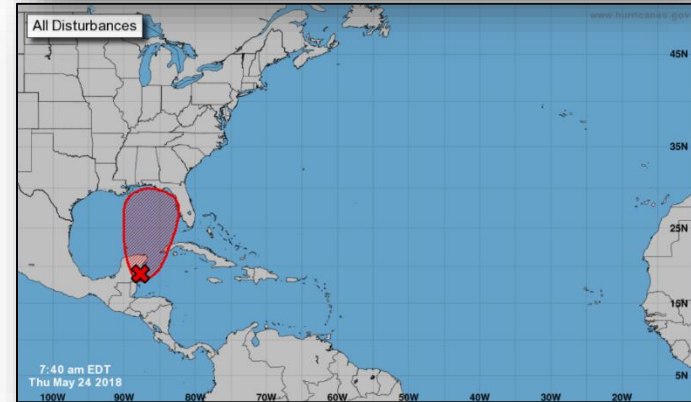
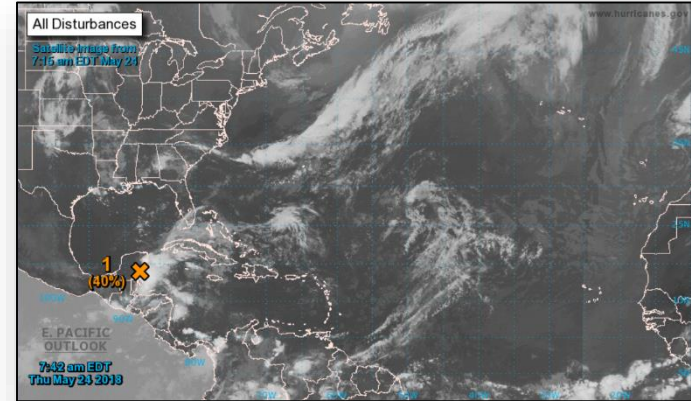
Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



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Invest 90L (as of 7:40 a.m. EDT)

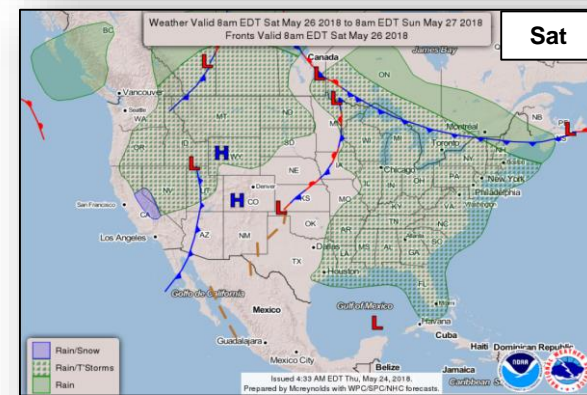
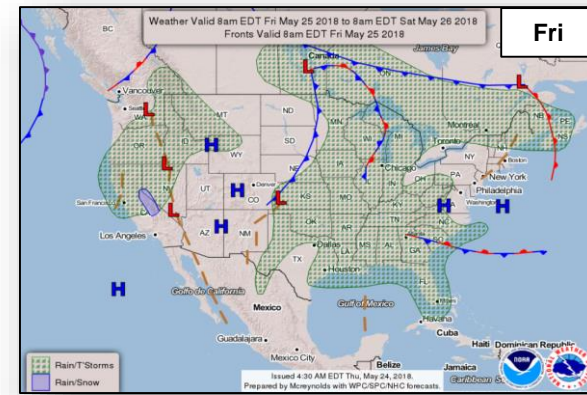
