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Significant Events: Remnants of Tropical Depression Alberto

Tropical Activity: Western Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests

Significant Weather:

- Severe Thunderstorms – Southern/Central Plains, Ohio Valley, Middle/Lower Mississippi valleys, and Northern Intermountain to Northern Rockies/Plains
- Heavy Rain and Flash Flooding possible – Southeast to the Central and Southern Appalachians, Ohio and Lower Mississippi valleys, Mid-Atlantic, and Northern Rockies/High Plains
- Critical/Elevated Fire Weather and Red Flag Warnings – CA, NV, AZ, UT, CO, NM, WY, & TX
- Space Weather:
 - Past 24 hours: None

Impacts

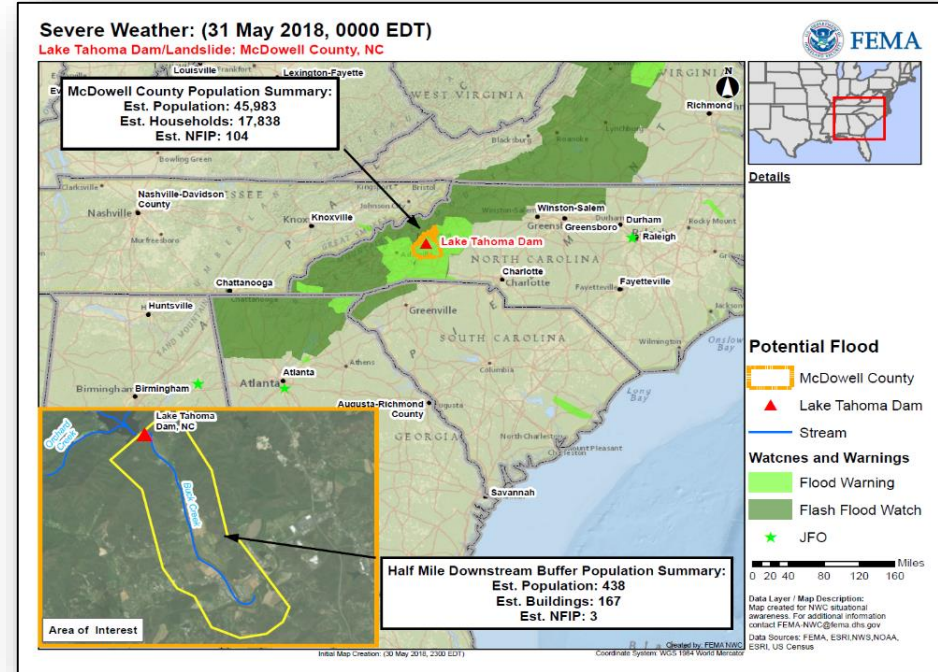
- Significant road, bridge, and structure damage occurred
- Tahoma Dam Landslide, McDowell County, NC:
 - Engineers inspected the dam and determined it safe
 - Evacuation orders have been lifted and the incident is stabilized

State/Local Response

 - NC: 4/40 (yesterday: 6/53)
 - GA: 1/0 (yesterday: 1/6)
- NC EOC at Partial Activation; Governor declared State of Emergency
- KY, MS, and AL EOCs at Monitoring

