Significant Activity – June 19-20



Significant Events: None

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic – Tropical Storm Bret; Potential Tropical Cyclone Three: High (80%)
- Eastern Pacific – No tropical cyclones expected during the next 48 hours
- Central Pacific – No tropical cyclones expected during the next 48 hours
- Western Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests during the next 48 hours

Significant Weather:

- Severe Thunderstorms possible – CO, KS, and OK
- Flash Flooding possible – LA, MS, AL, FL, GA, SC, and NC
- Rain and Thunderstorms – Southwest to Central Plains, Rockies to the Upper Mississippi Valley, Ohio Valley, Gulf Coast states to the Southeastern U.S., Mid-Atlantic, and Northeast
- Space Weather:
 - Past 24 hours: None observed
 - Next 24 hours: None predicted

Earthquake Activity: No significant activity

Declaration Activity: None

Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



Tropical Storm Bret (Advisory #7A as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located 75 miles ESE of Isla Margarita
- Moving WNW at 21 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph with higher gusts
- Gradual reduction in forward speed is expected over the next 48 hours
- Forecast to weaken to a tropical depression later today
- Not expected to threaten U.S. or territories at this time

Potential Tropical Cyclone Three (Advisory #3 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located 373 miles south of New Orleans, LA
- Moving NNW at 8 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- Expected to be near the Louisiana coast late Wednesday
- Marginally conducive for additional development during the next day or two; tropical or subtropical cyclone is likely
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (80%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (80%)

