Significant Activity – July 24-25



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Significant Events: None

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic – No tropical cyclones expected next 48 hours
- Eastern Pacific – Tropical Storm Greg; Hurricane Hilary; Hurricane Irwin
- Central Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests
- Western Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests

Significant Weather:

- Severe thunderstorms – Northern Plains to Great Lakes
- Flash flooding possible – Central Great Basin/Southwest to Central Rockies and Northern Plains to Upper Mississippi Valley
- Significant river flooding – IA and IL
- Isolated dry thunderstorms – CA, OR, NV, ID, ND, and WY
- Space weather:
 - Past 24 hours: None observed
 - Next 24 hours: None predicted

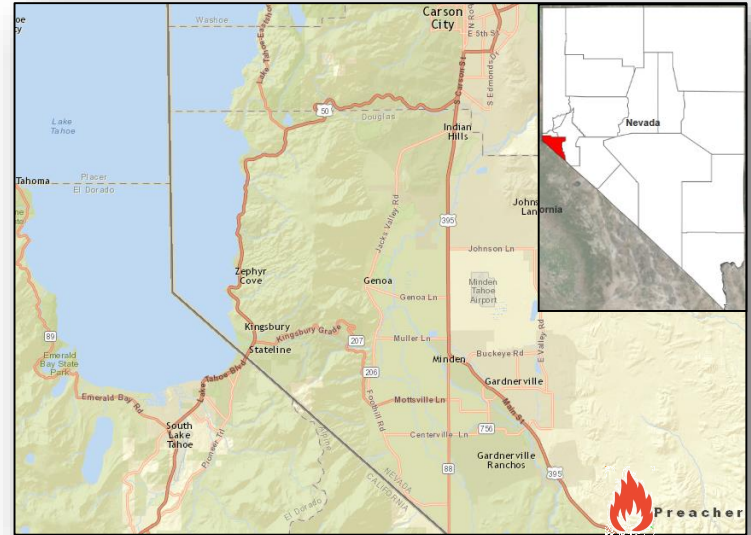

Current Situation

- Fire began July 24, 2017 burning in around community of Gardnerville, NV (pop. 1,350) in Douglas County
- Voluntary evacuations for 1,350 people
- Threatening power substation and watershed for Washoe Tribe

Response

- NV EOC at Partial Activation (for flooding)
- Region IX RWC remains at Steady State

Tropical Storm Greg (Advisory #32 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

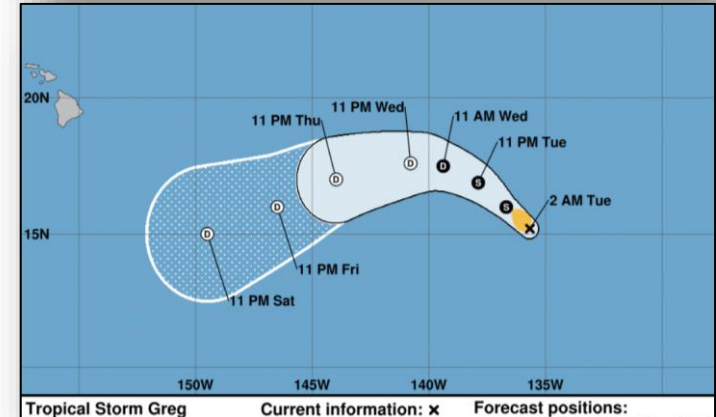
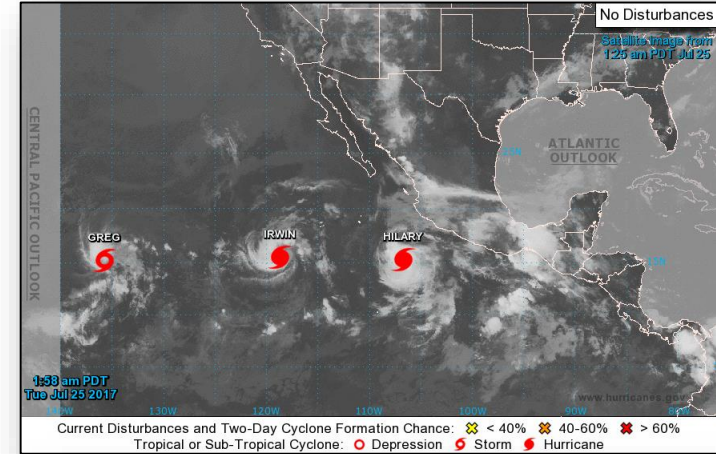
- Located 1,345 miles E of the south point of Hawaii
- Moving WNW at 9 mph; maximum sustained winds 45 mph