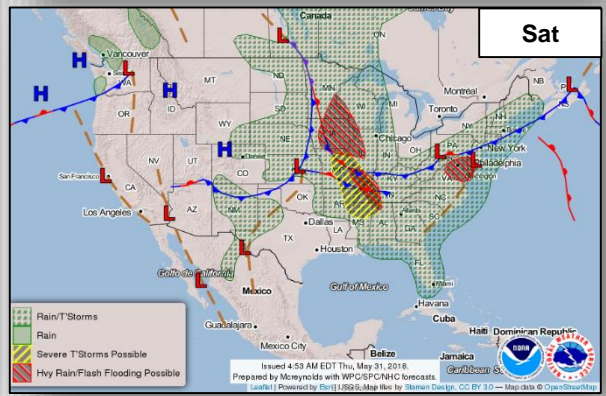
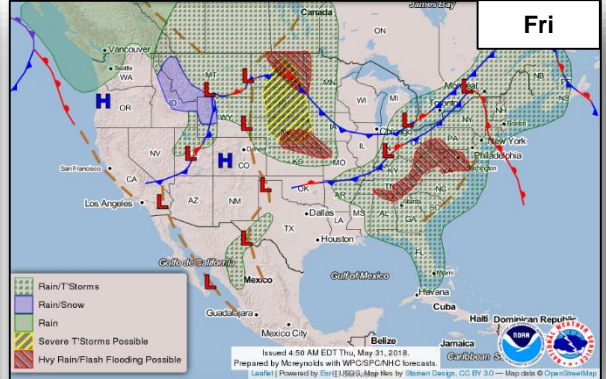
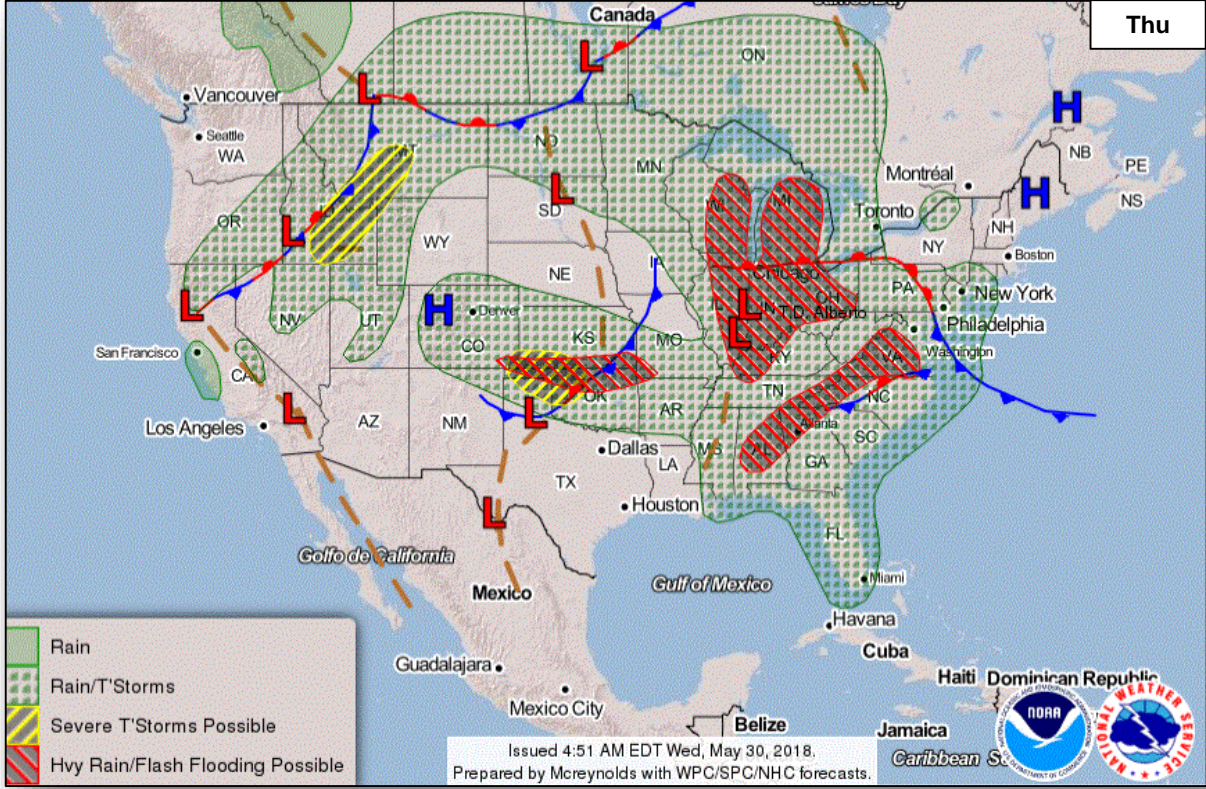