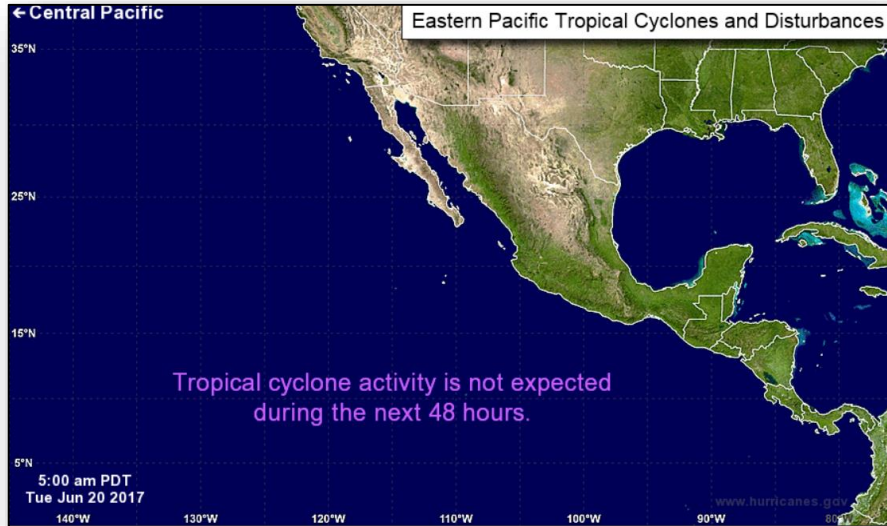

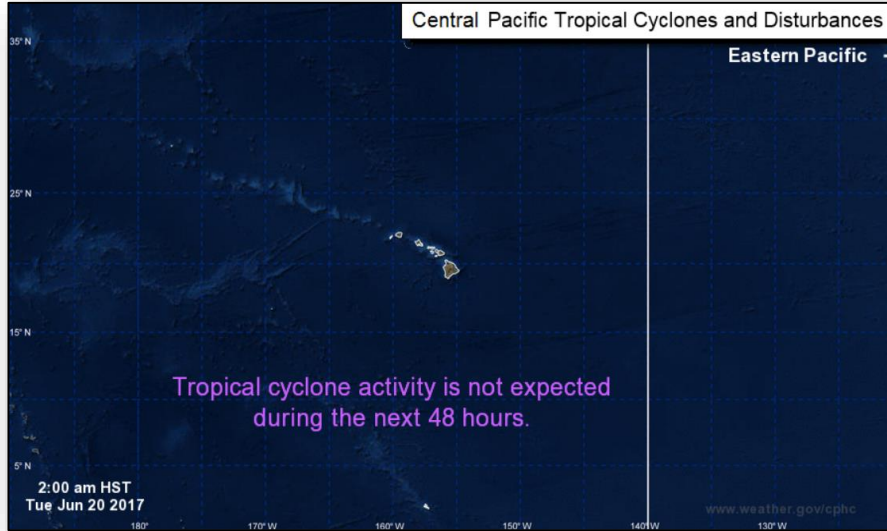


48 Hour Outlook

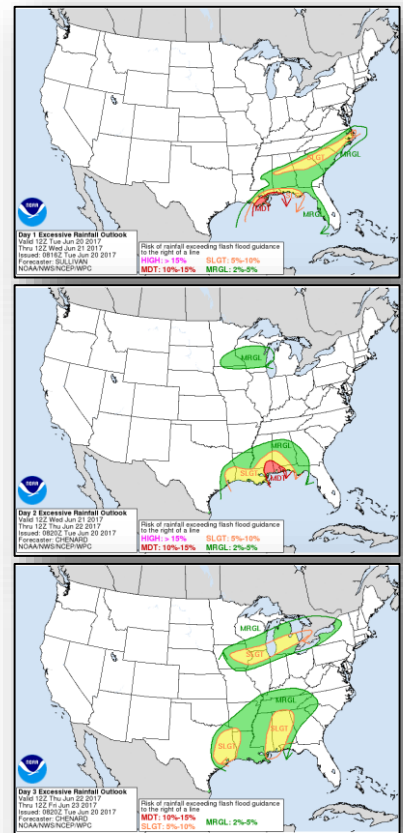
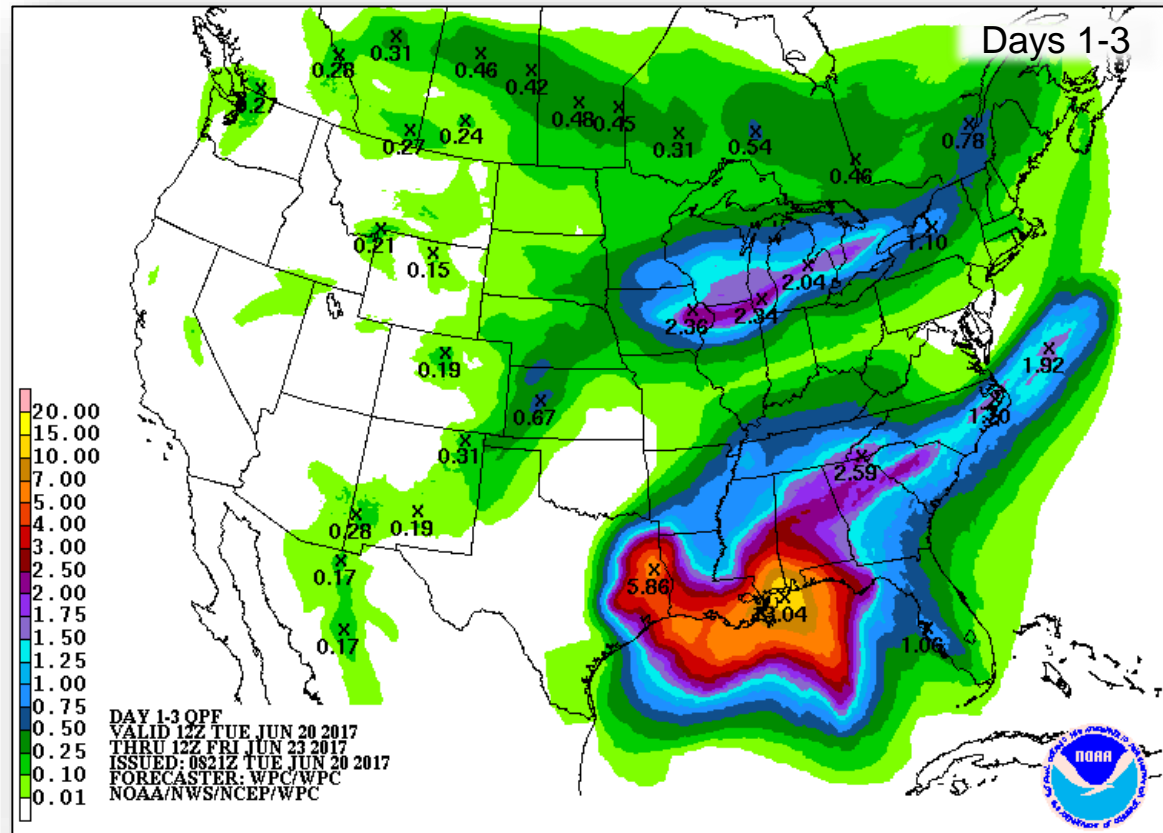

