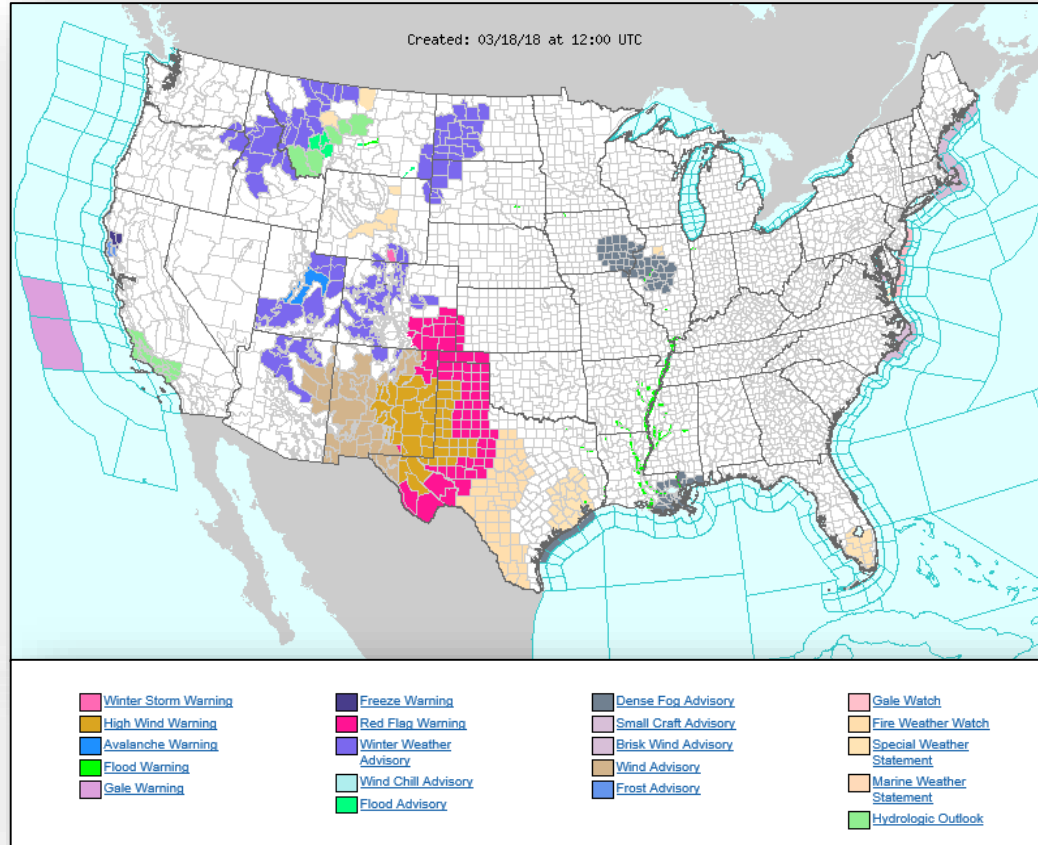

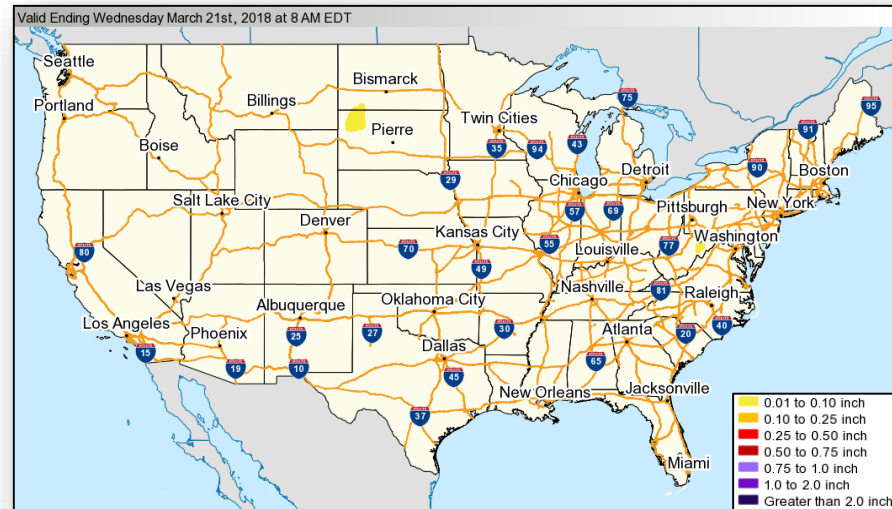
# Winter Precipitation Outlook

***Forecast