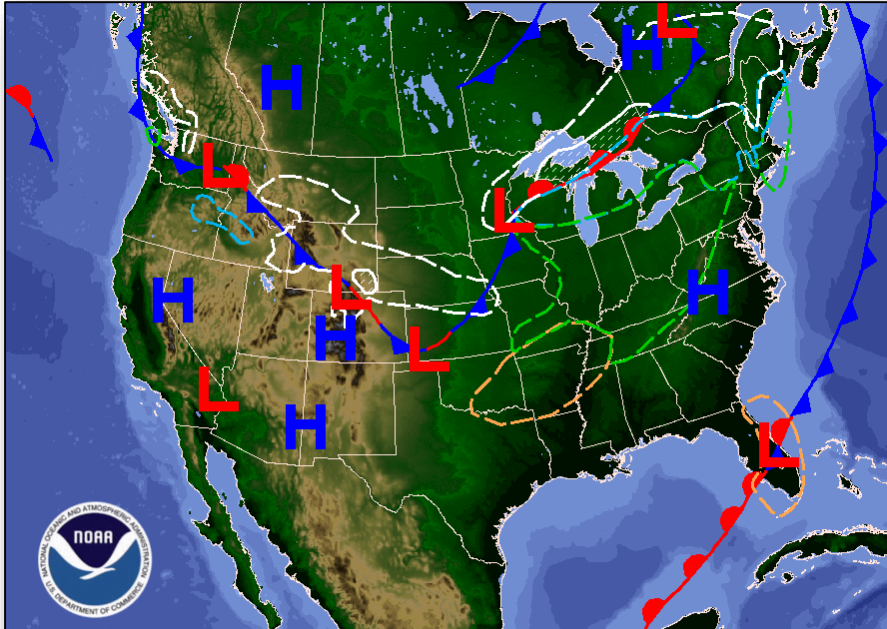

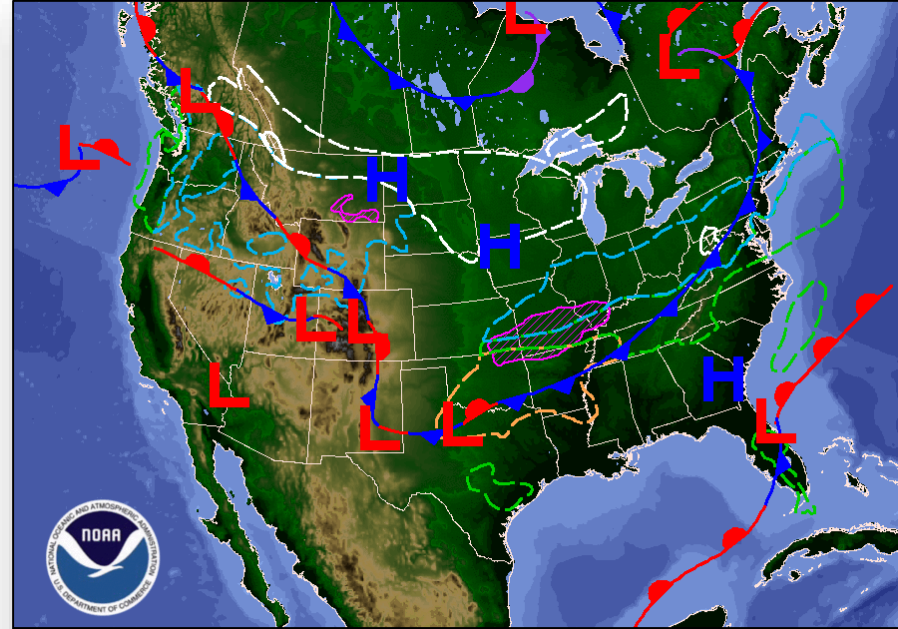


Day 1 National Forecast Chart

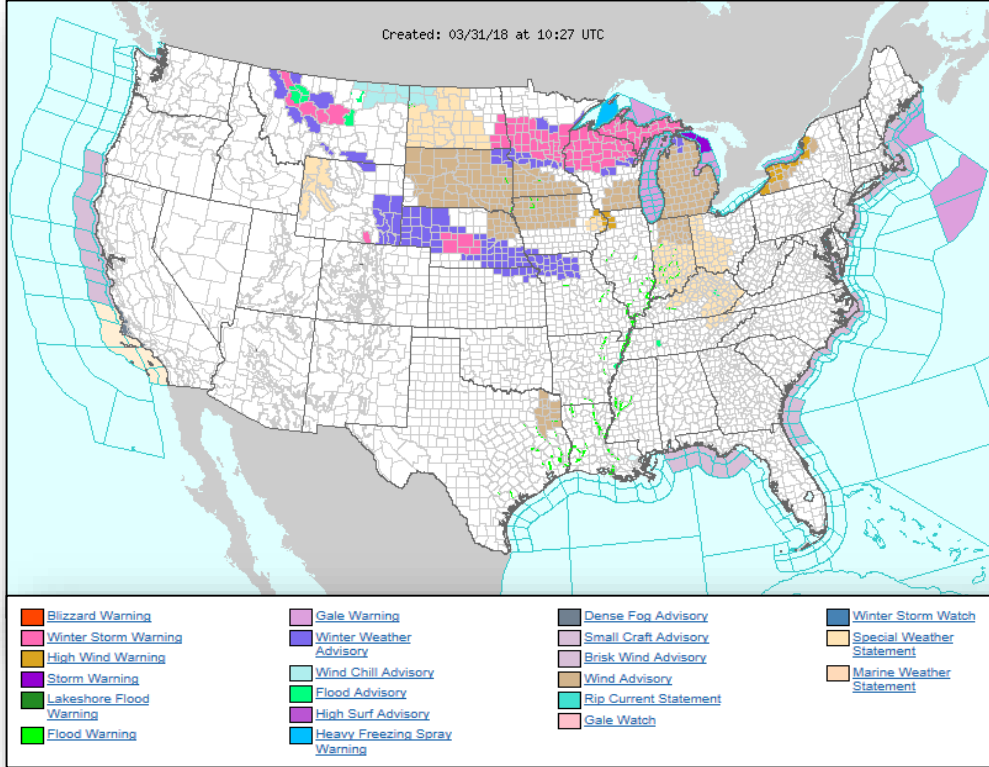