Hurricane Irwin (CAT 1) (Advisory #12 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located 770 miles SW of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 5 mph; maximum sustained winds 75 mph
- Little change in strength expected today

Hurricane Hilary (CAT 1) (Advisory #16 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

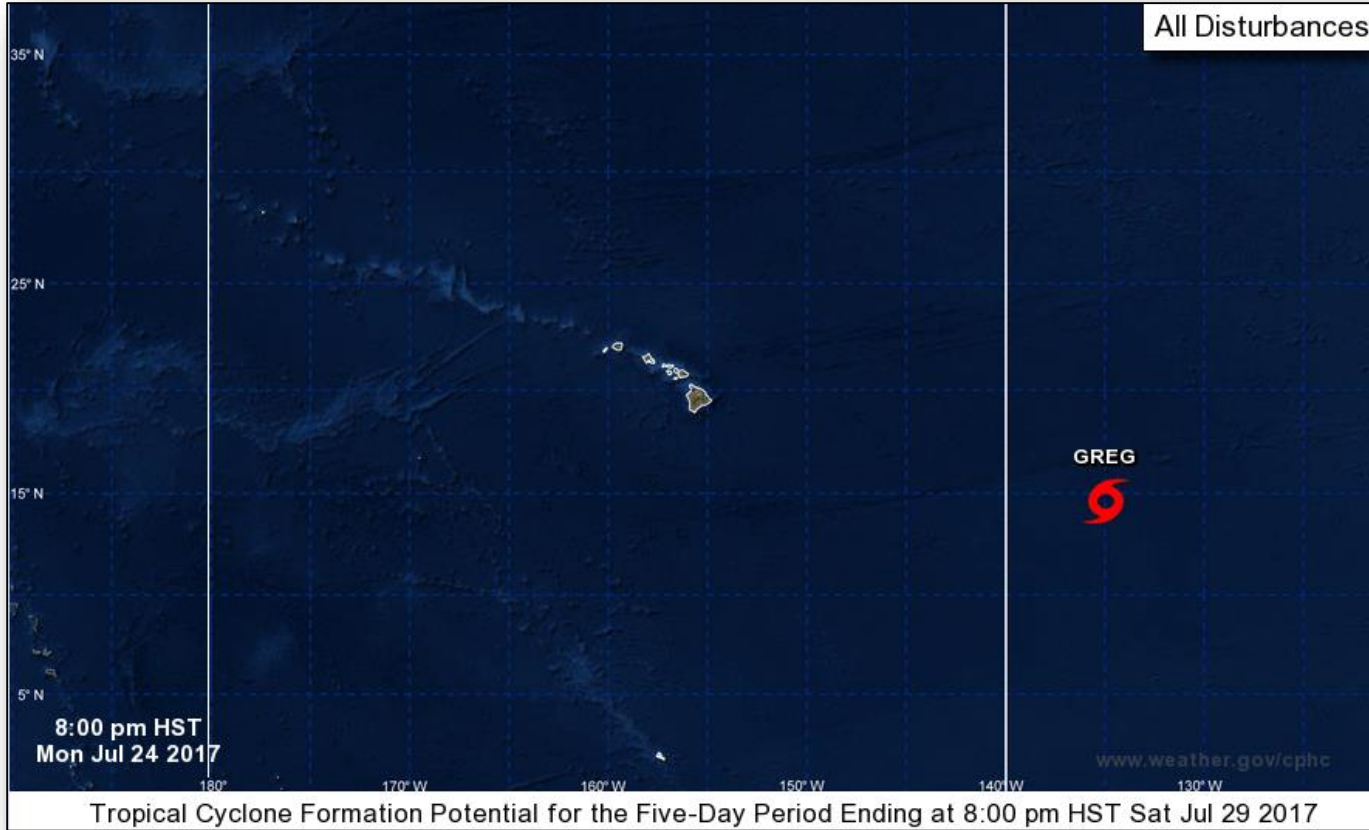
- Located 360 miles S of Cabo Corriethes, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 10 mph; maximum sustained winds 105 mph
- Continue strengthening during next 48 hours; Major hurricane today