Precipitation Forecast / Flash Flood Risk



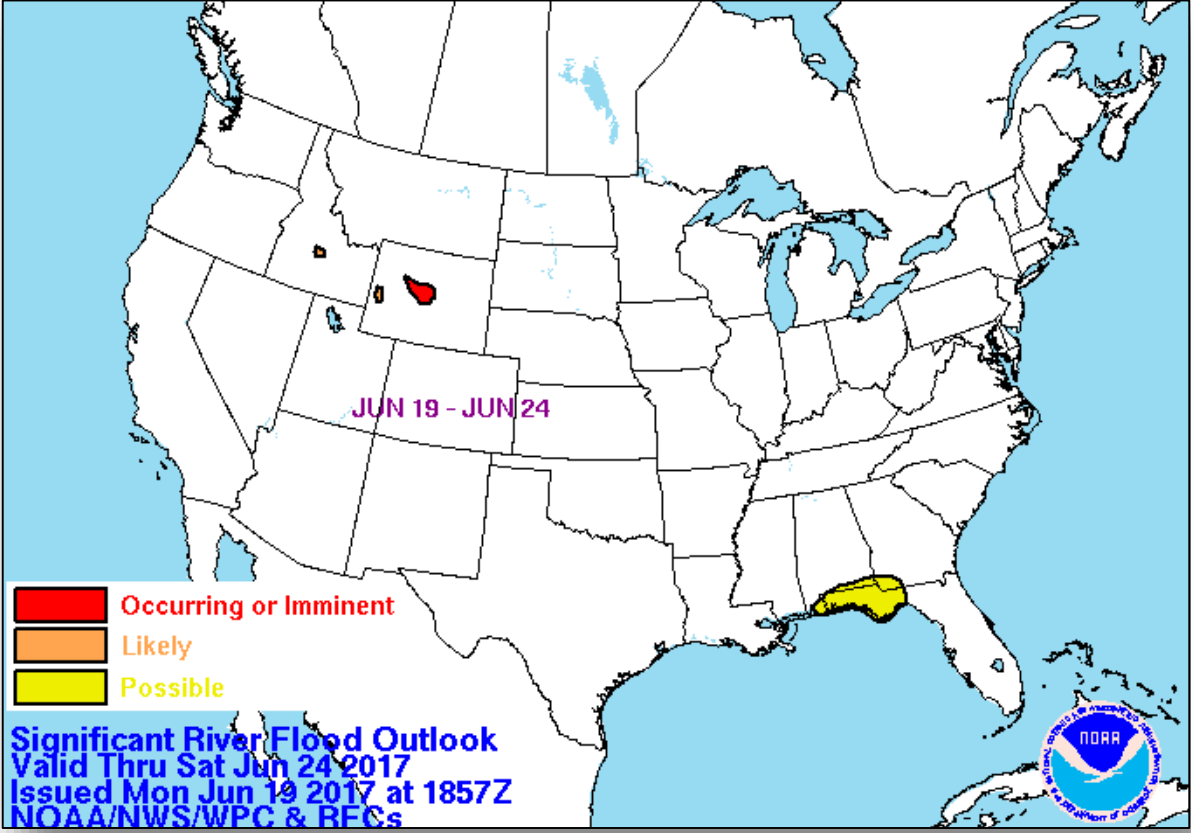
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