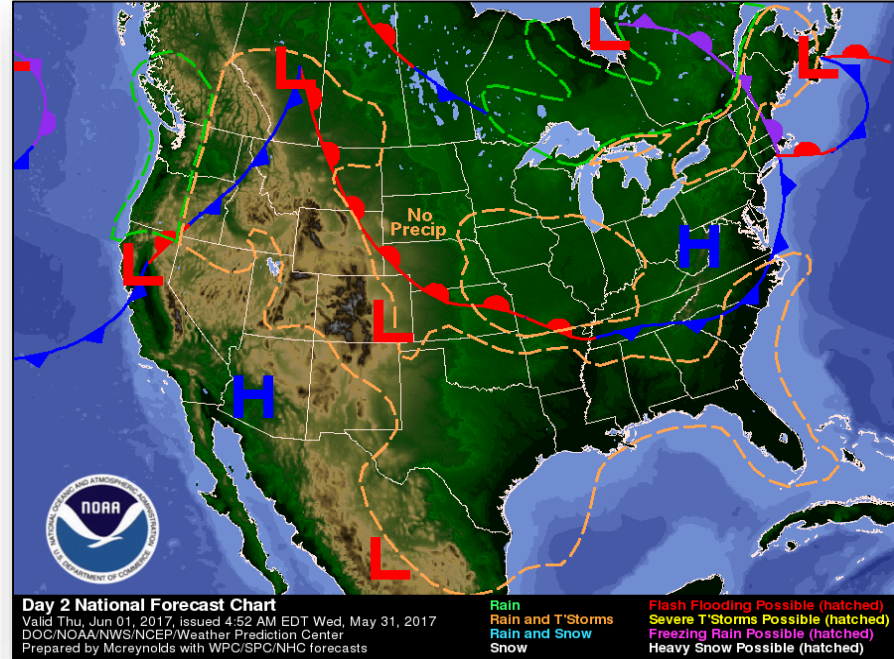
- Located 275 miles southeast of Acapulco, Mexico; drifting northward

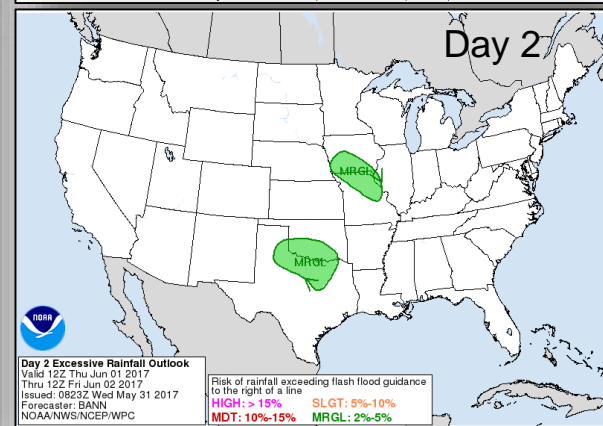
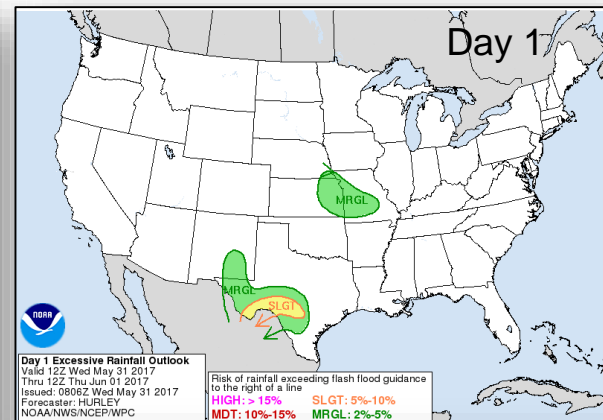
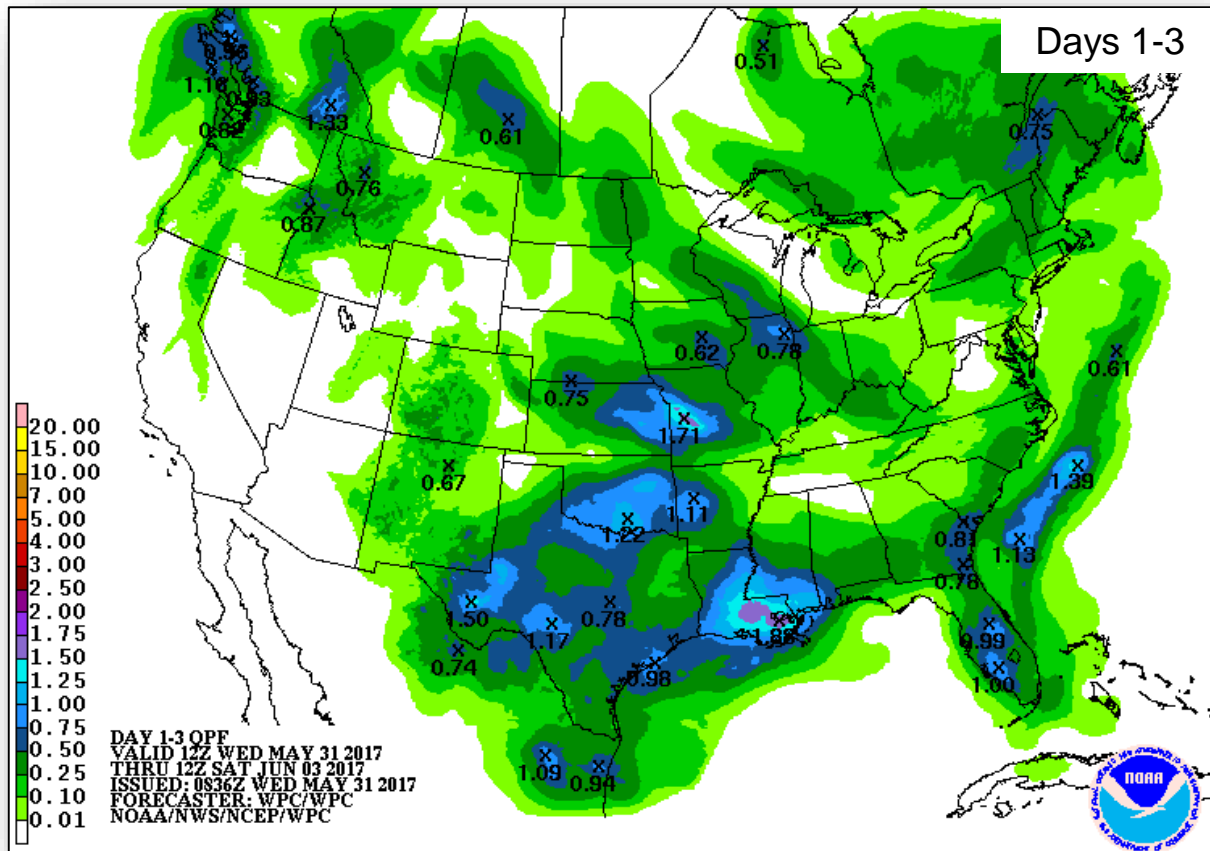

