Significant Activity – July 25-26



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Significant Events: Wildfire activity

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic – Tropical cyclone activity not expected during the next 48 hours
- Eastern Pacific – Disturbance 1 – Medium (60%); Disturbance 2 – Medium (50%)
- Central Pacific – Disturbance 1 – Low (10%)
- Western Pacific – No activity affecting U.S. interests

Significant Weather:

- Severe Thunderstorms possible – Central/Southern Rockies and High Plains; Ohio Valley to lower Great Lakes
- Heavy Rain and Flash Flooding possible – Central/Southern Rockies and Northeast
- Elevated Fire weather – CA, ID, WY, and CO
- Red Flag Warnings – OR, CA
- Isolated Dry Thunderstorms – WA, ID, MT, and WY

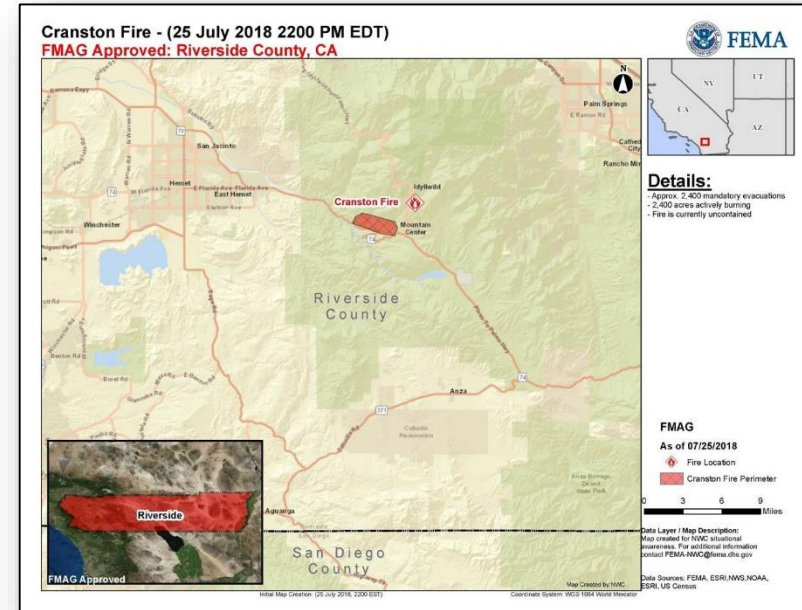

Current Situation

- Fire began July 25, 2018 and is burning in and around the communities of Idyllwild, Mountain Center, and Pine Grove (total population 11,806)
- Threatening buildings, infrastructure and utilities

- Region IX RWC at Steady State, but continues to monitor
- FMAG approved on July 25, 2018



