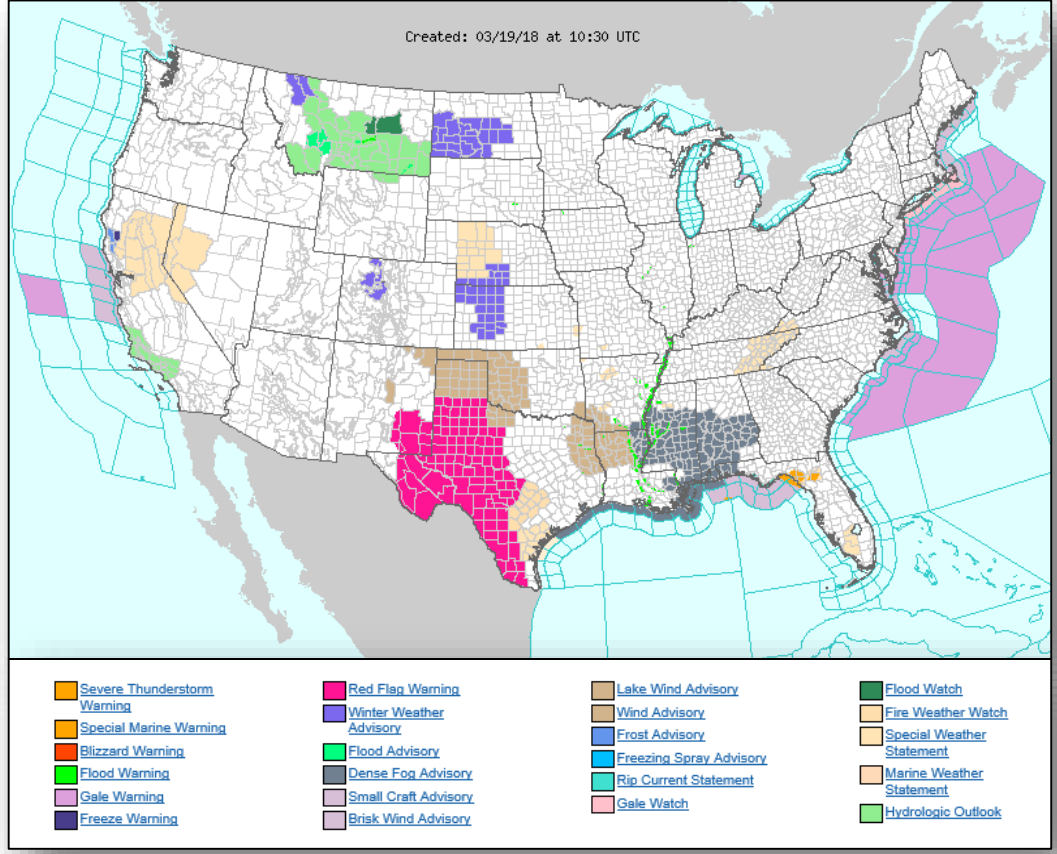

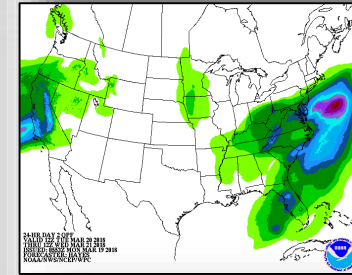
# Precipitation Forecast



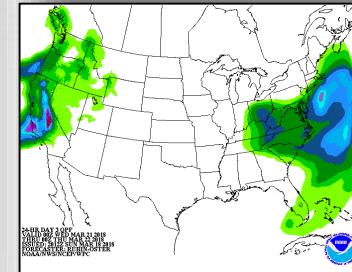

