- Space Weather Past 24 hours: none observed; Next 24 hours: none predicted





Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific




Tropical Storm Fernanda (Advisory #6 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

Severe Weather Outlook – Days 1-3










Precipitation Forecast / Flash Flood Risk











Regional River Forecast – Fox & Des Plaines






Significant River Flood Outlook






National Heat Index Forecast








FEMA-4322-DR-NY

- The President approved a Major Disaster Declaration on July 12, 2017
- For Severe Winter Storm and Snowstorm that occurred March 14-17, 2017
- · Provides:
 - Public Assistance for 28 counties, including snow assistance for 27 counties
 - Hazard Mitigation statewide
- The FCO is Seamus K. Leary






Declaration Approved



FEMA-4323-DR-ND

- The President approved a Major Disaster Declaration on June 12, 2017
- For flooding that occurred March 23 April 29, 2017
- · Provides:
 - Public Assistance for 10 counties and the Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Reservation*
 - o Hazard Mitigation for all areas within the state
- The FCO is Thomas J. McCool



^{*} The Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Reservation falls wholly within the boundary of Rolette County


