- Western Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests

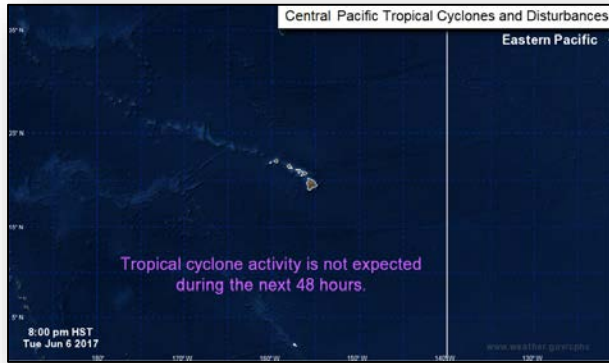
**Significant Weather:**

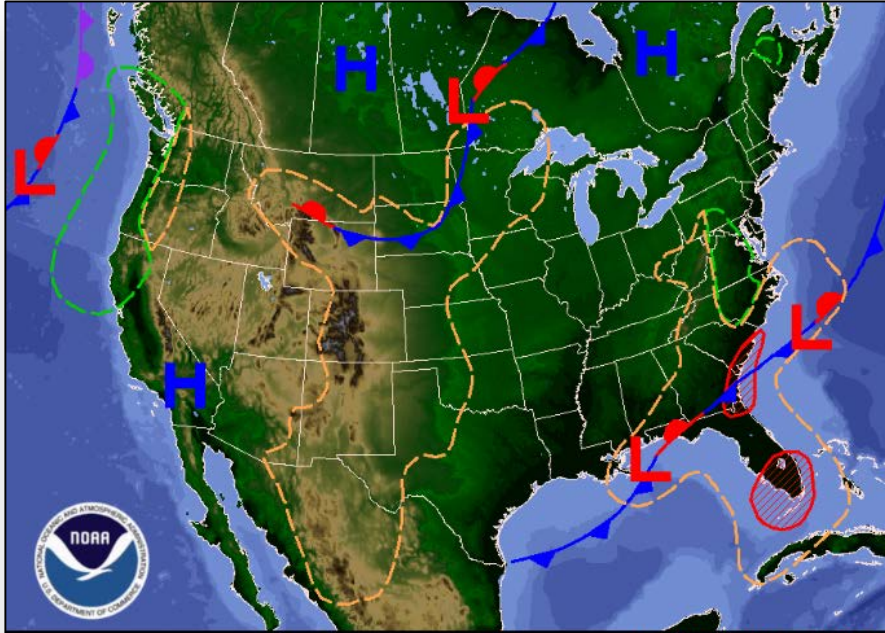

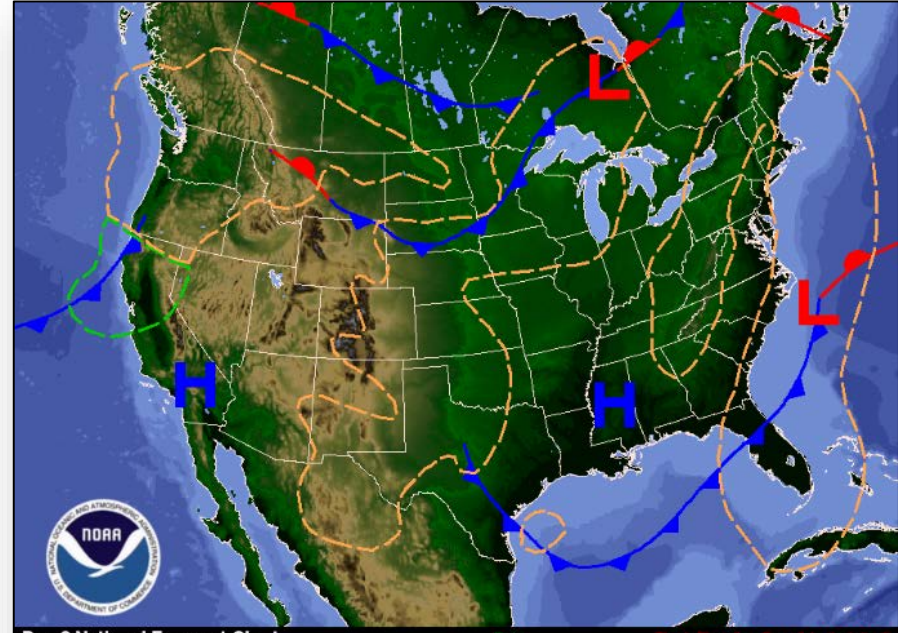

# Precipitation Forecast / Flash Flood Risk