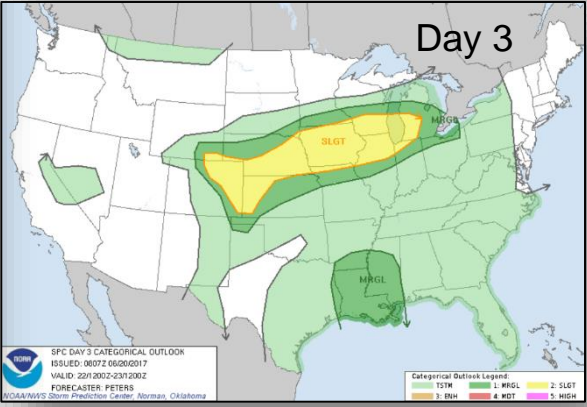
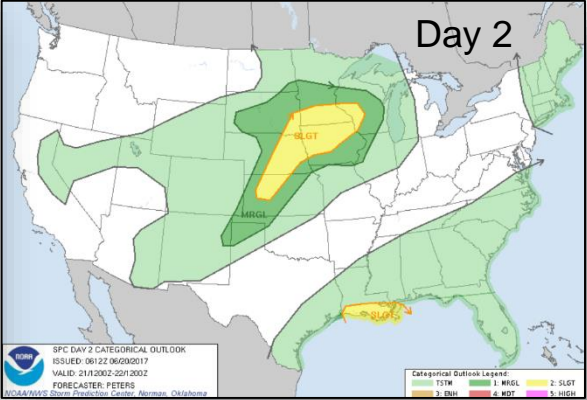
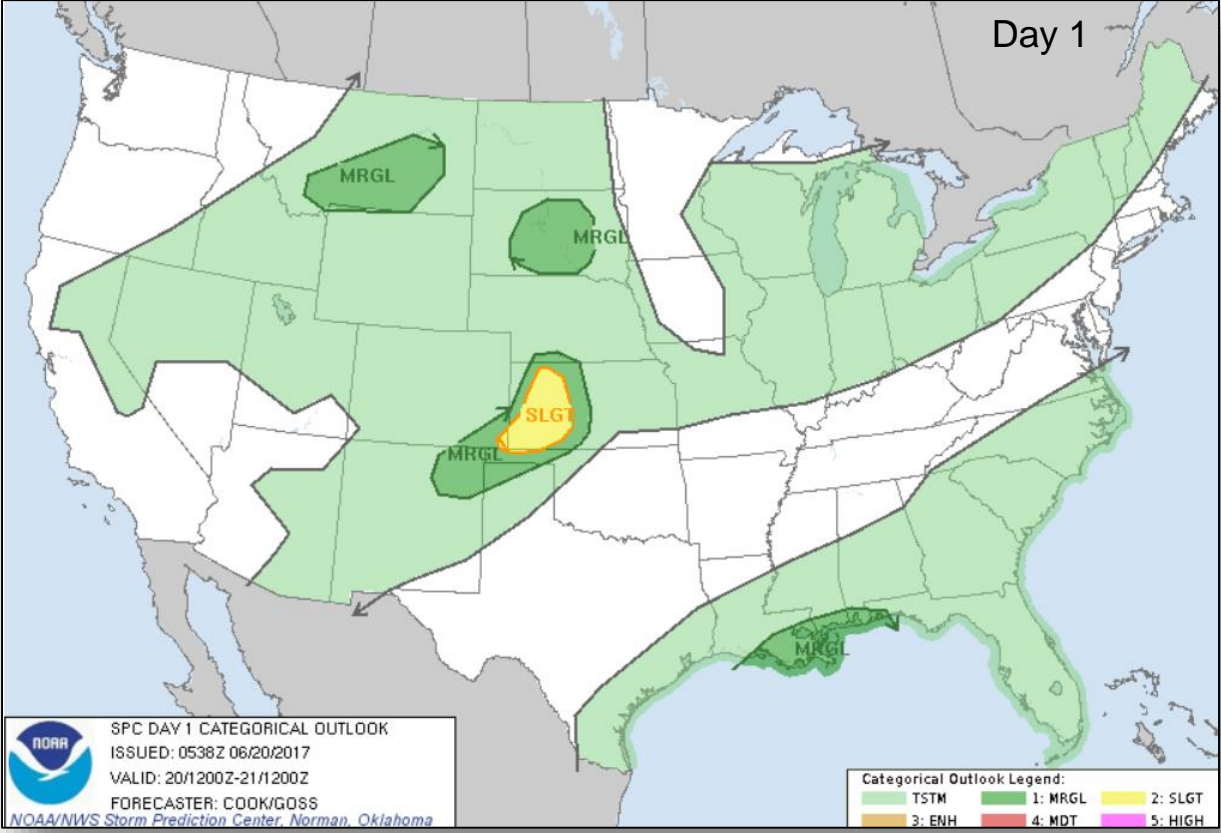
Significant River Flood Outlook