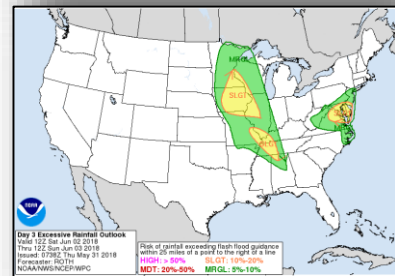
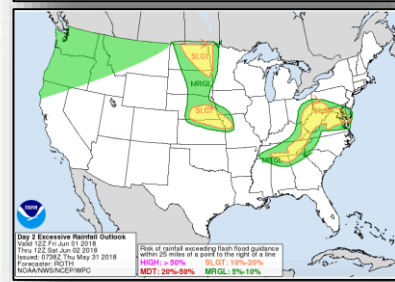
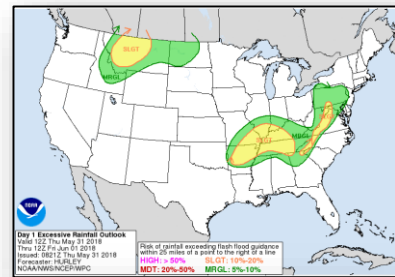
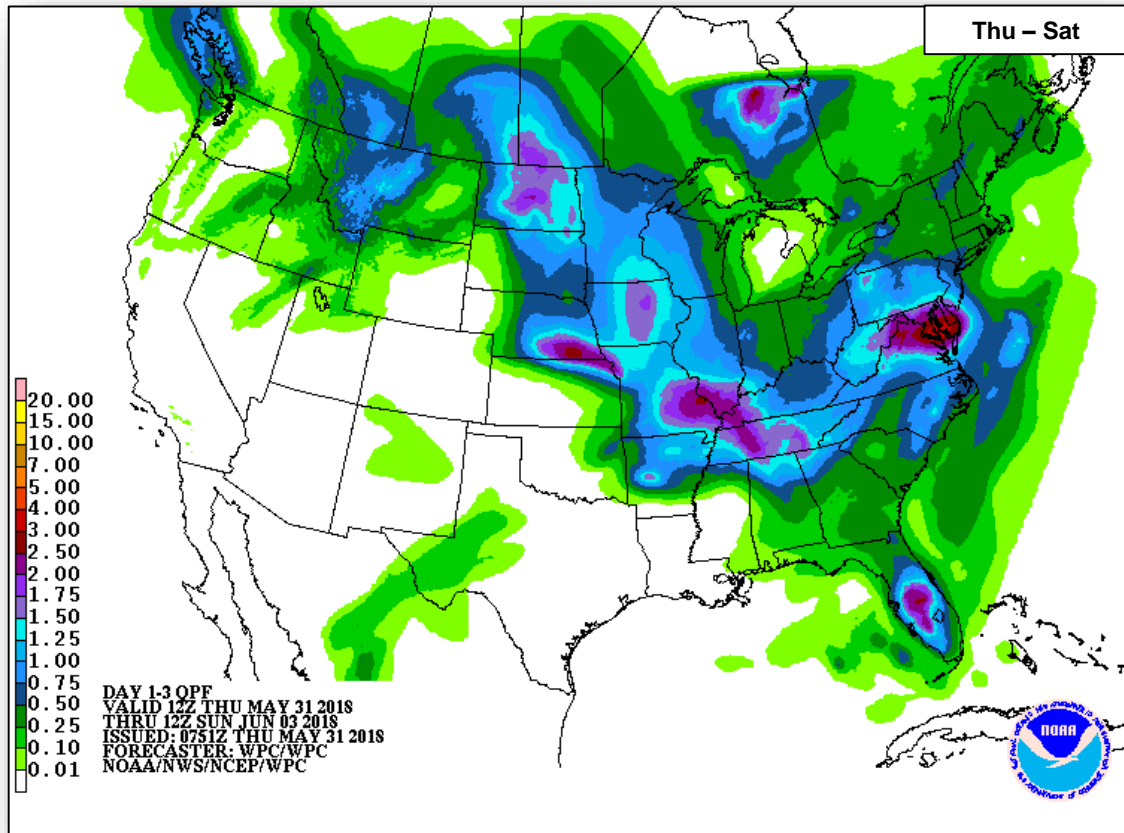
National Weather Forecast