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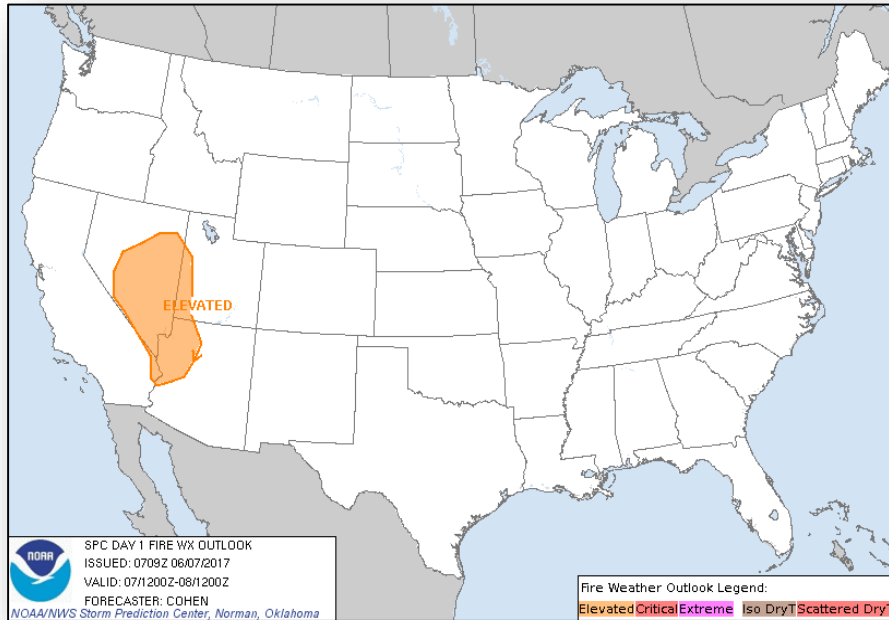




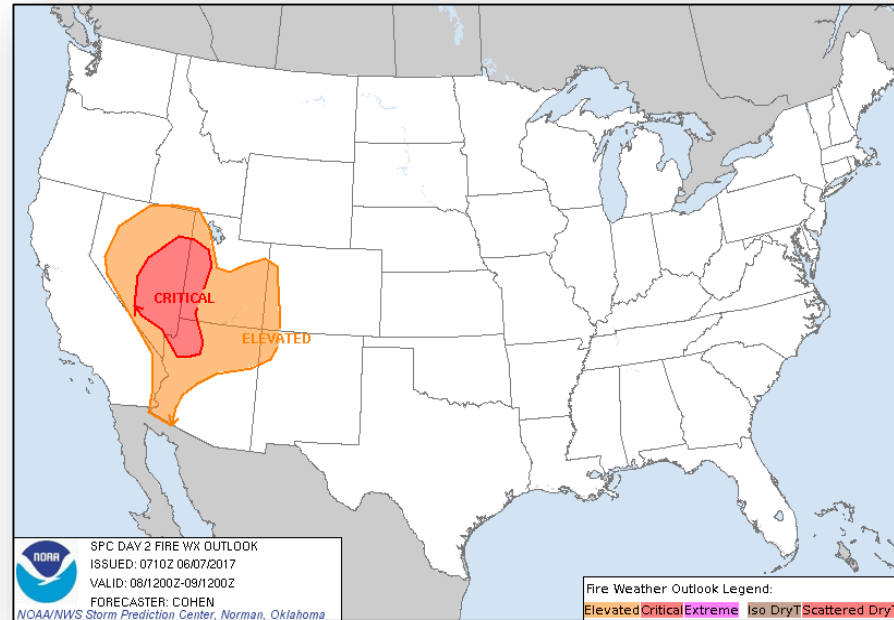

\* The Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Reservation falls wholly within the boundary of Rolette County