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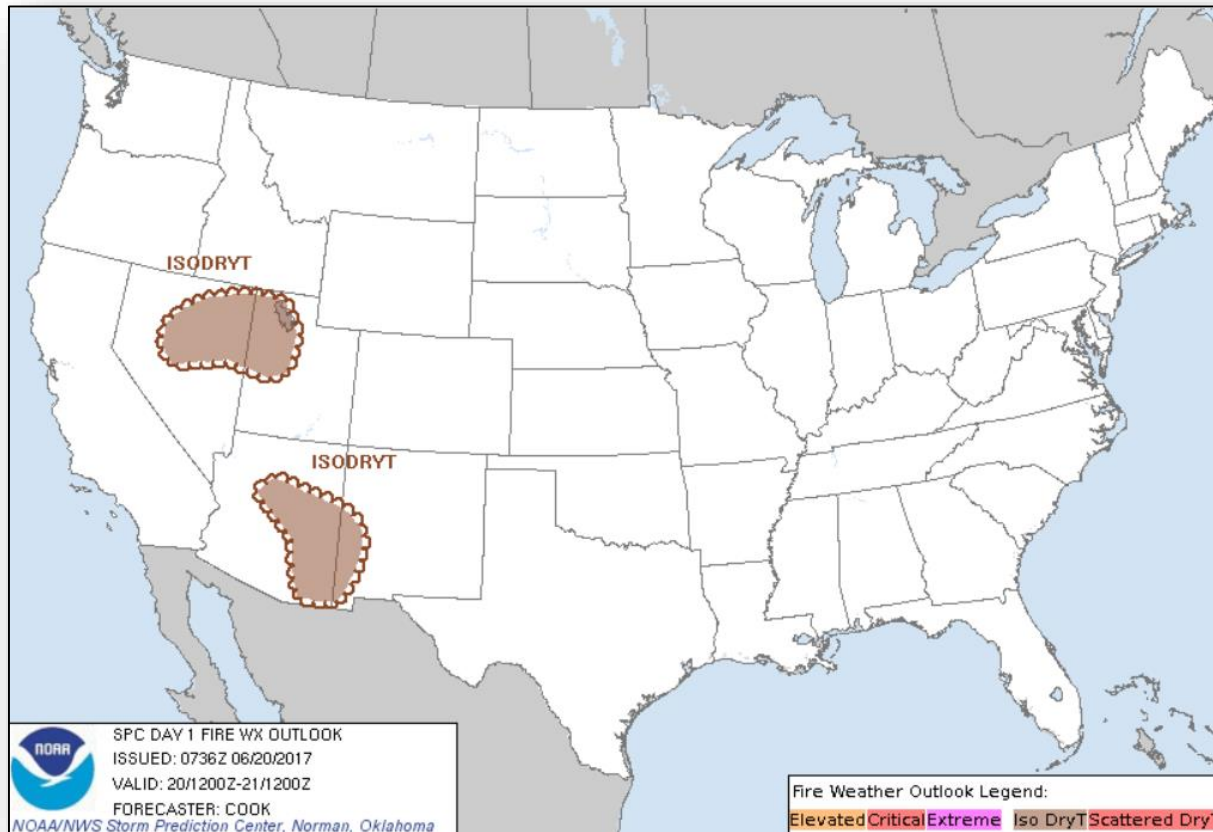
Severe Weather Outlook – Days 1-3