Precipitation / Excessive Rainfall Forecast



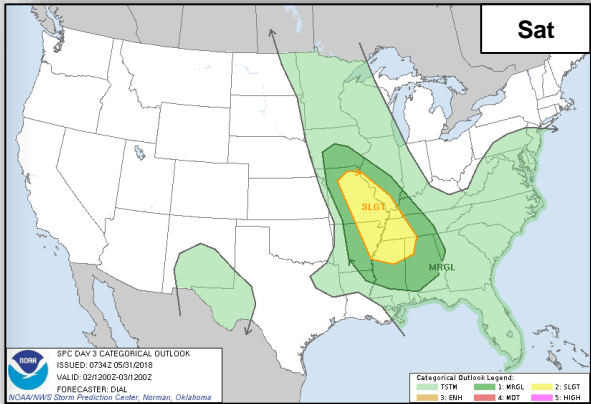
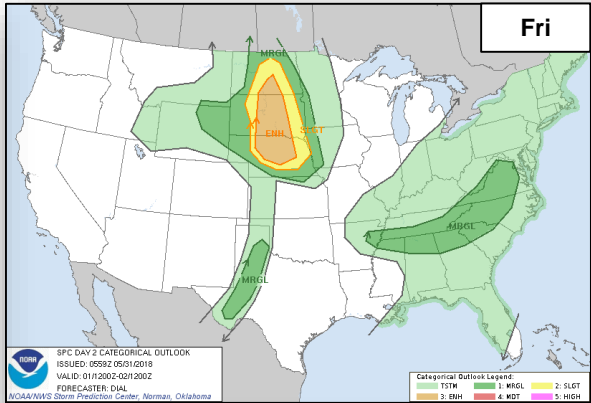
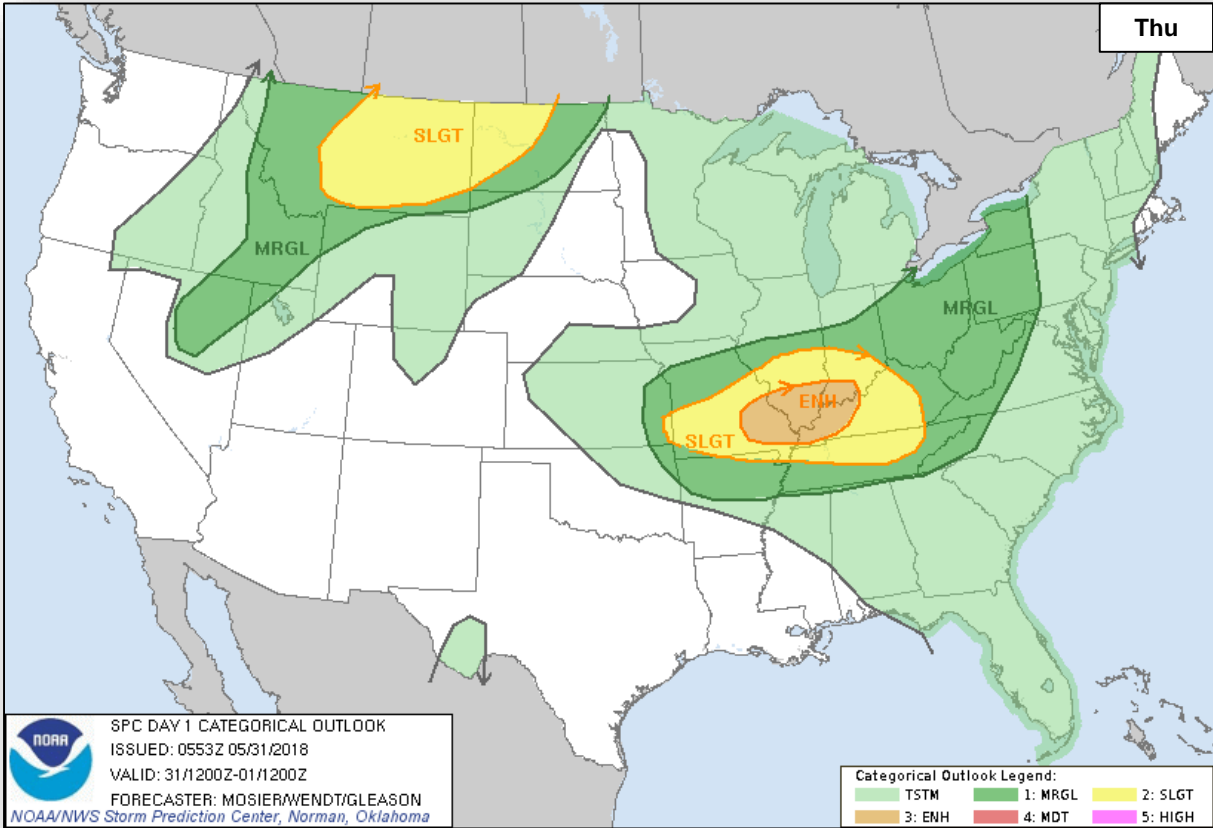
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Severe Weather Outlook