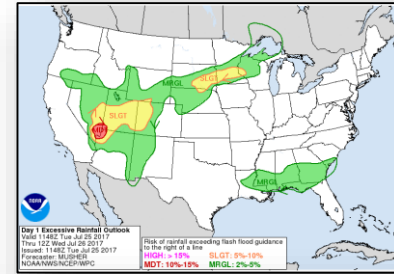
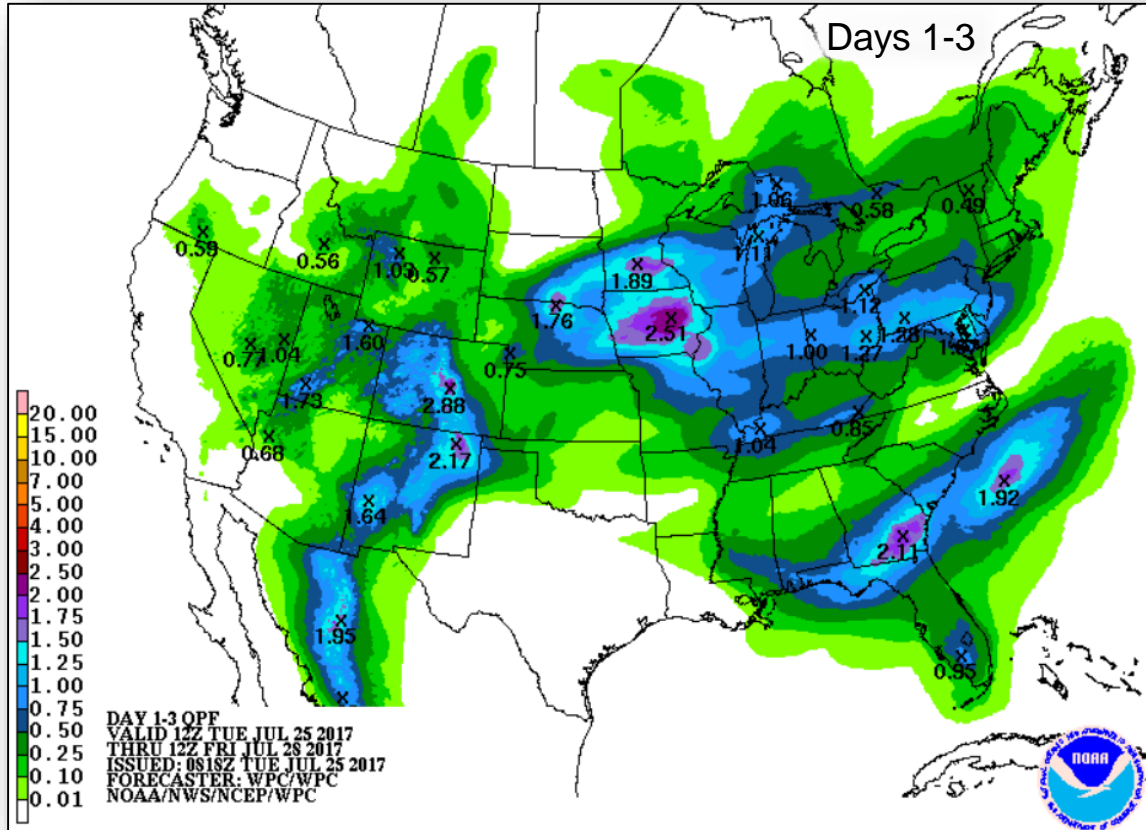
Severe Weather Outlook – Days 1-3



