




#### National Weather Forecast










### Precipitation Forecast / Flash Flood Risk











#### Fire Weather Outlook





#### Hazards Outlook – June 9-13







<sup>\*</sup> The Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Reservation falls wholly within the boundary of Rolette County