Fire Weather Outlook



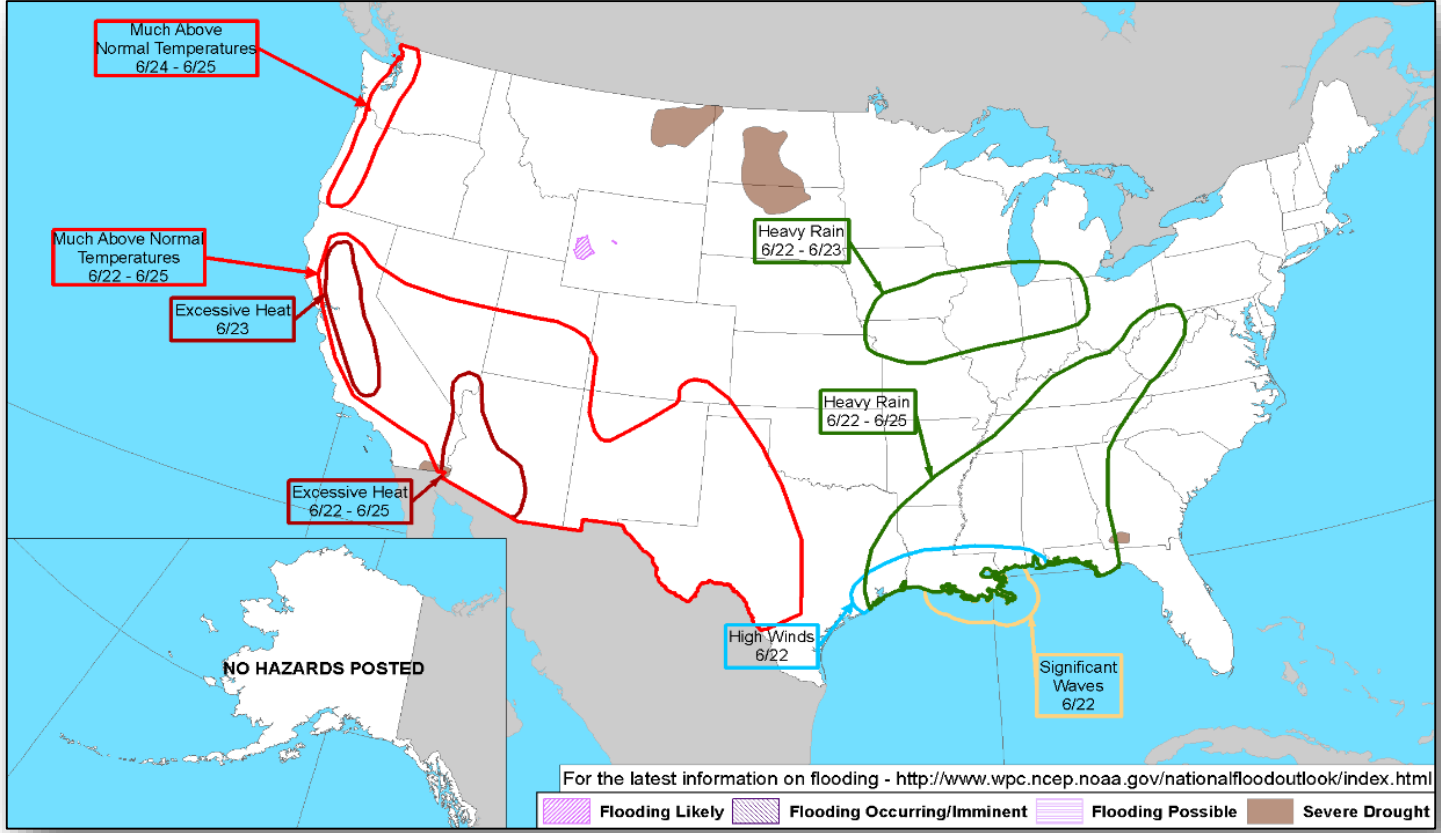

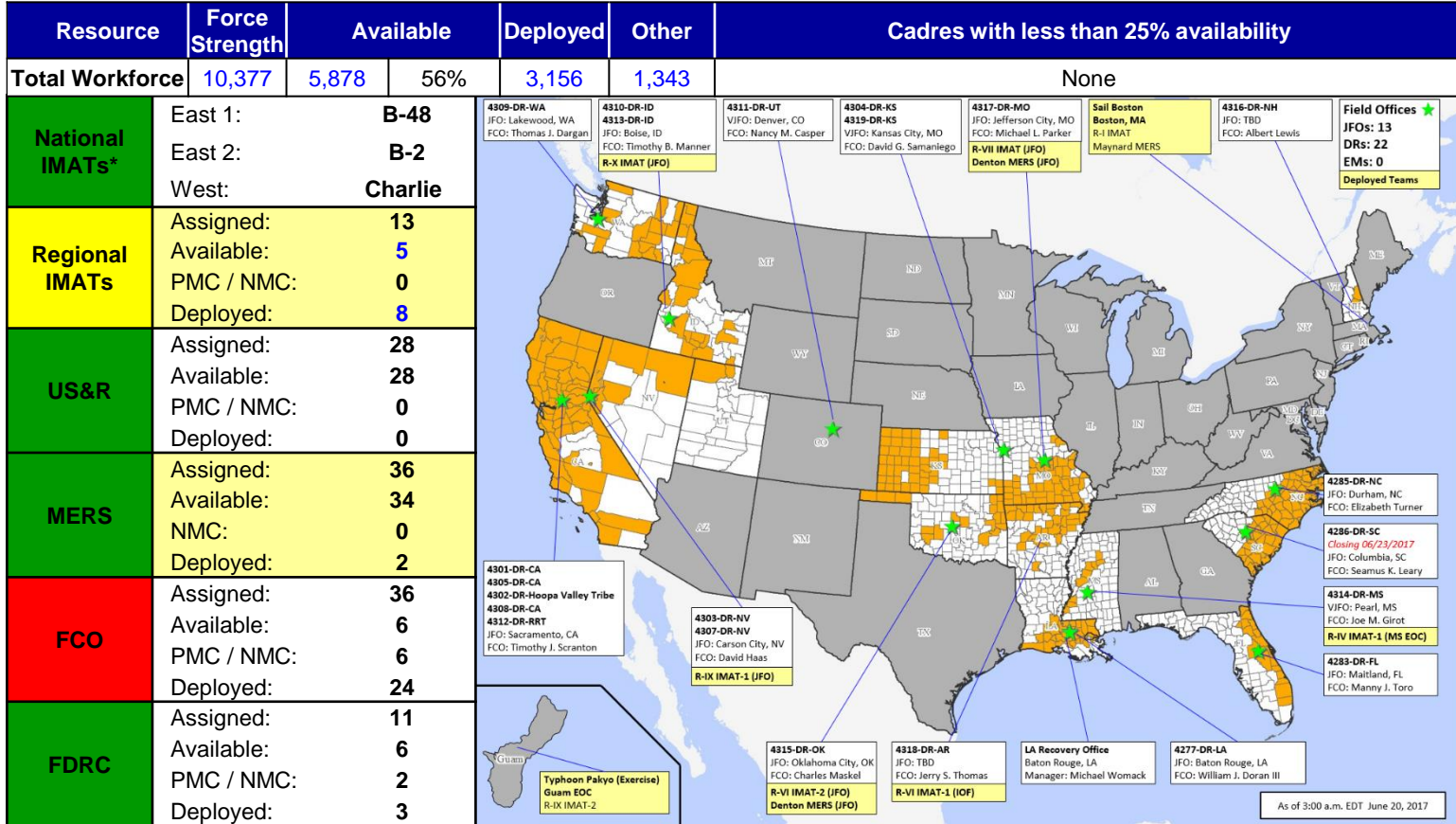