Snowfall***



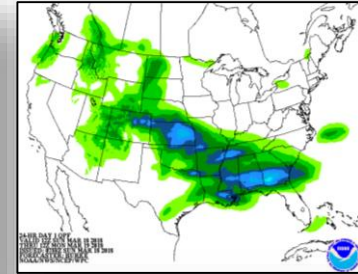
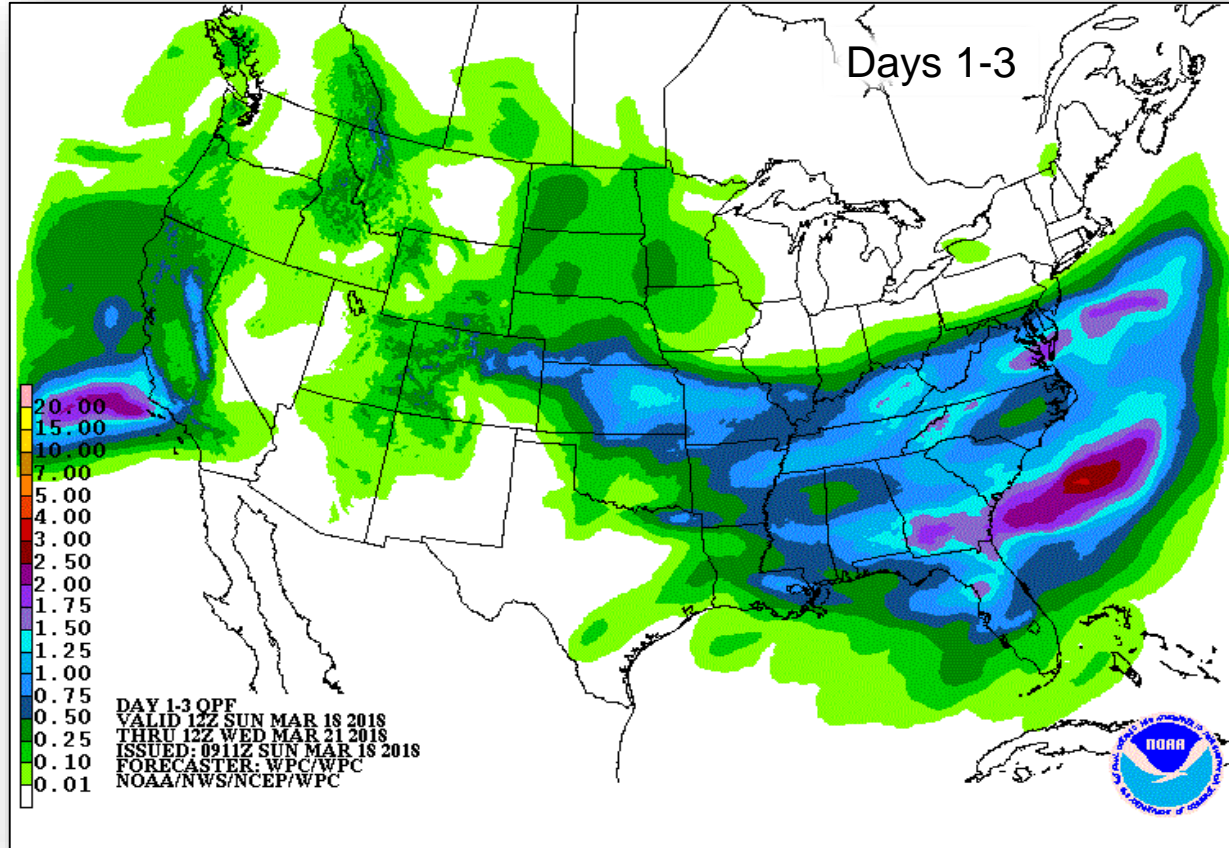
***Forecast Ice Accumulation***