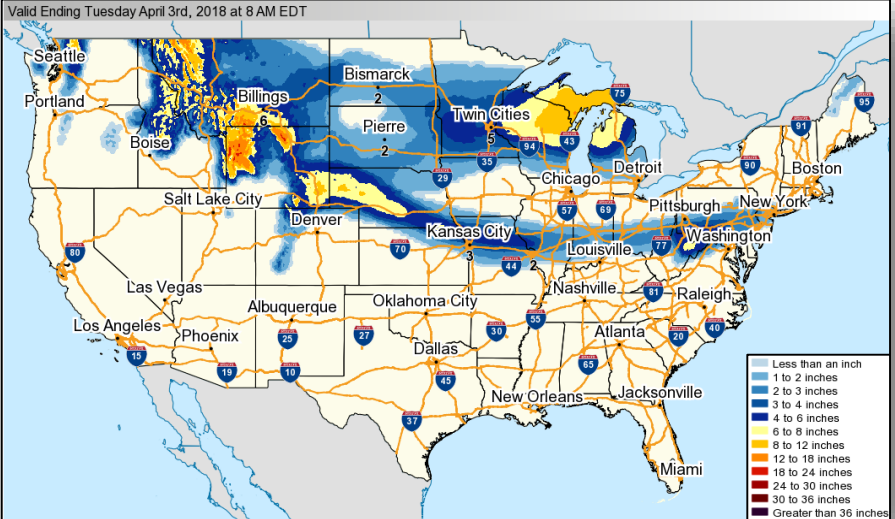

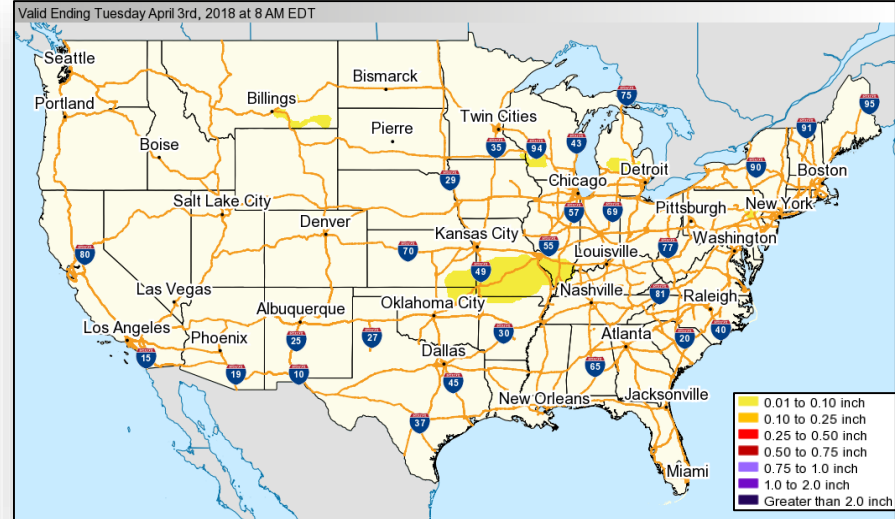

Forecast Snowfall

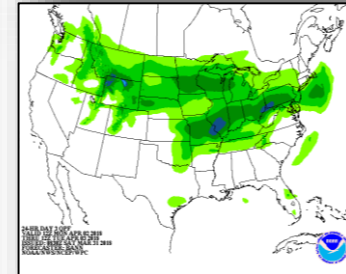
