• Burning in Santa Barbara county (pop. 445k) and Ventura county (pop. 851k)

Impacts


- Evacuations remain in effect for over 93k residents
- Shelters: 5 (-1) open / 316 (-90) occupants (ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 5:31 a.m. EDT)
- A boil water advisory has been issued for both counties

State/Local Response

- Governor declared a State of Emergency; National Guard deployed
- CA EOC at Full Activation
- NV EOC at Partial Activation
- UT EOC at Monitoring (CA wildfires)

FEMA Response

- Emergency Disaster Declaration approved on December 8, 2017
- Region IX RWC at Steady State; RRCC not activated
- Region IX IMAT-1 & 2 deployed to CA EOC
- Region IX LNO deployed to Southern Regional EOC
- Defense Coordinating Element (DCE) activated







DEBRIS REMOVAL

Collected 1,056,976 CY of Debris (+38,938)

- To date have received 53 RRF's and 46 ROE's
- Debris removal operations are ongoing in 43 municipalities as of 12/10/2017.
- 29 municipalities have indicated they will be performing their own debris removal and do not require assistance from USACE.










Precipitation Forecast








Forecast Snowfall






Fire Weather Outlook








Public Assistance Obligated per Category In the Past 2 Weeks – 11/27/2017 through 12/11/2017




