### **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic No tropical cyclone activity expected during the next 48 hours
- Eastern Pacific No tropical cyclones expected during the next 48 hours
- Central Pacific No tropical cyclones expected during the next 48 hours
- Western Pacific No activity affecting U.S. interests

### Significant Weather:

- Severe thunderstorms possible Northern Rockies and Northern Plains
- Rain and thunderstorms California, Pacific Northwest to Upper Mississippi Valley; Great Lakes to Northeast, and Southern Plains
- Rain and snow Northern California, Pacific Northwest, Northern Intermountain, Northern and Central Rockies
- Critical/elevated fire weather areas AZ, CA, CO, MT, ND, NM, NV, UT, and WY
- Red Flag Warnings AZ, CA, CO, NV, and UT

# Precipitation Forecast / Flash Flood Risk






# Earthquake Activity – Hilo, HI




### <u> M5.3 – Hilo, Hl</u>

- Occurred at 1:01 p.m. EDT on June 8, 2017
- Approximately 28 miles south of Hilo, HI; at a depth of 4 miles
- · No reports of fatalities, injuries, or damage
- No tsunami was generated

Response:

- HI EOC remains at Normal Operations
- FEMA Region IX remains at Steady State
- No request for FEMA assistance