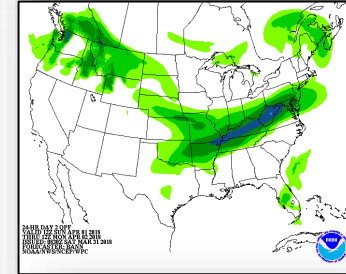
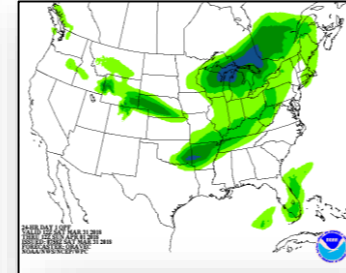
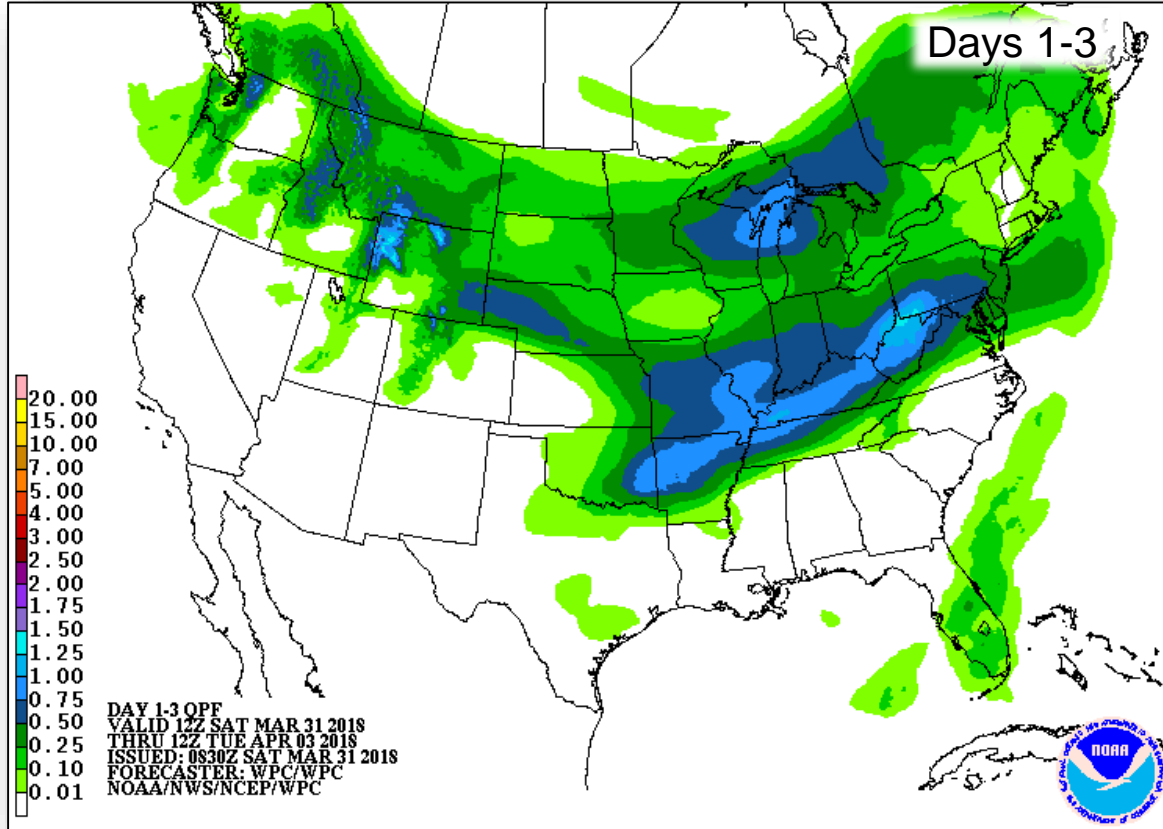