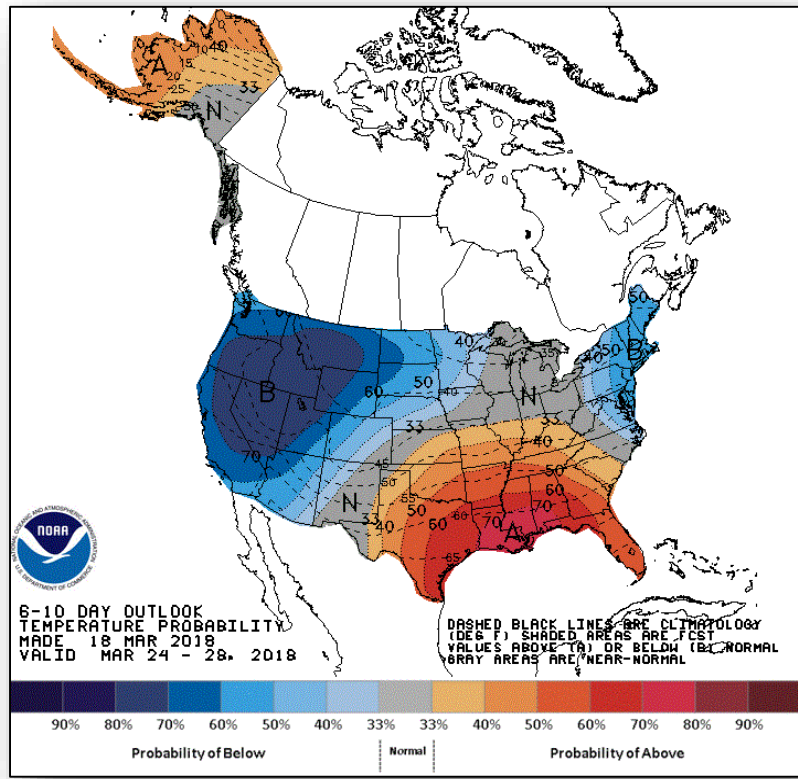
# Severe Weather Outlook



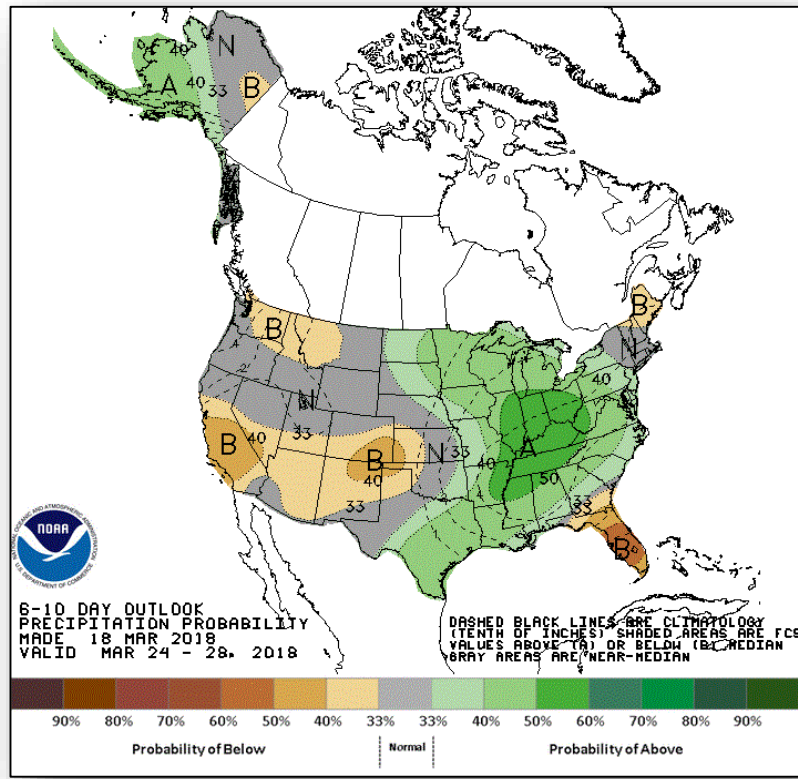

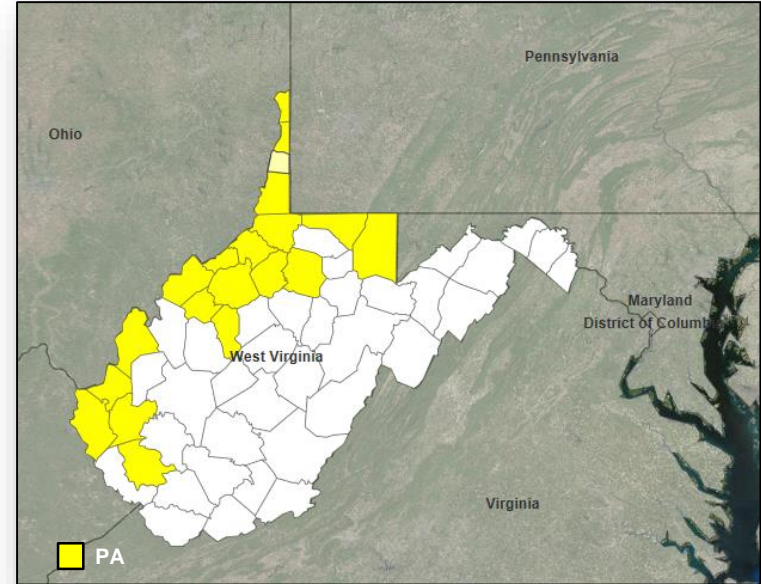
# Declaration Request
