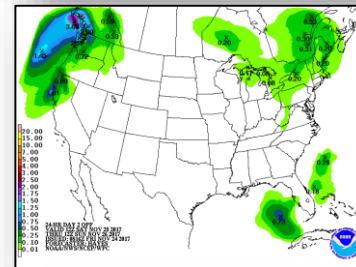
# Precipitation Forecast



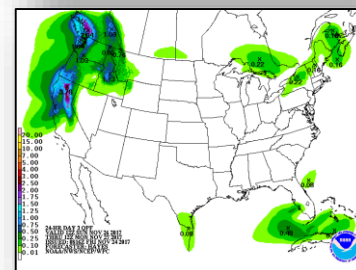
