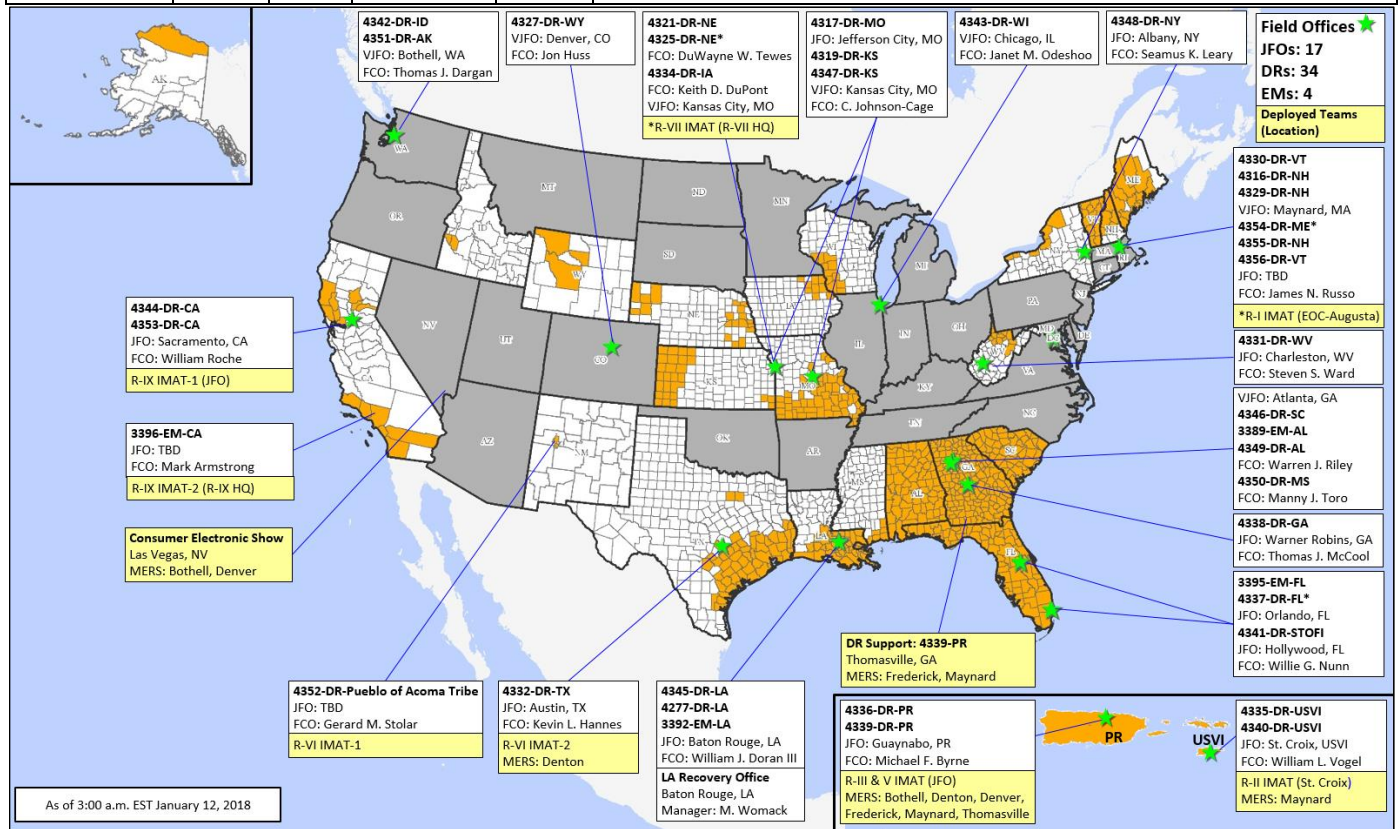

## Monitoring / Potential Future Operations

### *Flooding / Mudslides, Southern CA*

#### Situation

No rain is forecast for several days; the risk of additional damage from mudslides remains in burn scar areas in southern California.

#### Impacts

- Fatalities: 17 confirmed
- Road closures: Portions of four state highways in Santa Barbara County, multiple state routes in Santa Barbara and Los Angeles counties, and portions of U.S. Highway 101 remain closed
- Union Pacific Rail Subdivision between Santa Barbara and Carpinteria service is suspended
- In Montecito, a natural gas and water shut-off is affecting 13,500 people



#### State/Local Response

- CA EOC is at Full Activation (24/7), with select ESFs activated; Southern REOC is at Partial Activation
- Santa Barbara County declared a Local Emergency and the County EOC is at Full Activation (24/7)
- Elements of CA TF-2, TF-5, TF-6, and TF-8 are supporting response; two Canine Search Mission Ready Packages deployed to Santa Barbara County
- Mandatory Evacuations in effect for 29,379 residents in Santa Barbara County
- Shelters: Three open with 57 occupants (*Region IX DSAR, January 11, 2018*)
- A Boil Water Notice continues for Montecito Water District customers

#### FEMA Response

- FEMA-4353-DR-CA for wildfires was expanded to include flooding, mud flows and debris flows
- FEMA Region IX RWC is monitoring; LNOs deployed to Santa Barbara and Ventura County EOCs
- FEMA NWC is monitoring

*Tropical Cyclones / Western Pacific:* No activity affecting U.S. interests

#### *Significant Weather:*

- Heavy snow expected for the Cascades, Northern Rockies, and portions of the Northern Plains
- Winter storm unfolding in the Midwest will move eastward from the Mississippi Valley into New England
- A swath of freezing rain is forecast to span from the Lower Mississippi Valley to the Northeast
- Rain and embedded thunderstorms from the Southeast into the Mid-Atlantic over the next couple of days
- Heavy rains expected near coastal New England and NY; flooding possible due to rain and melting ice
