Significant Activity – Mar 3-4



#### Significant Events:

Northeast coastal storm

#### **Tropical Activity:**

Western Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests

#### Significant Weather:

- Heavy snow and strong winds Central Great Basin to Northern/Central Plains
- Freezing rain possible Northern Plains and Upper Mississippi Valley
- Extreme/Critical/Elevated fire weather conditions & Red Flag Warnings NM, CO, NE, KS, OK, TX, and FL
- Space Weather: Past 24 hours: None observed; Next 24 hours: None predicted

Earthquake Activity: No significant activity

Declaration Activity: Major Disaster Declaration approved for American Samoa

### Northeast Coastal Storm – March 1-4



#### **Situation**

Threat from a Powerful Nor'easter continues to diminish; minor to moderate coastal flooding continued along the NJ, NY, and southern New England coast for the Saturday night high tide cycle – water levels are falling

#### Impacts


- Fatalities: Confirmed in VA (2) and MD (1); Unconfirmed (6) in MA, NJ, NY, and MD
- Power outages trending down from previous report (as of 8:00 a.m. EST)\*
- Structures damaged by coastal flooding, backwater inundation & high winds
- · Delays/cancellations reported across impacted regions for air/rail/ports
- Numerous road closures due to downed trees and power lines

#### State/Local Response

- MD, MA & VA Governors declared a State of Emergency
- MA EOC at Full Activation; National Guard activated
- PA & NJ EOCs at Partial Activation
- MD, NY, DE, & VA EOCs at Monitoring
- CT, NH, & RI EOCs returned to Normal Operations
- Shelters open/occupants: MA 5/105, NY 18/1, PA 11/153, MD 2/7, VA 1/1, WV 1/2

#### FEMA Response

- FEMA Regions I-III are monitoring the situation
- Region I LNO returned from MA EOC
- Region III IMAT and LNOs on alert
- FEMA NWC rostered Enhanced Watch




#### Customers without Power FEMA Regions I, II, & III\*




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

### **Precipitation Forecast**










### Significant River Flood Outlook









6-10 Day Temperature Probability





6-10 Day Precipitation Probability