# Precipitation Forecast / Flash Flood Risk



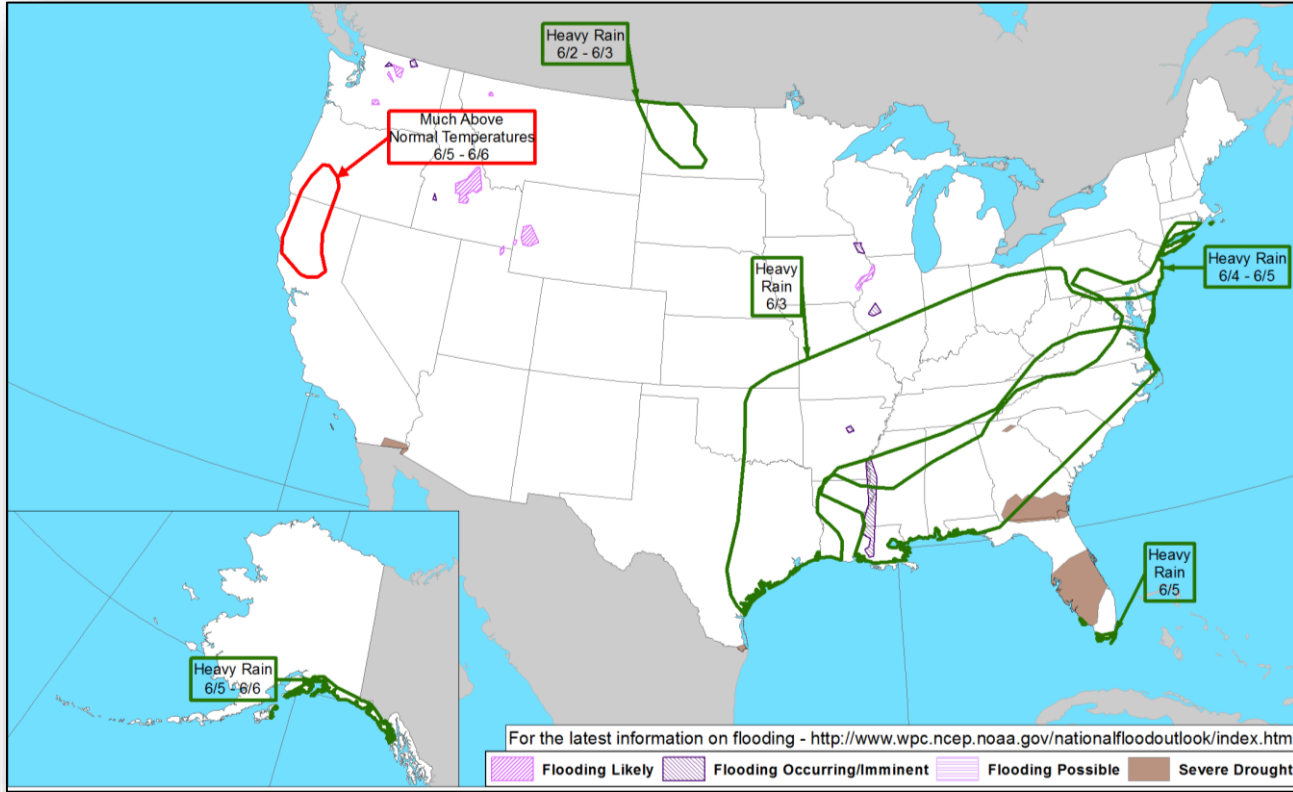