Forecast Ice Accumulation

Precipitation Forecast



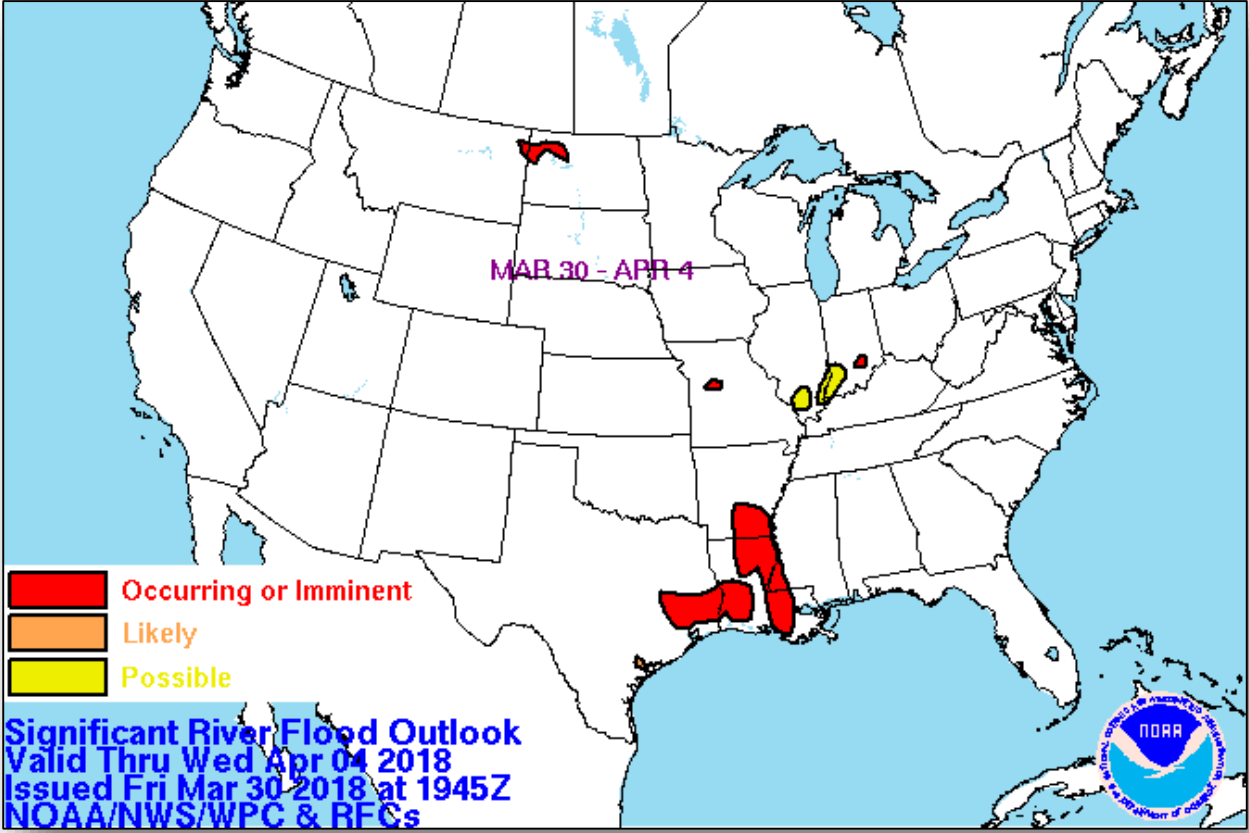

Significant River Flood Outlook



