



48 Hour Outlook



Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific




Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 am EDT)

- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)




Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific






48 Hour Outlook









Precipitation / Excessive Rainfall Forecast