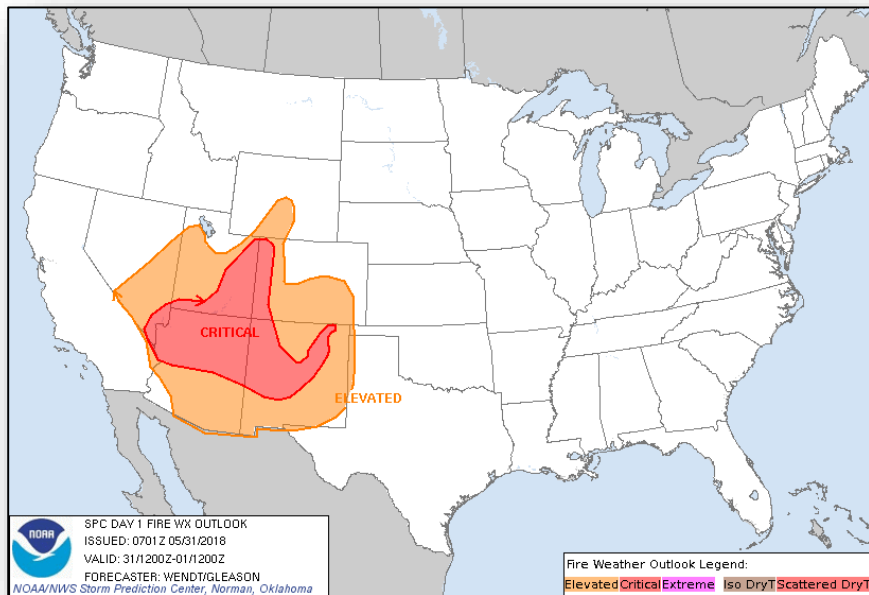
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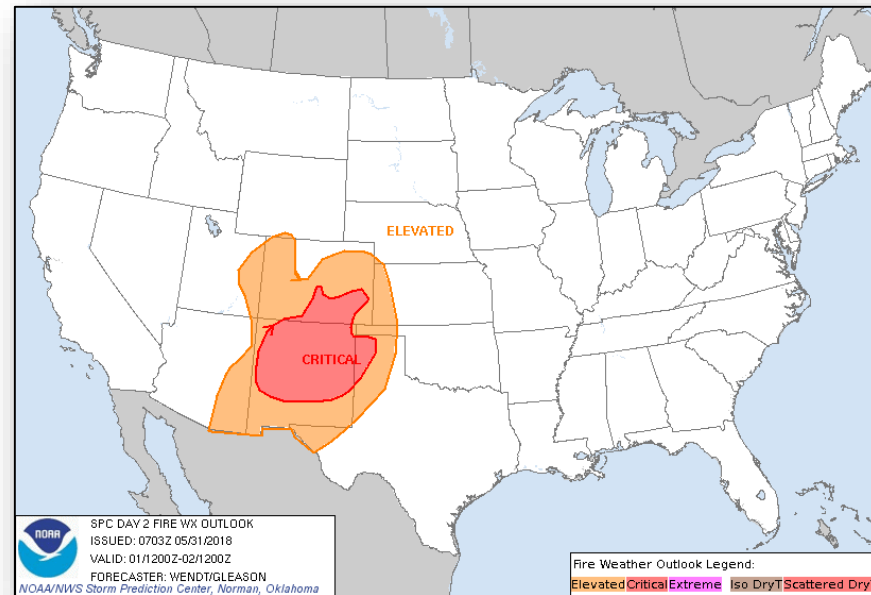

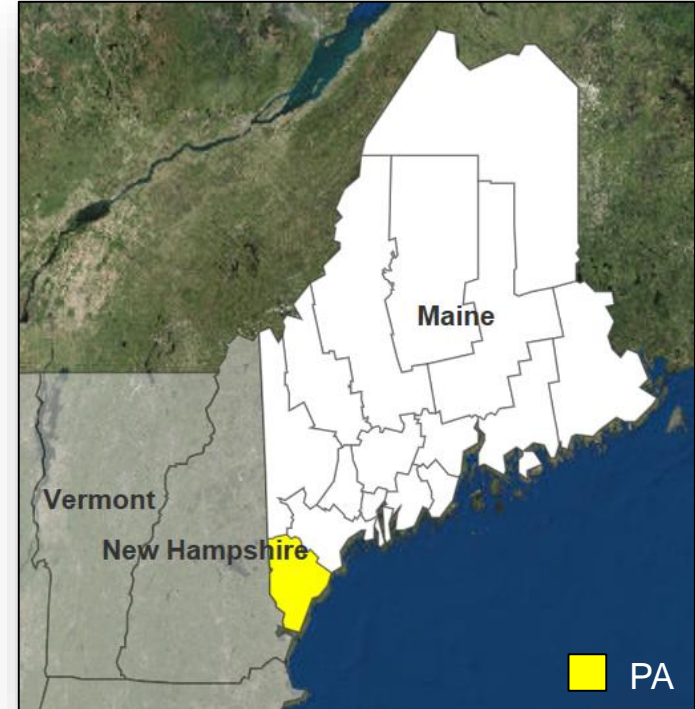
Declaration Approved