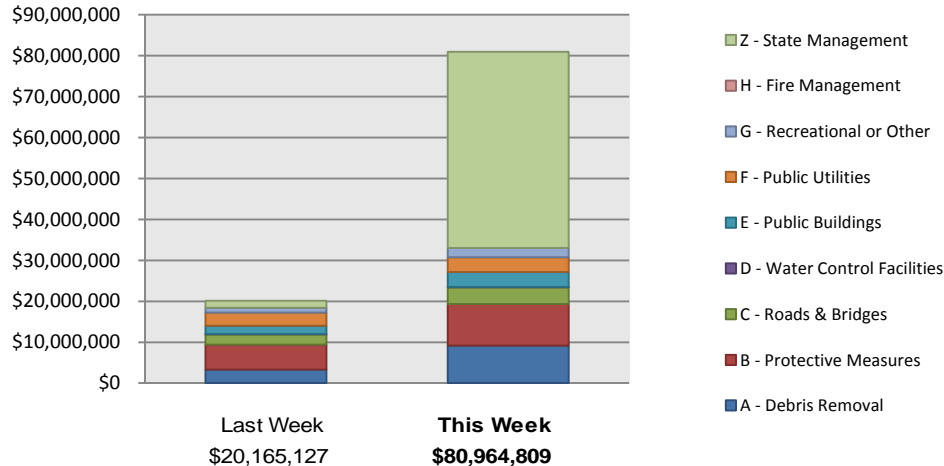

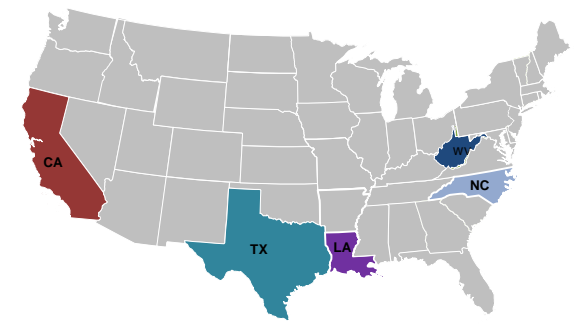

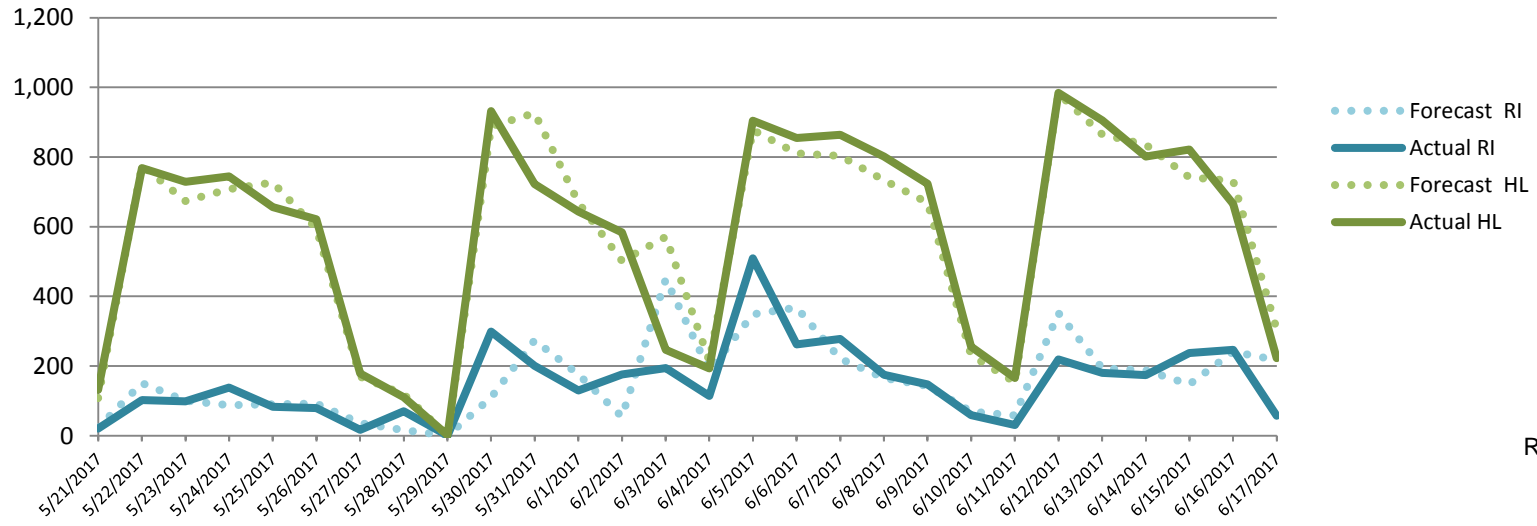