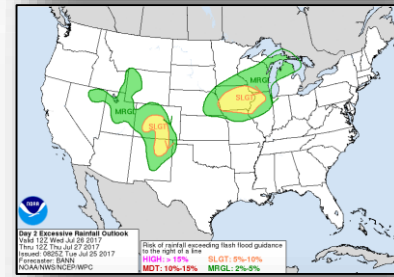
Precipitation Forecast / Flash Flood Risk



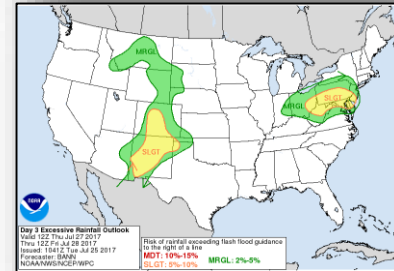

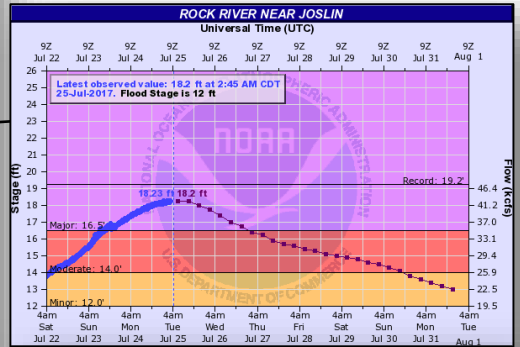
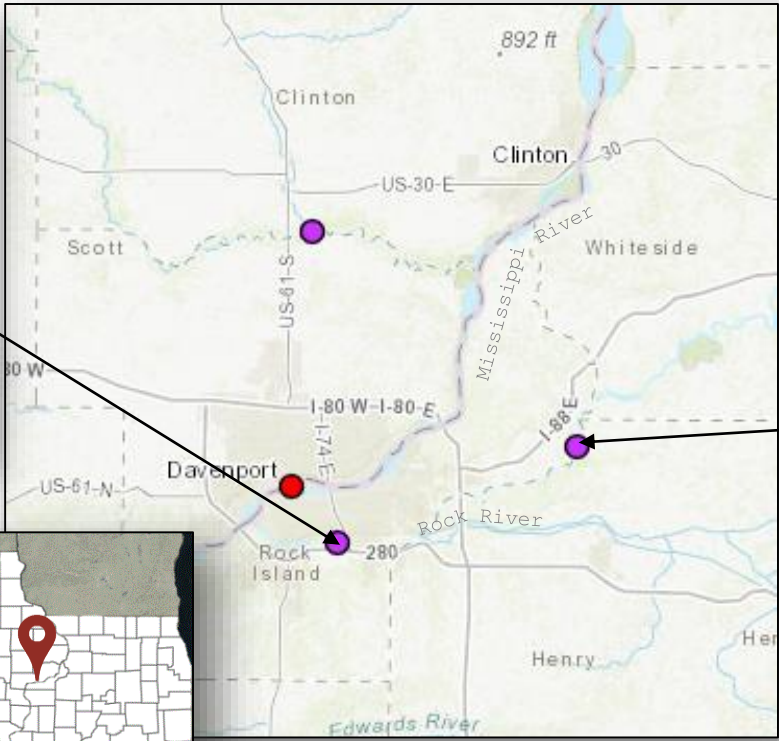
Major River Flooding – Mid-Mississippi Valley

 - Impacts: Numerous roads and several homes impacted by floodwaters in Quad Cities area

