Current Situation

• Burning in Santa Barbara county (pop. 445k) and Ventura county (pop. 851k)

Impacts


- · Evacuations remain in effect for over 93k residents
- Shelters: 4 (-1) open / 294 (-22) occupants (ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 5:31 a.m. EDT)
- A boil water advisory has been issued for both counties

State/Local Response

- Governor declared a State of Emergency; National Guard deployed
- CA EOC at Full Activation
- NV EOC at Partial Activation
- UT EOC at Monitoring (CA wildfires)

FEMA Response

- Emergency Disaster Declaration approved on December 8, 2017
- Region IX RWC at Steady State; RRCC not activated
- Region IX IMAT-1 & 2 deployed to CA EOC
- Region IX LNO deployed to Southern Regional EOC
- Defense Coordinating Element (DCE) activated















Forecast Snowfall






Fire Weather Outlook


