- Space Weather – Past 24 hours: none; Next 24 hours: minor – geomagnetic storms reaching G1 level are expected

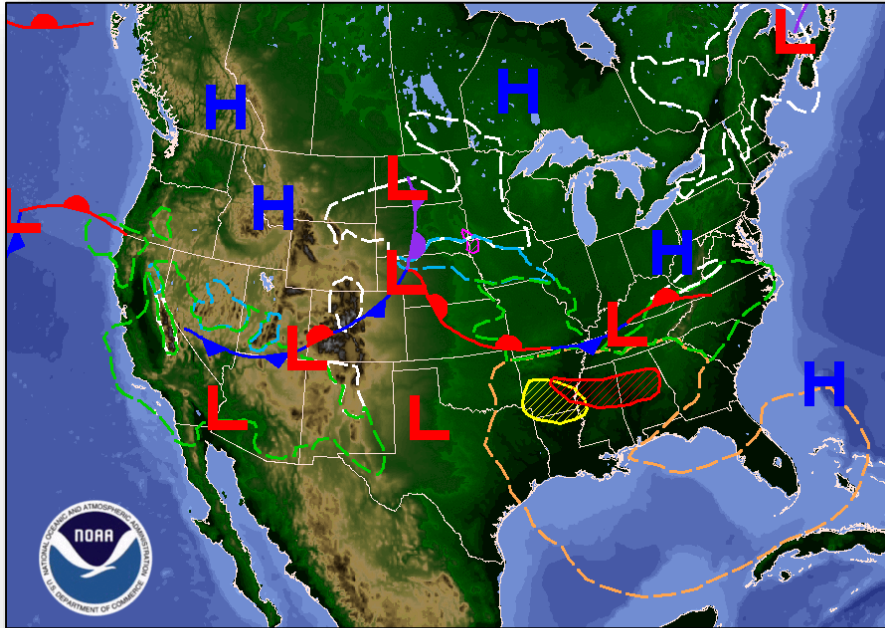

National Weather Forecast



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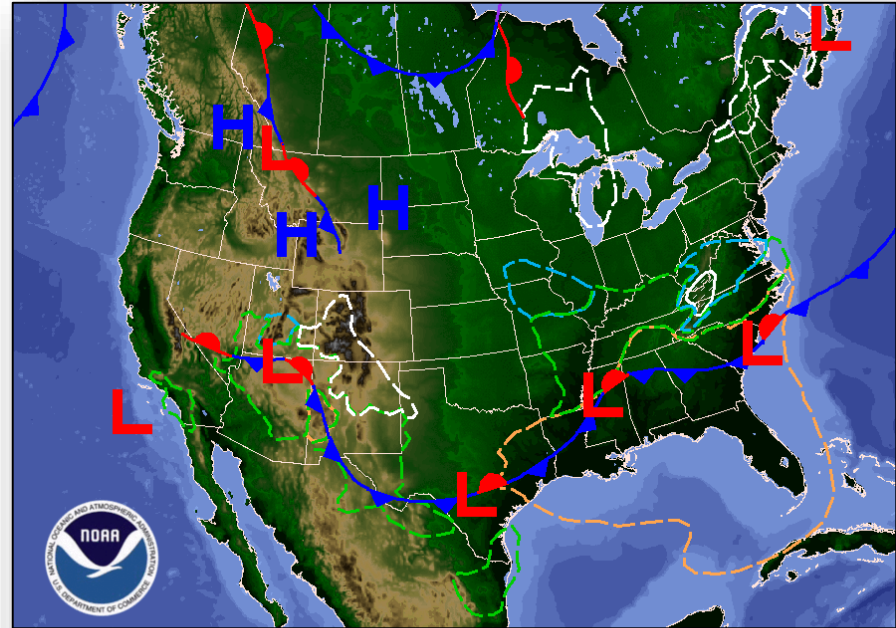