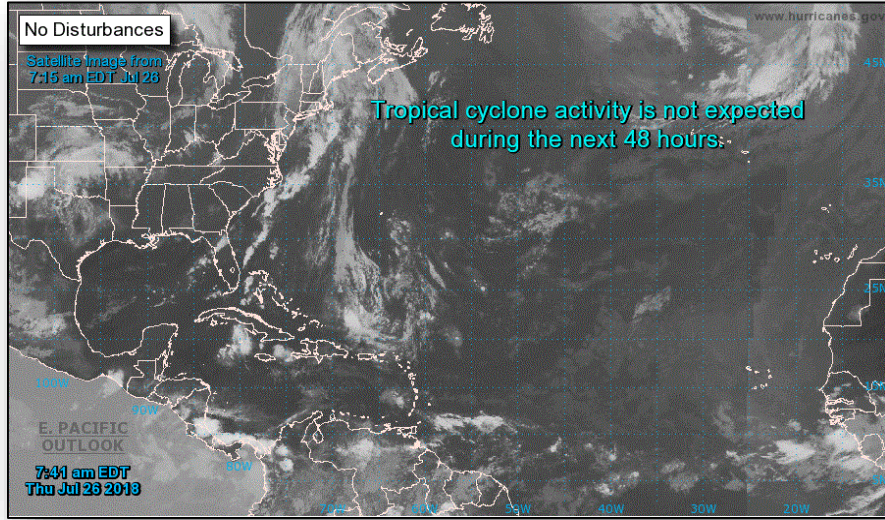

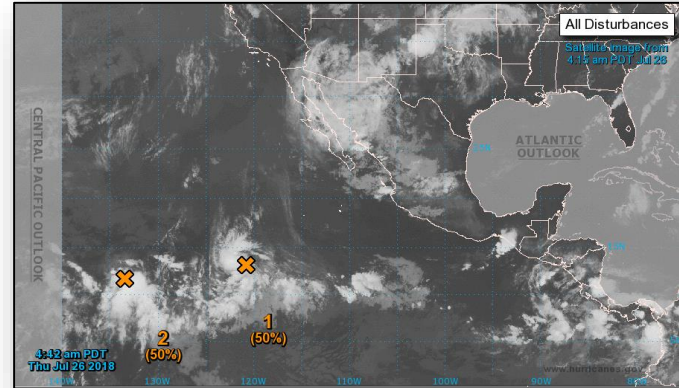

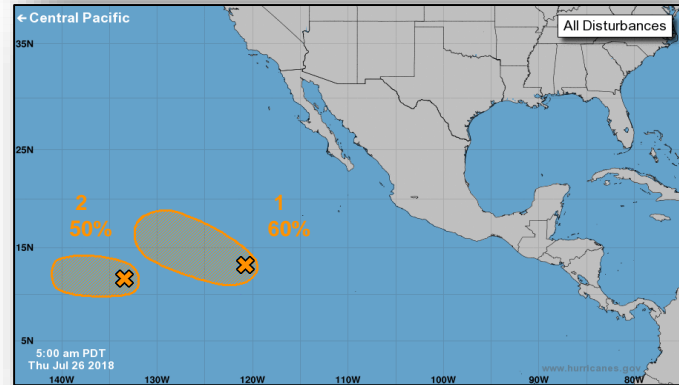
Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (50%)



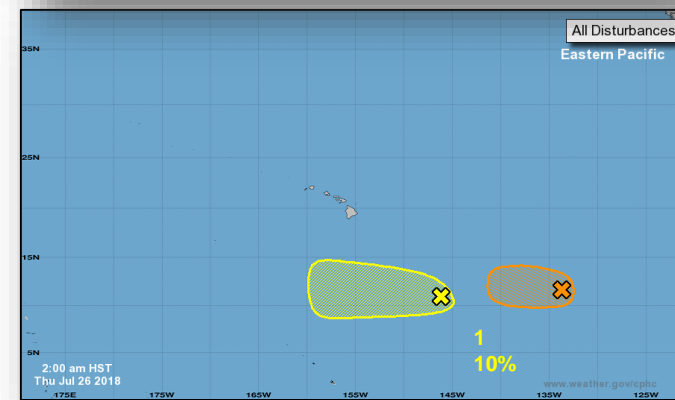
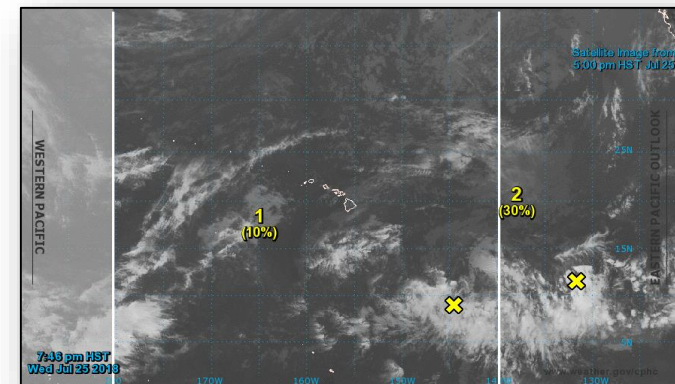