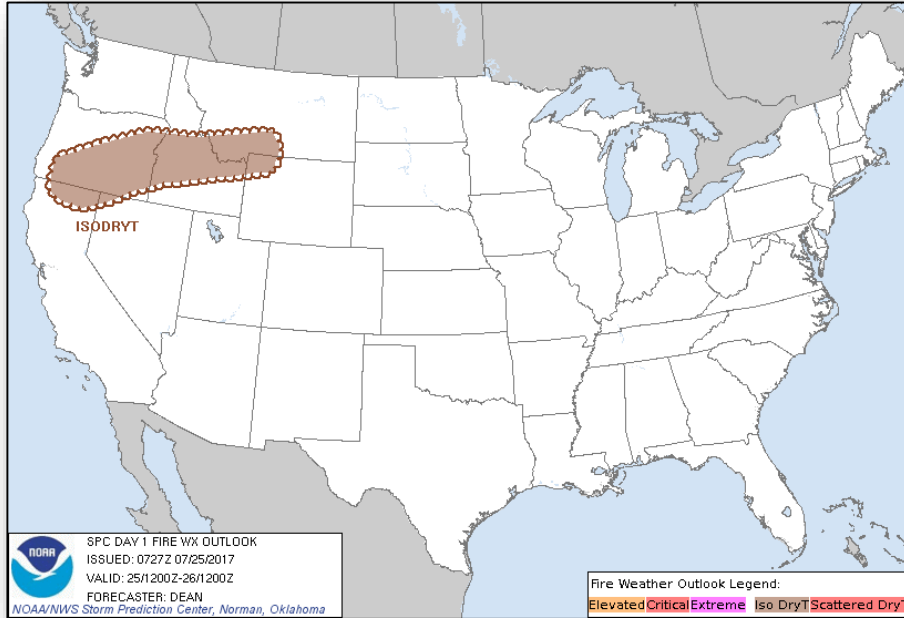


Rock River near Joslin, IL:

 - Impacts: Several secondary roads and a few homes and businesses impacted by flood waters

