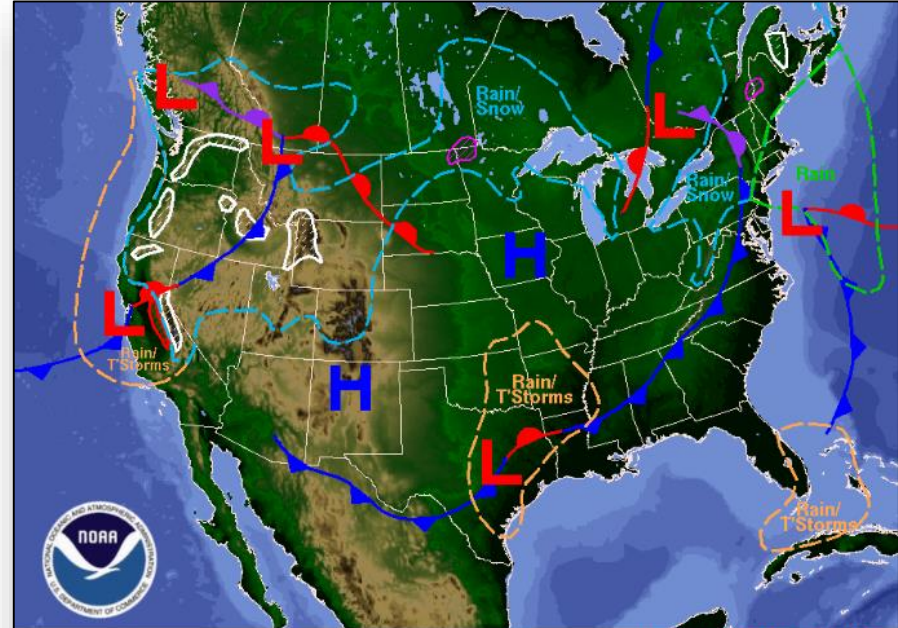

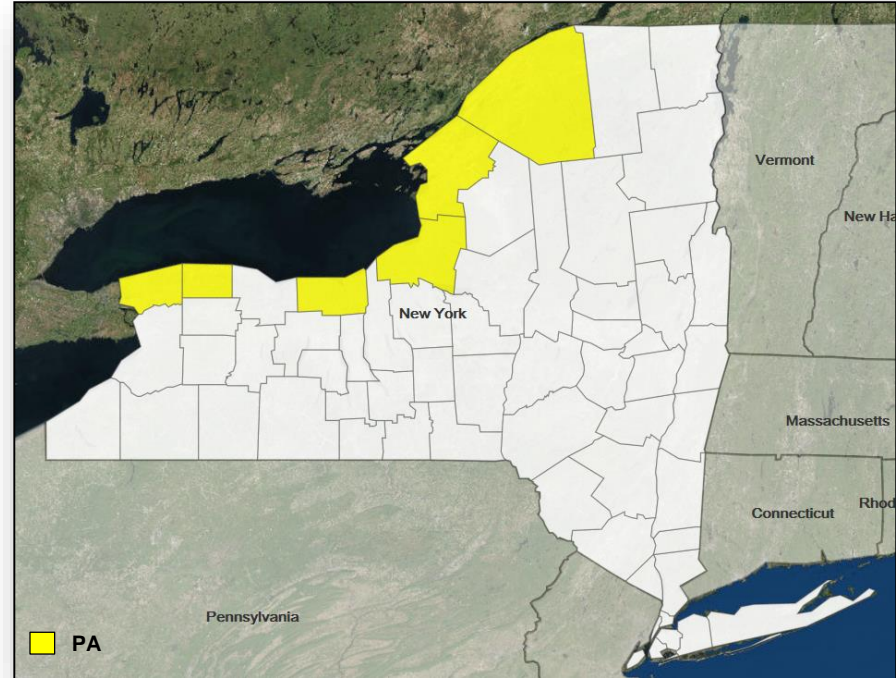


# Declaration Approved
