# Nor'easter Mar 6 & Continuing



#### **Situation**

The Nor'easter continues to spread snow into the Northeast, moving parallel to the New England coast today, then westward into ME and then gradually weakening.

#### **Impacts**


- · 1 unconfirmed fatality in NY
- Customers without Power\*: CT: 136k; MA: 319k; NJ: 245k; NY: 150k; PA: 77k
- Shelters / Occupants: NY 15/53; PA 4/91 (ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 5:31 a.m. EST)
- Over 2,500 flights canceled in the last 24 hours on the Northeast corridor (FlightAware as of 1:35 a.m. EST)
- AMTRAK temporarily suspended northeast corridor service between NYC and Boston until 10:00 a.m. EST
- Widespread road closures due to downed trees & power lines in northern NJ

### State/Local Response

- Governors of MD, NJ, PA, & VA have declared a state of emergency
- NY State, NH, CT, & MA EOC at Partial Activation
- MD & NJ EOCs at Monitoring
- PA & DE EOC returned to normal operations

### FEMA Response


- FEMA Region III LNOs deployed to PA EOC

- FEMA NWC monitoring





## Winter Precipitation Outlook








Forecast Snowfall

Forecast Ice Accumulation




## Significant River Flood Outlook