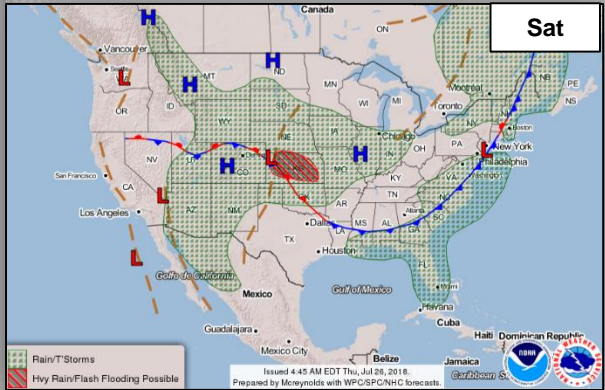
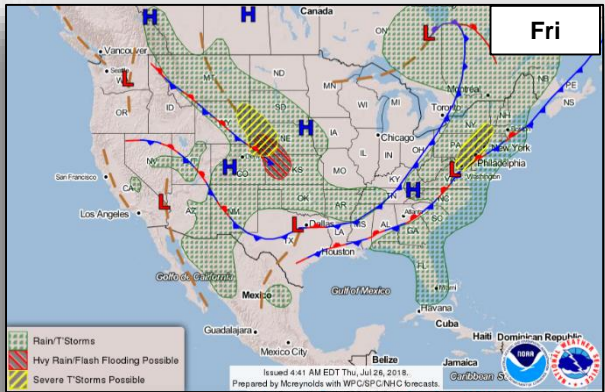
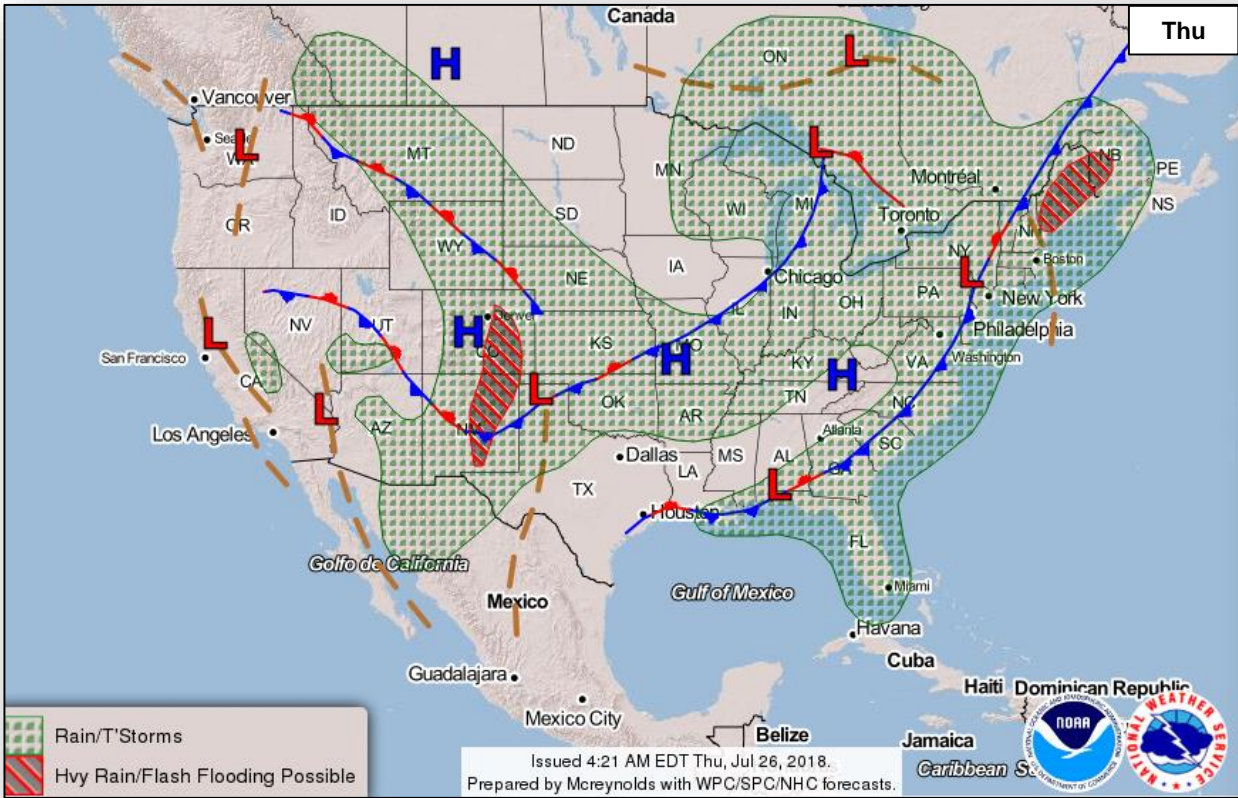
- Located 850 miles SE of Hilo, HI