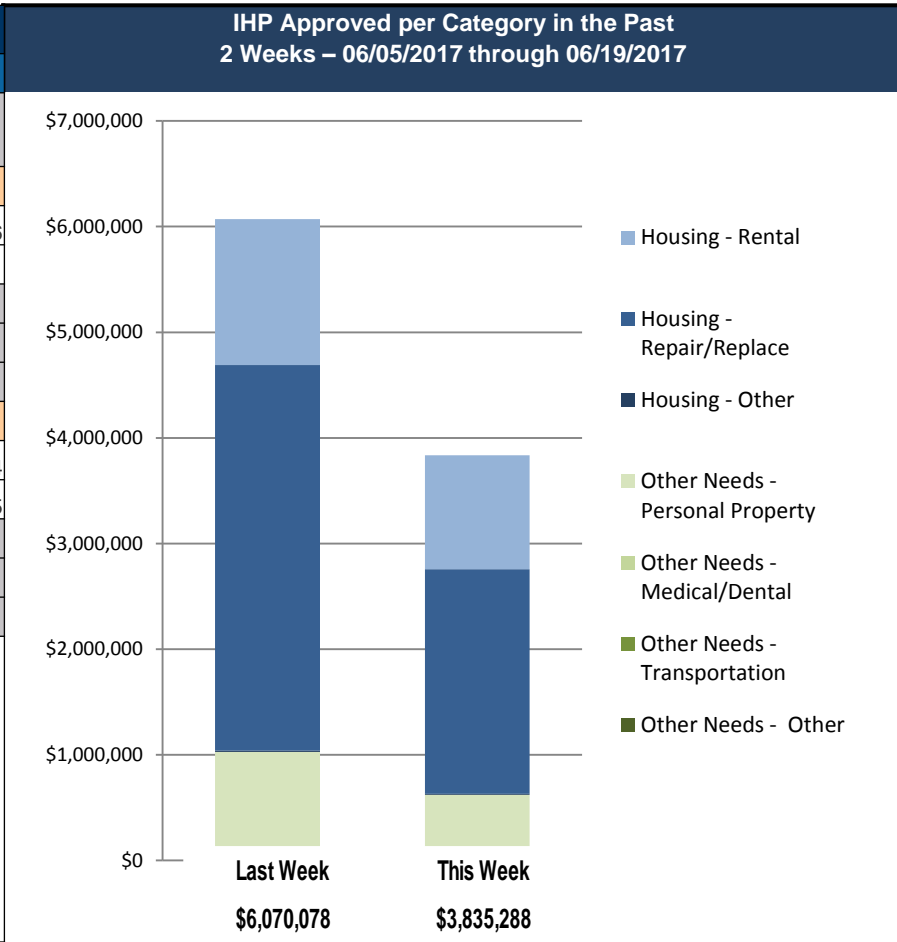
NPSC Call Forecasting and Actual Calls Over the Past 4 Weeks 05/21/2017 through 06/17/2017
