### Significant Activity – Dec 9 - 10



Significant Events: Wildfires - southern California

#### **Tropical Activity:**

- Critical/Elevated Fire Weather conditions and Red Flag Warnings southern CA and Central/Southern Plains
- Lake Effect Snow possible NY

#### Wildfires – Southern California



#### **Current Situation**

Six active fires are burning in southern California, five of which have FMAGs. The Thomas Fire is the largest with over 155k acres burned. Critical to extreme fire weather conditions expected to persist through early next week.

#### <u>Impacts</u>


- Shelters statewide: 7 (-5) open / 396 (-251) occupants (ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 6:08 a.m. EST)
- Widespread mandatory evacuations remain in effect
- One confirmed fatality reported as a result of the Thomas Fire

#### State/Local Response

- Governor declared a State of Emergency; National Guard deployed
- CA EOC at Full Activation
- NV EOC at Partial Activation (support for CA wildfires)
- UT EOC at Monitoring (support for CA wildfires)

#### FEMA Response

- Emergency Disaster Declaration approved on December 8, 2017
- Region IX RWC at Steady State; RRCC not activated
- Region IX IMAT-2 deployed to CA EOC
- Region IX LNO deployed to Southern Regional EOC
- Defense Coordinating Element activated


















6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability