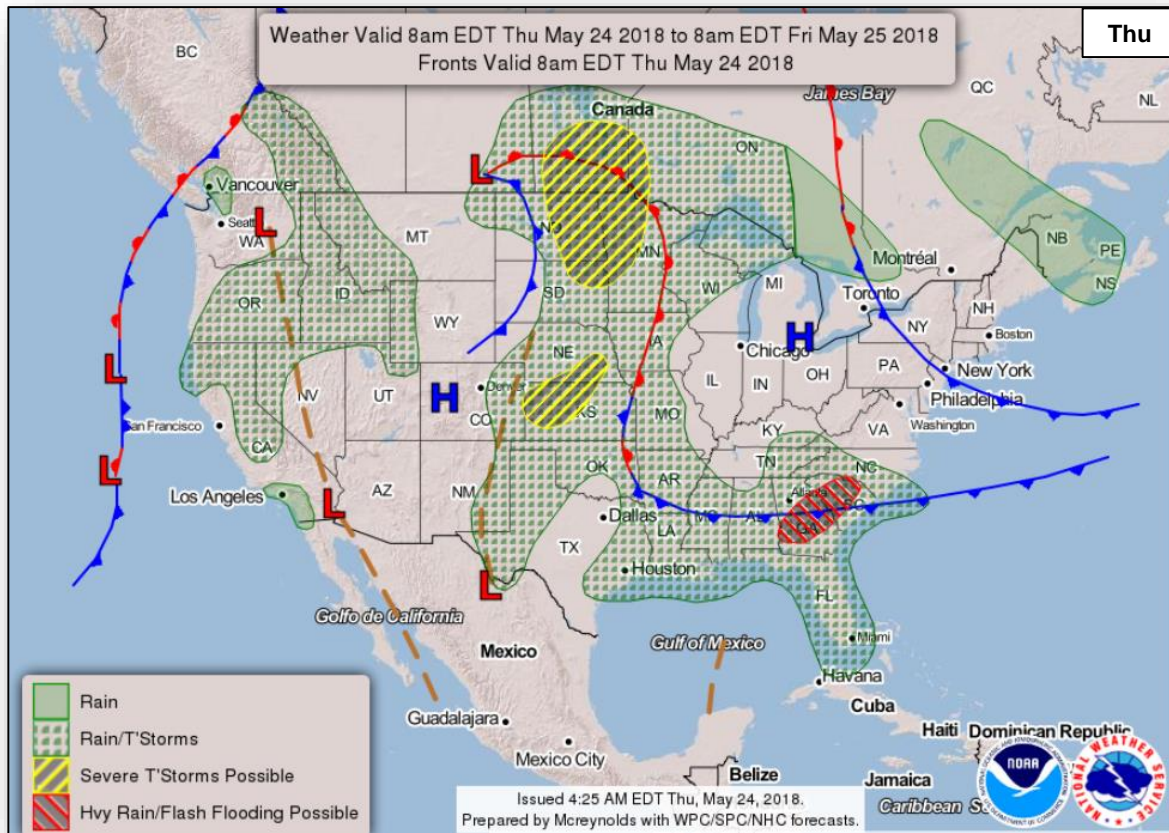
- Located over the southeastern Yucatan Peninsula
- Drifting north near Yucatan Peninsula
- Subtropical or tropical depression likely to form by late Saturday over the southeastern Gulf of Mexico
- Regardless of development, locally heavy rainfall is forecast over much of Florida and northern Gulf coast into early next week
- Threat of rip currents will steadily increase along the Gulf Coast from Florida to Louisiana over Memorial Day weekend
- Formation chance through 48 hours: MEDIUM (40%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: HIGH (80%)

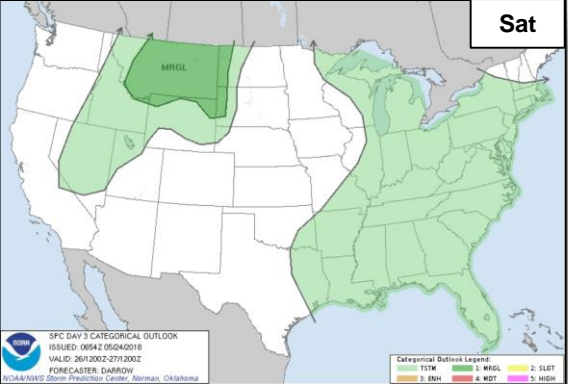
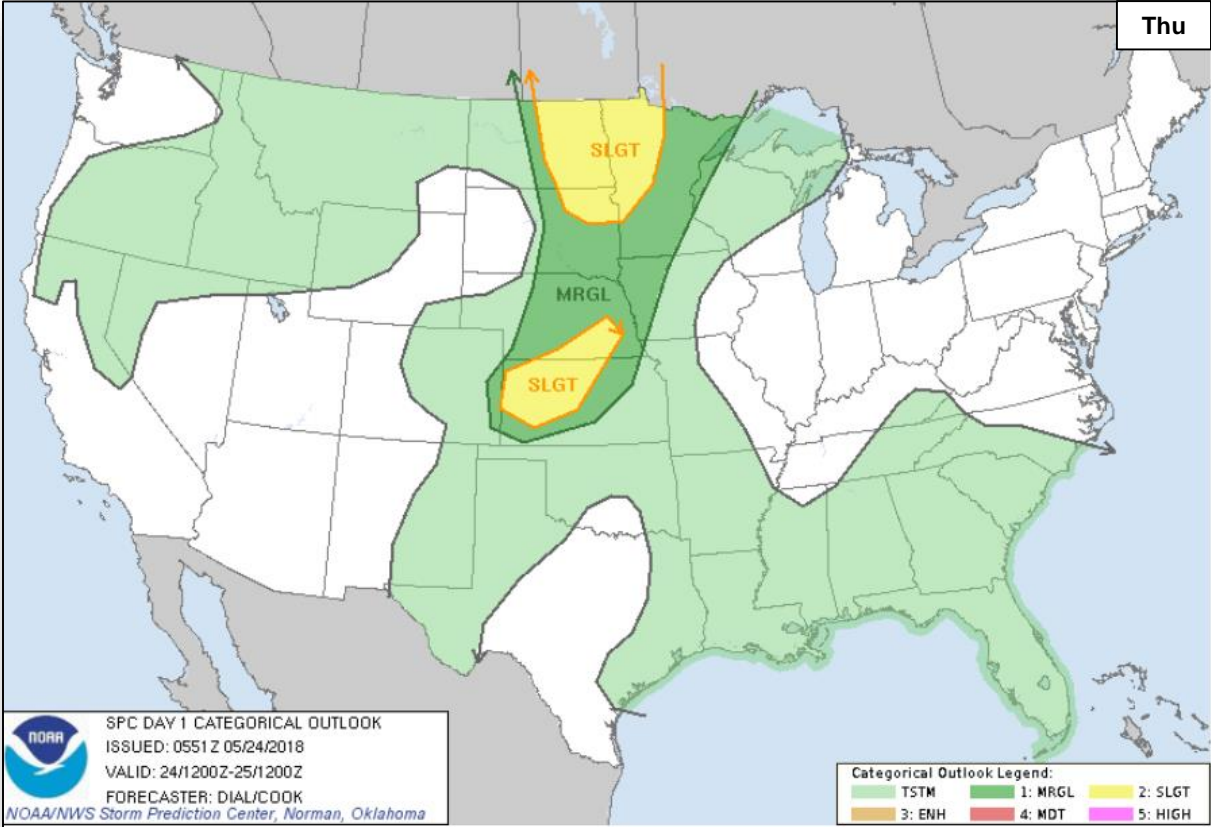
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Severe Weather Outlook



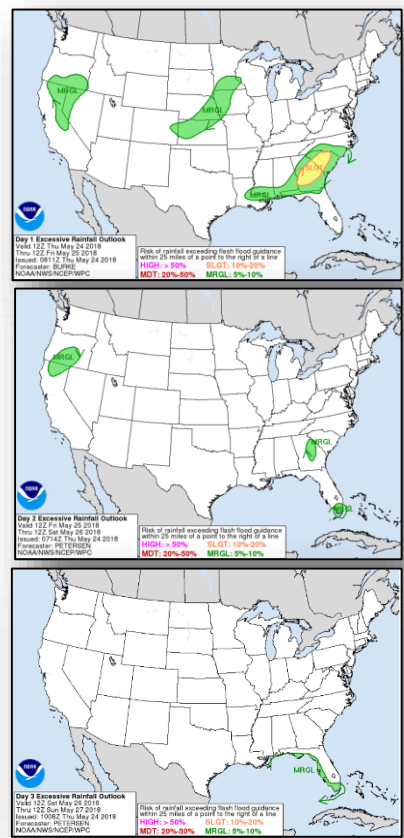
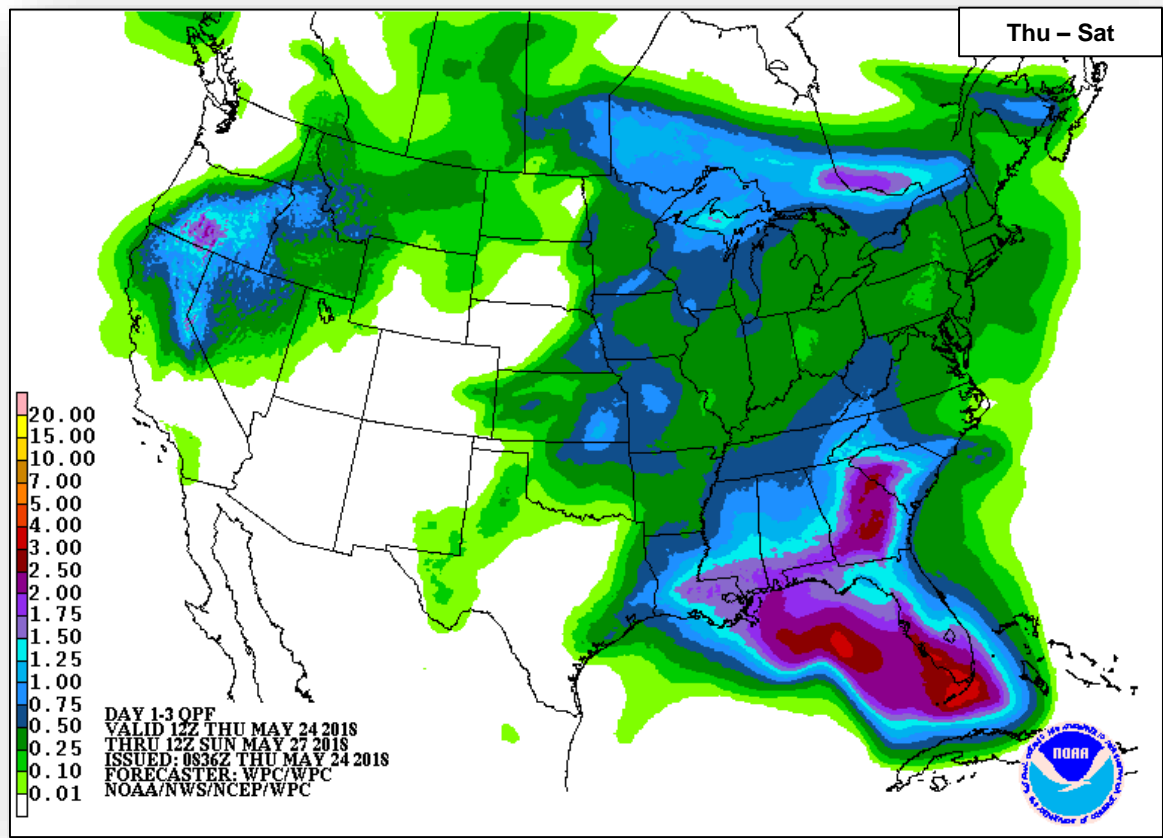
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Precipitation / Excessive Rainfall Forecast