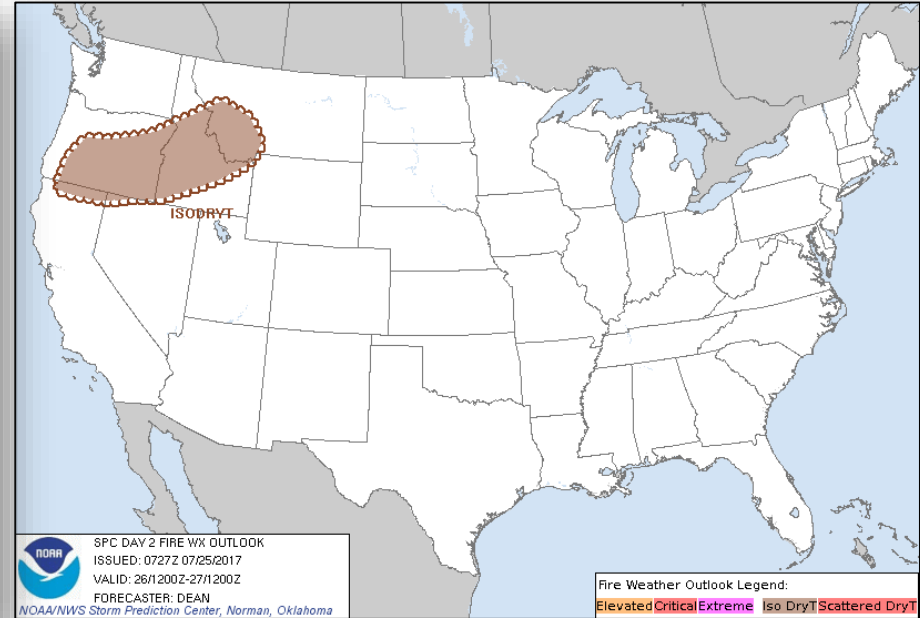

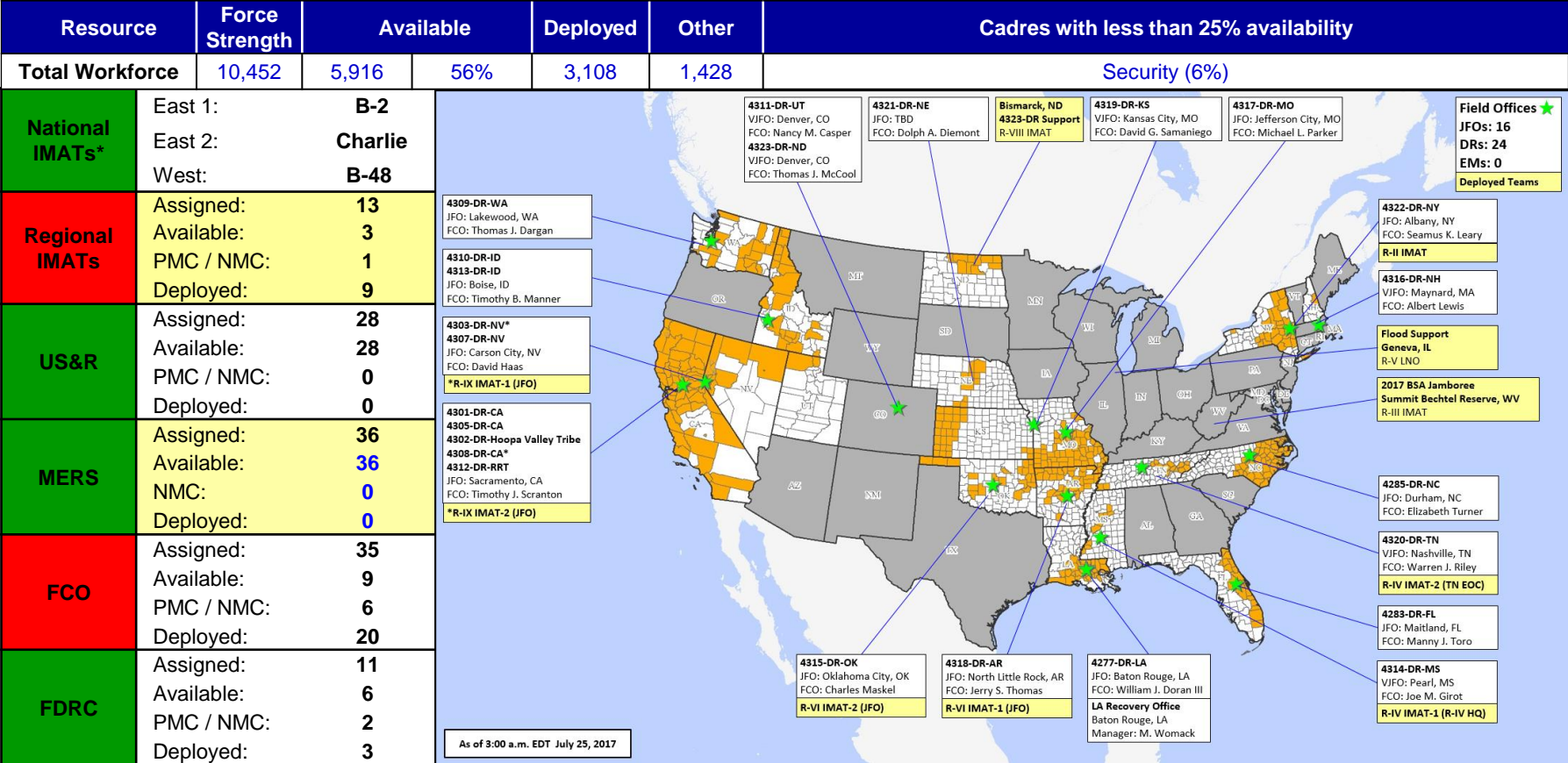