Day 1 National Forecast Chart

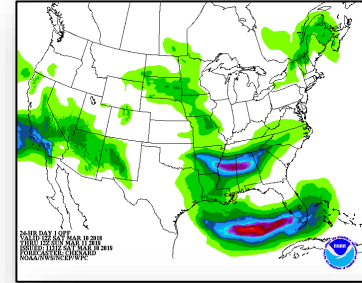
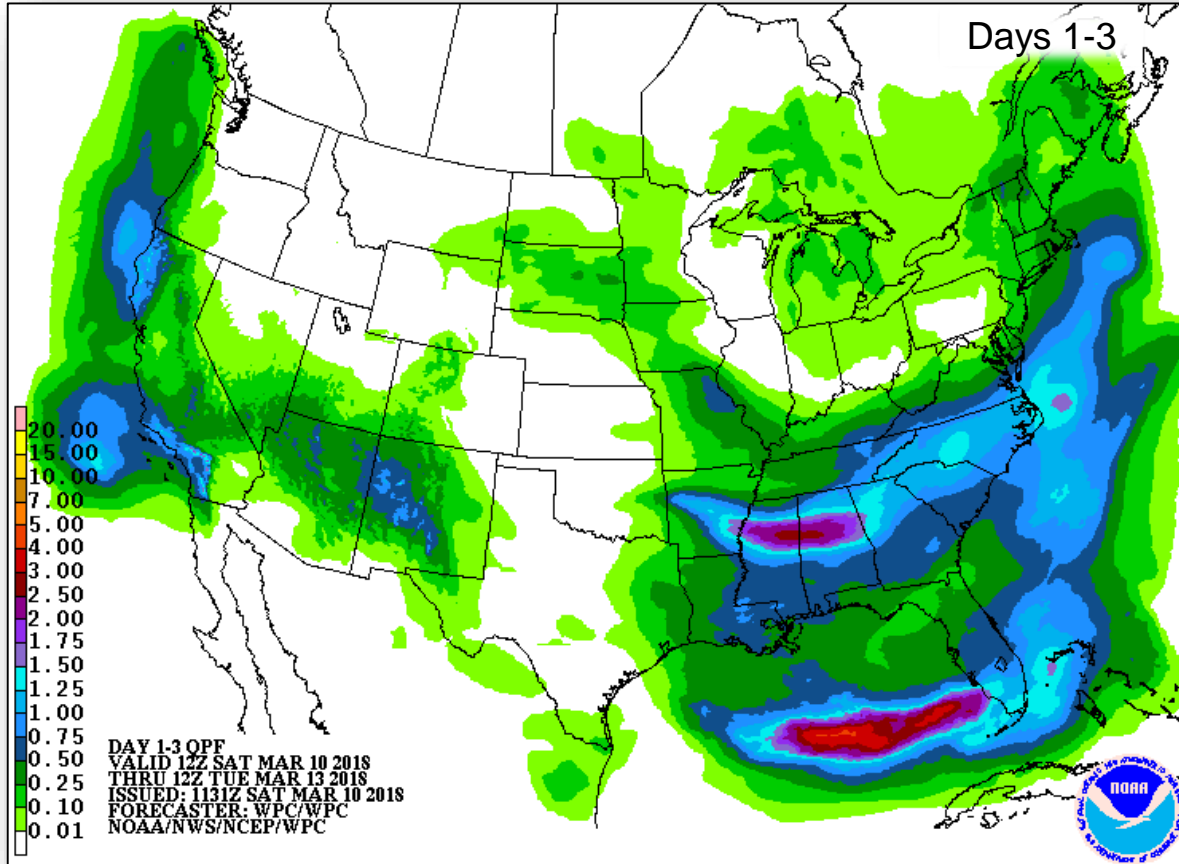