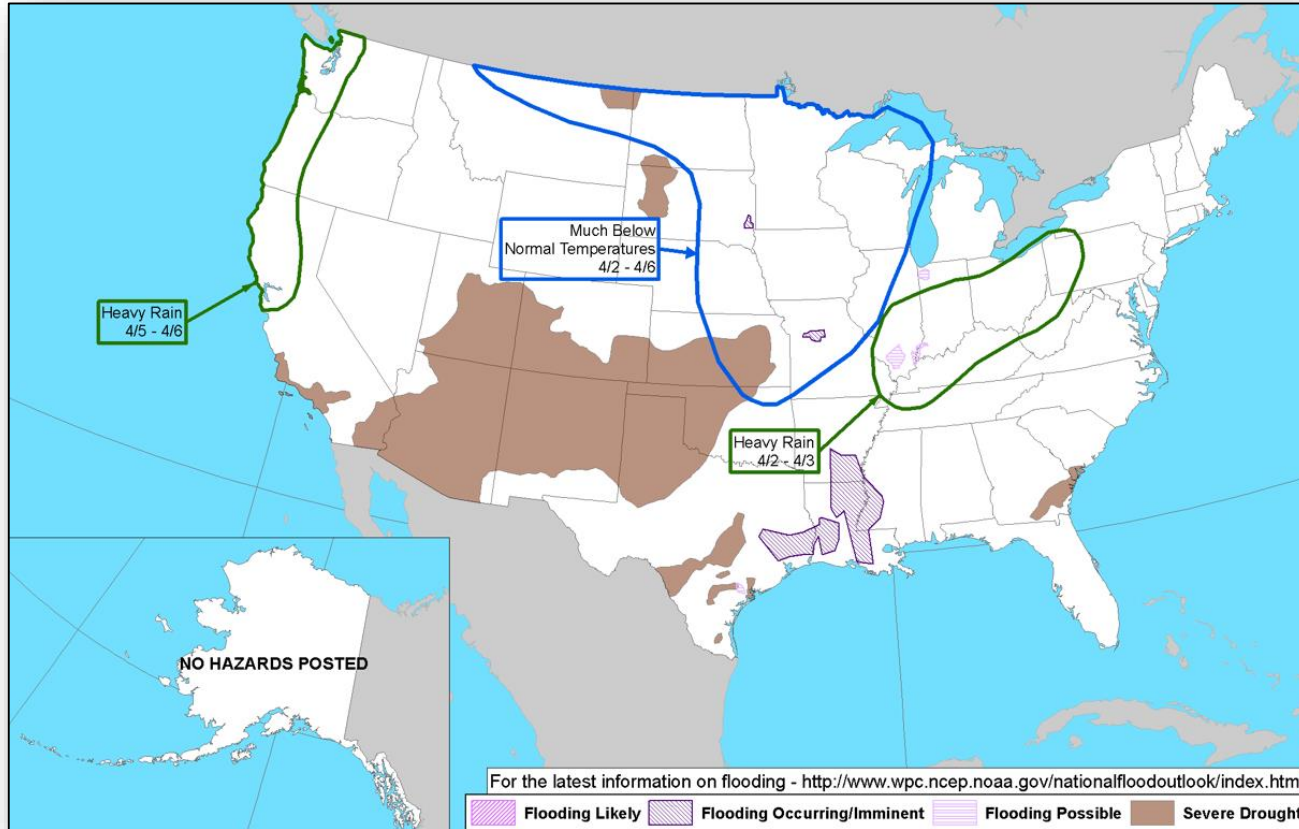

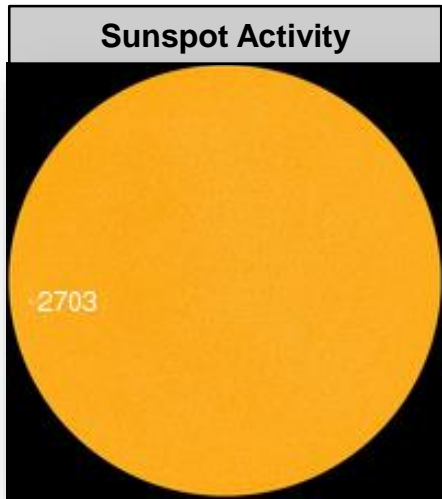
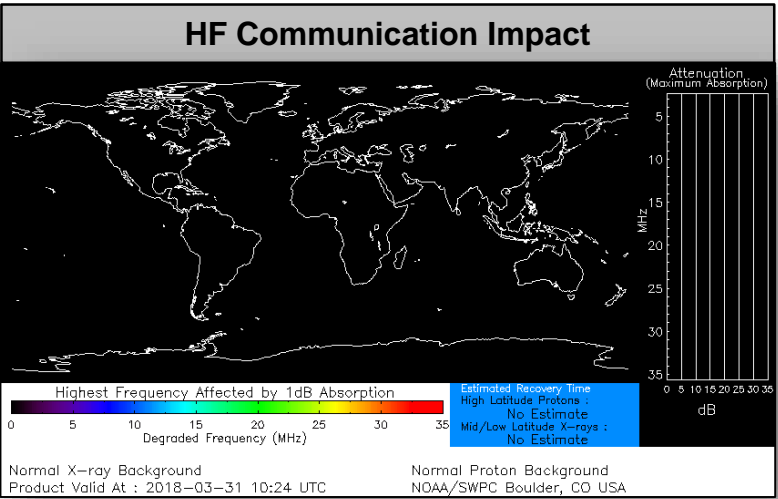