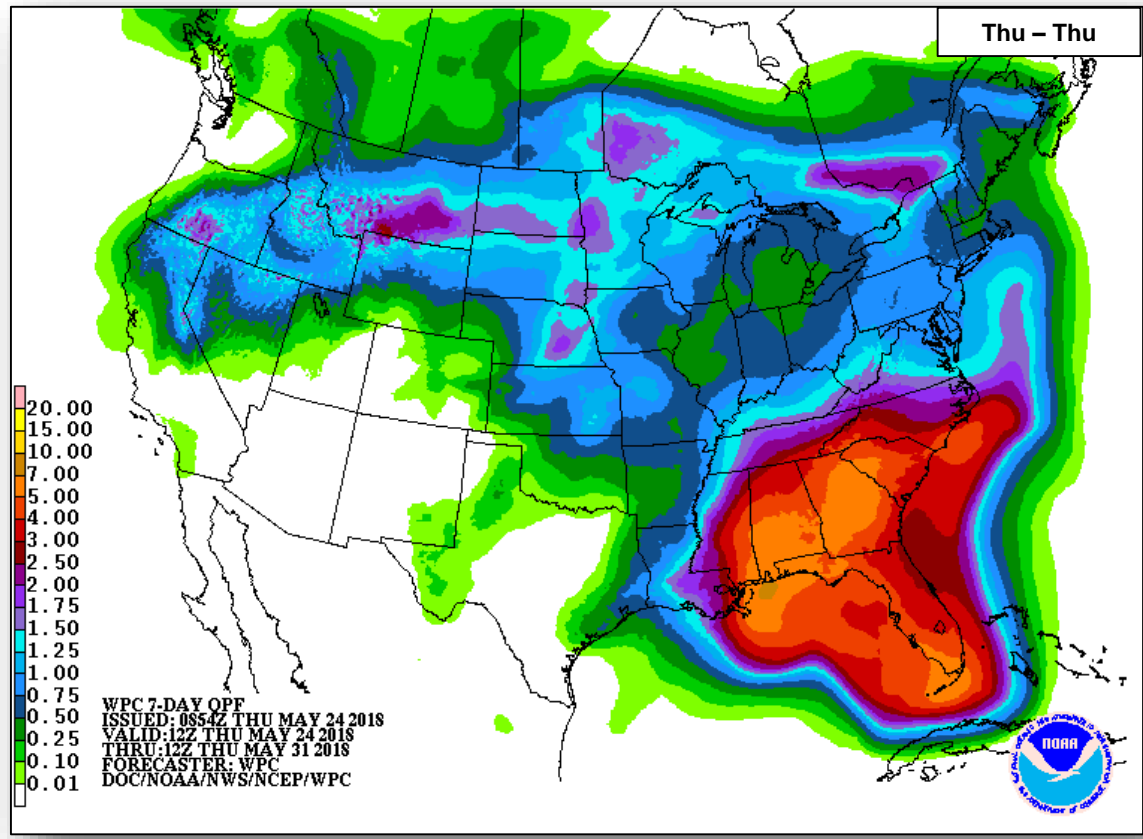
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Precipitation - Days 1-7



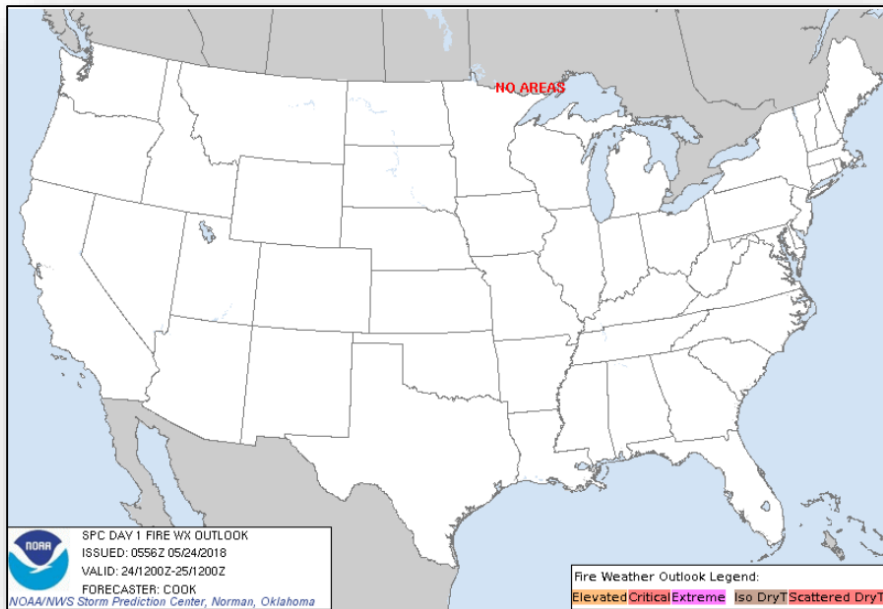
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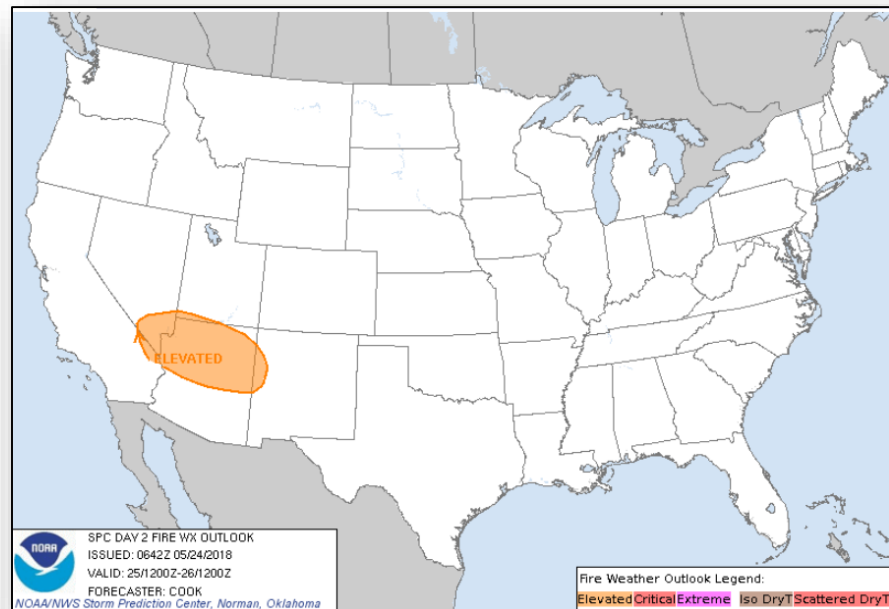