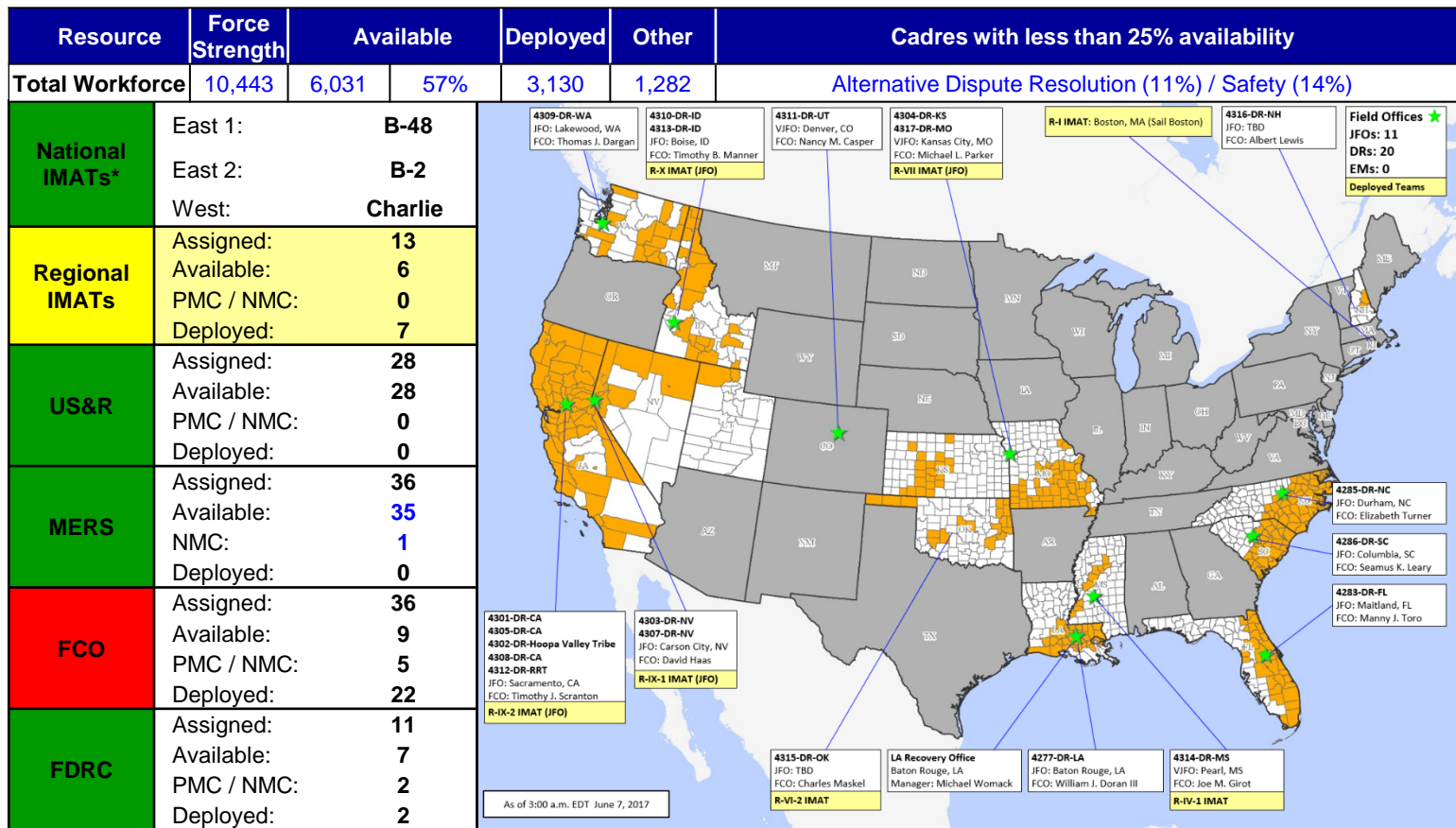