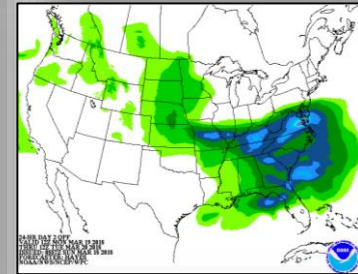

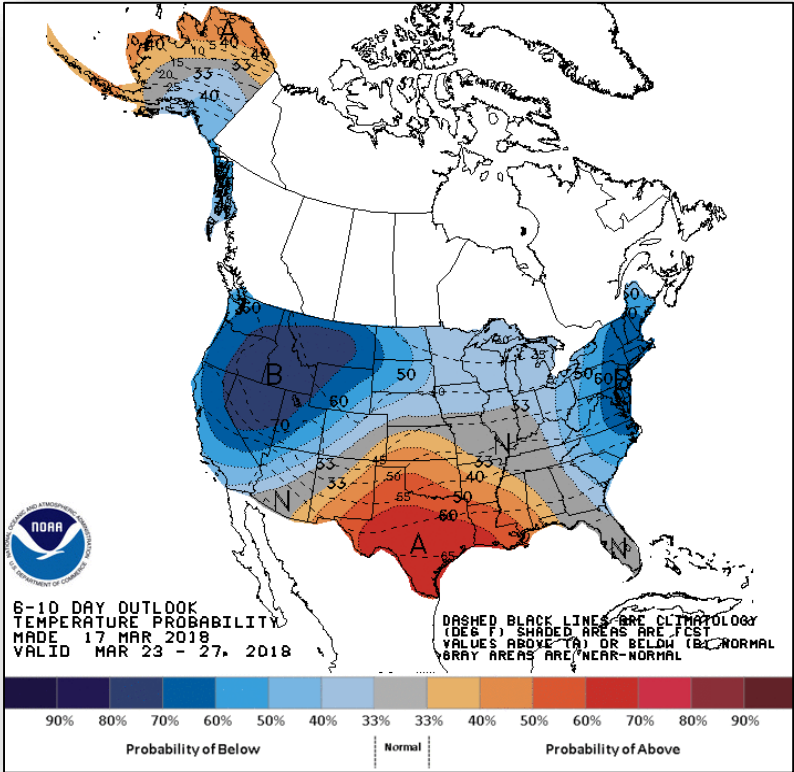




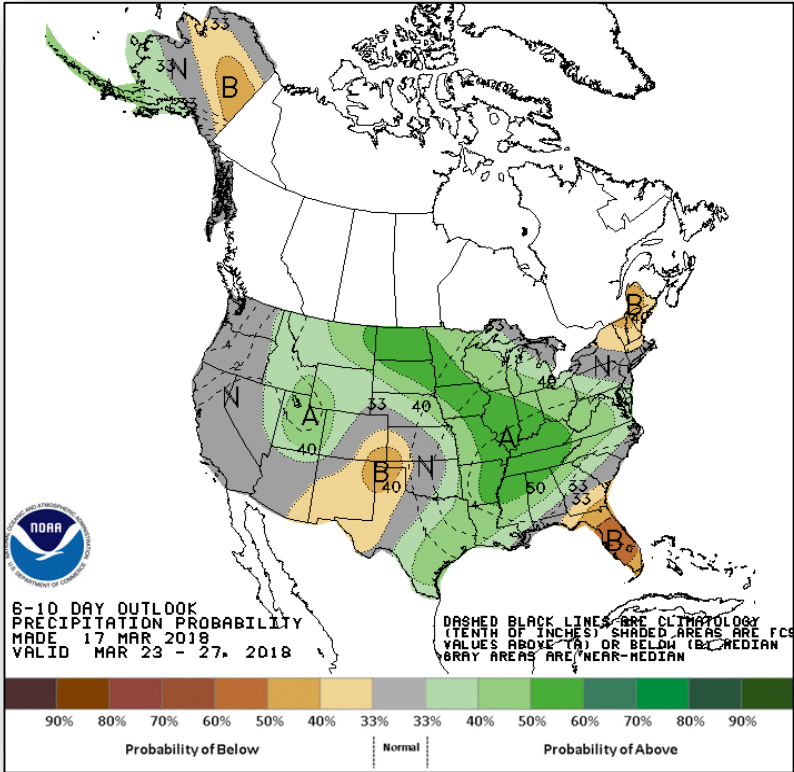
# 6-10 Day Outlooks

6-10 Day Temperature Probability



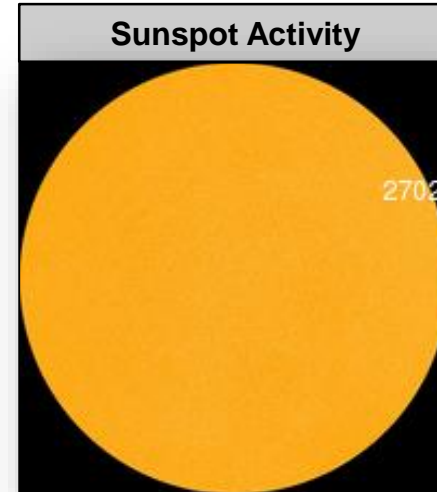
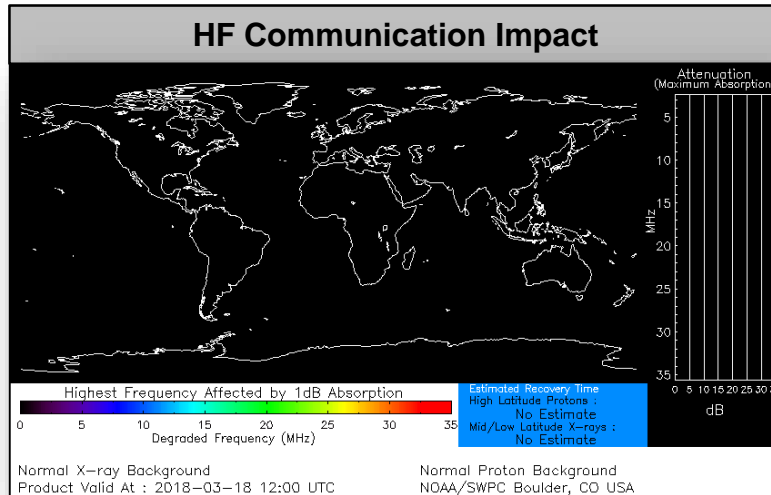
6-10 Day Precipitation Probability