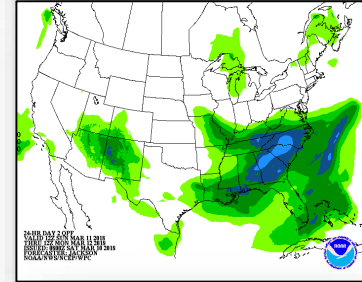
Precipitation Forecast



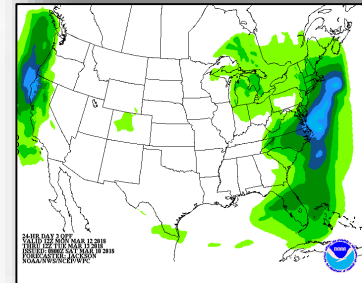

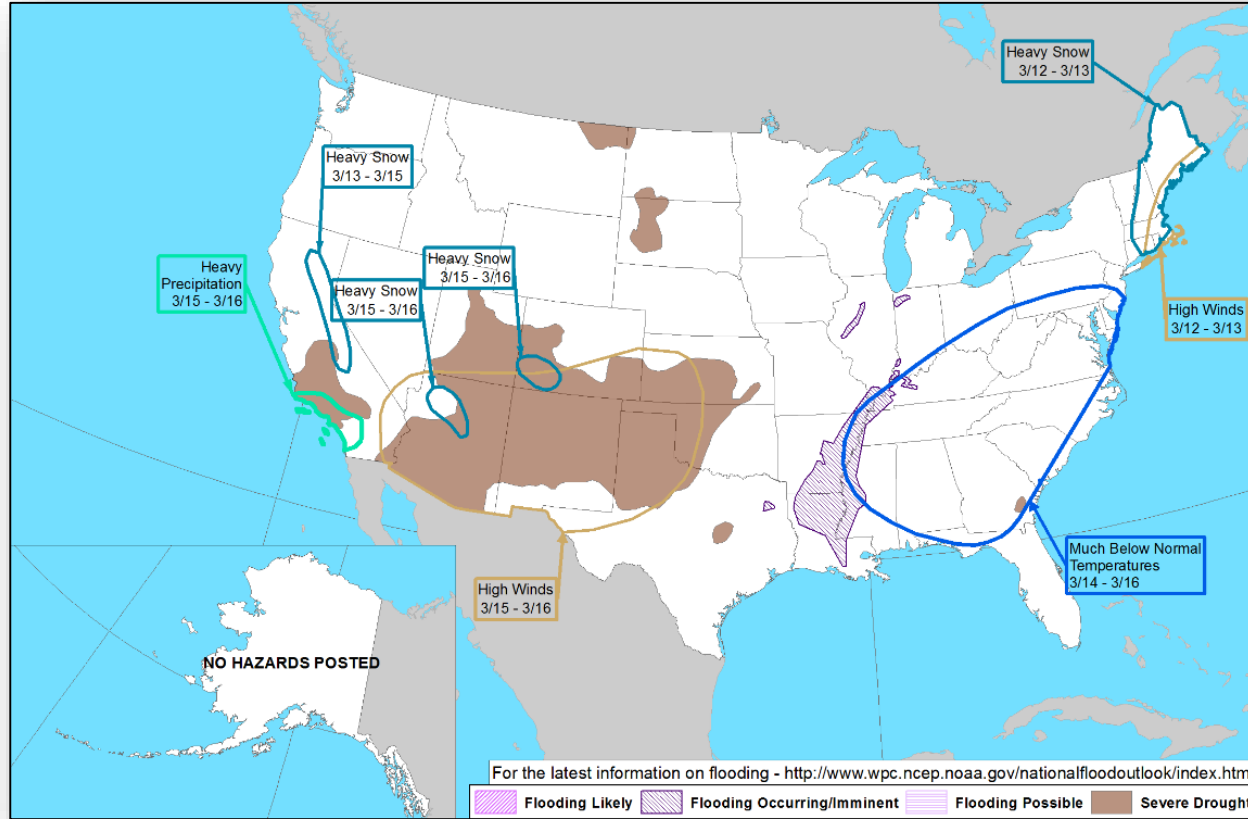
Severe Weather Outlook – Days 1-3



Hazards Outlook – Mar 12-16



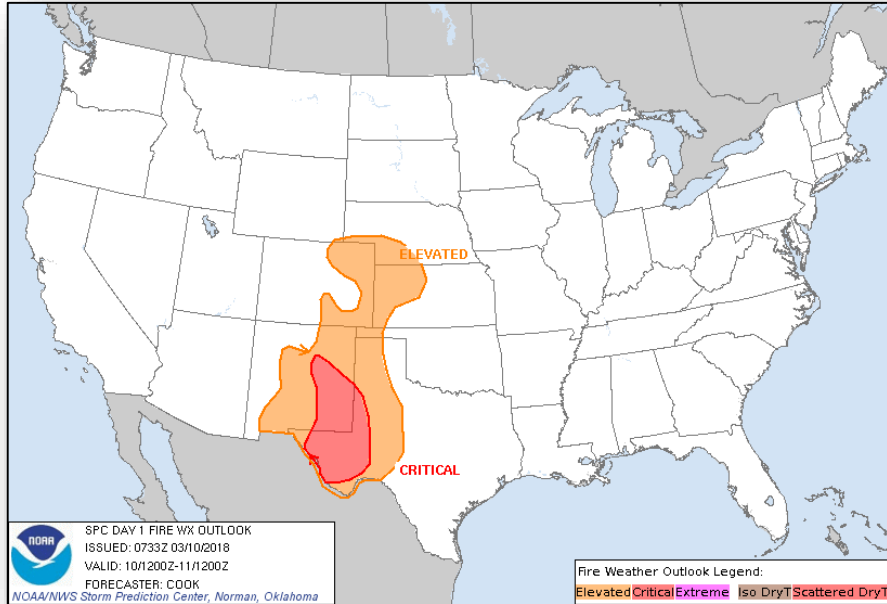
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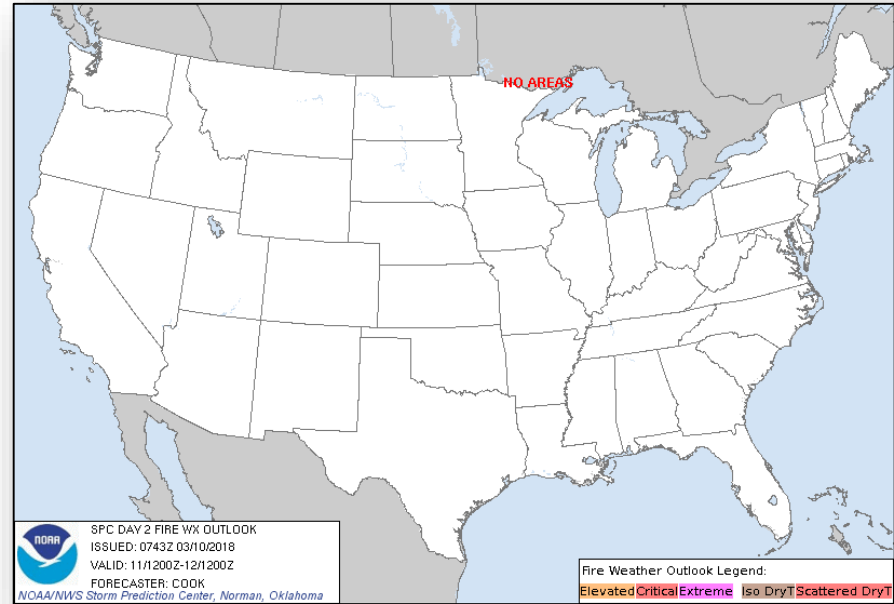

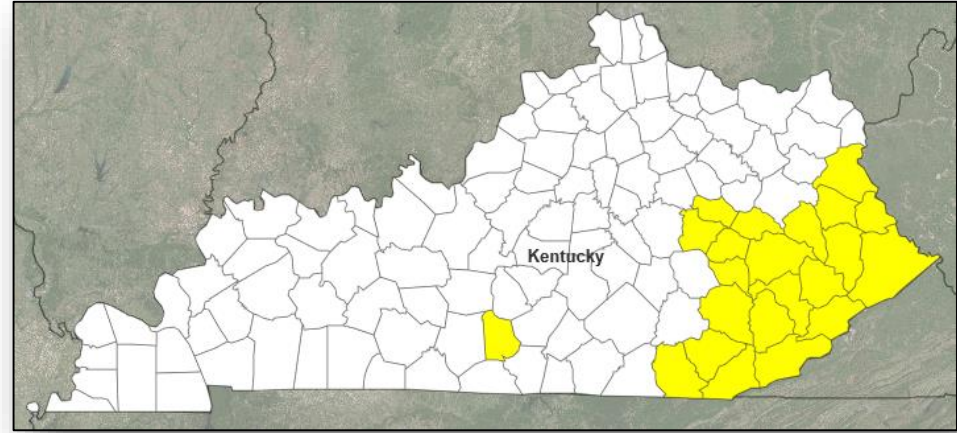
Declaration Request