National Weather Forecast



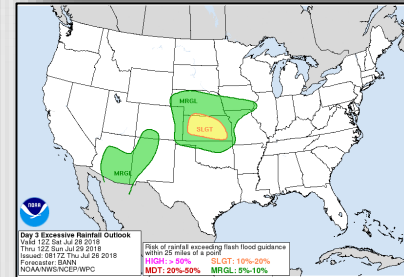
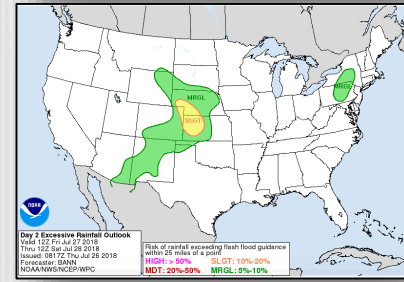
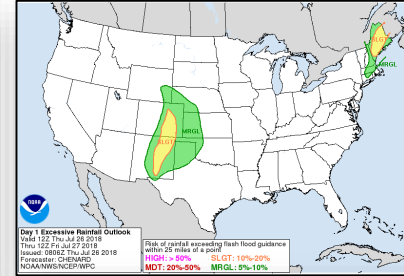
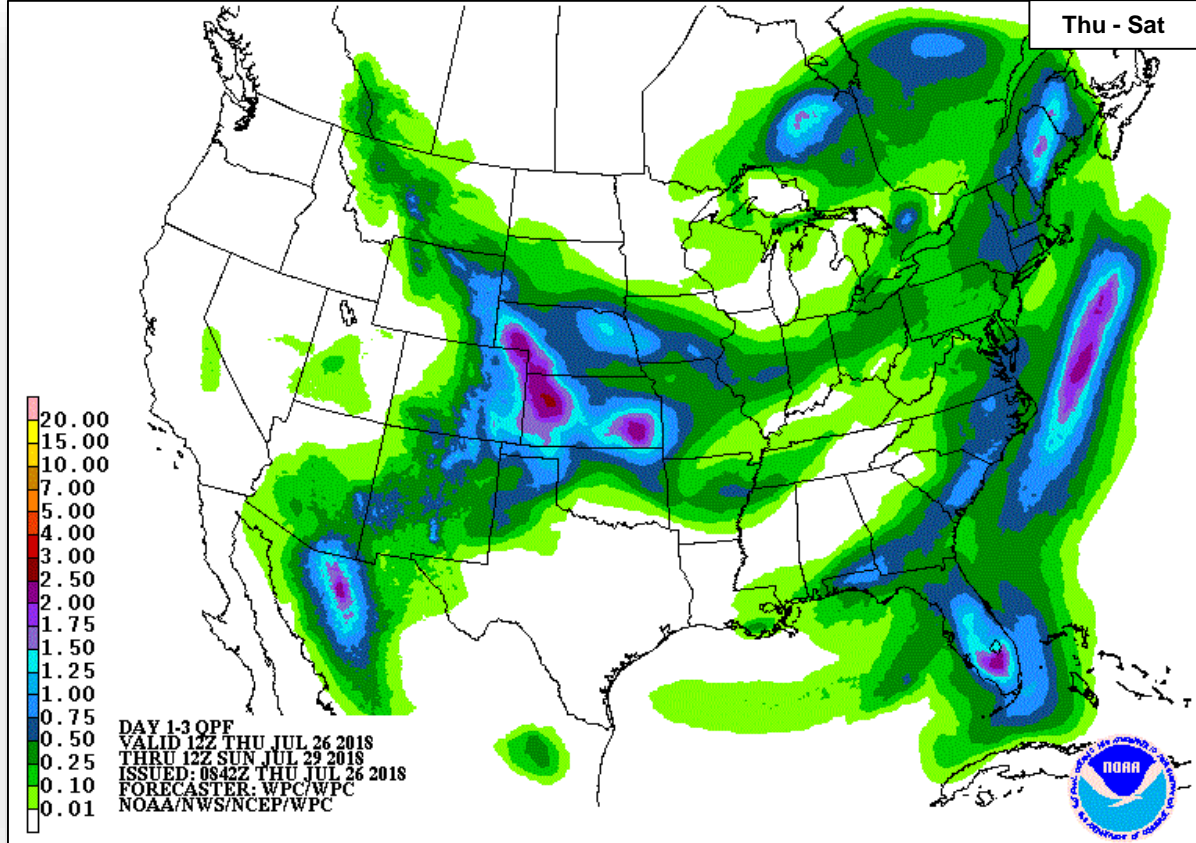
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Precipitation / Excessive Rainfall Forecast



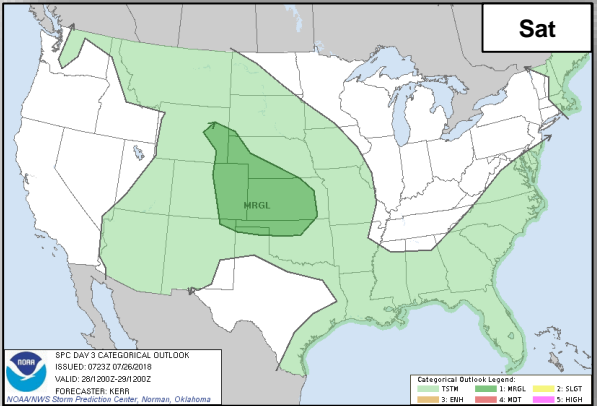
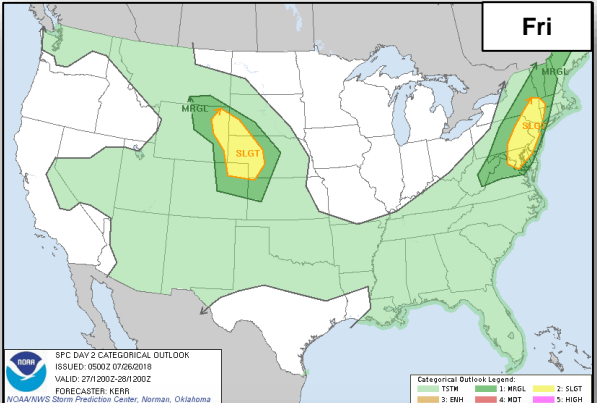
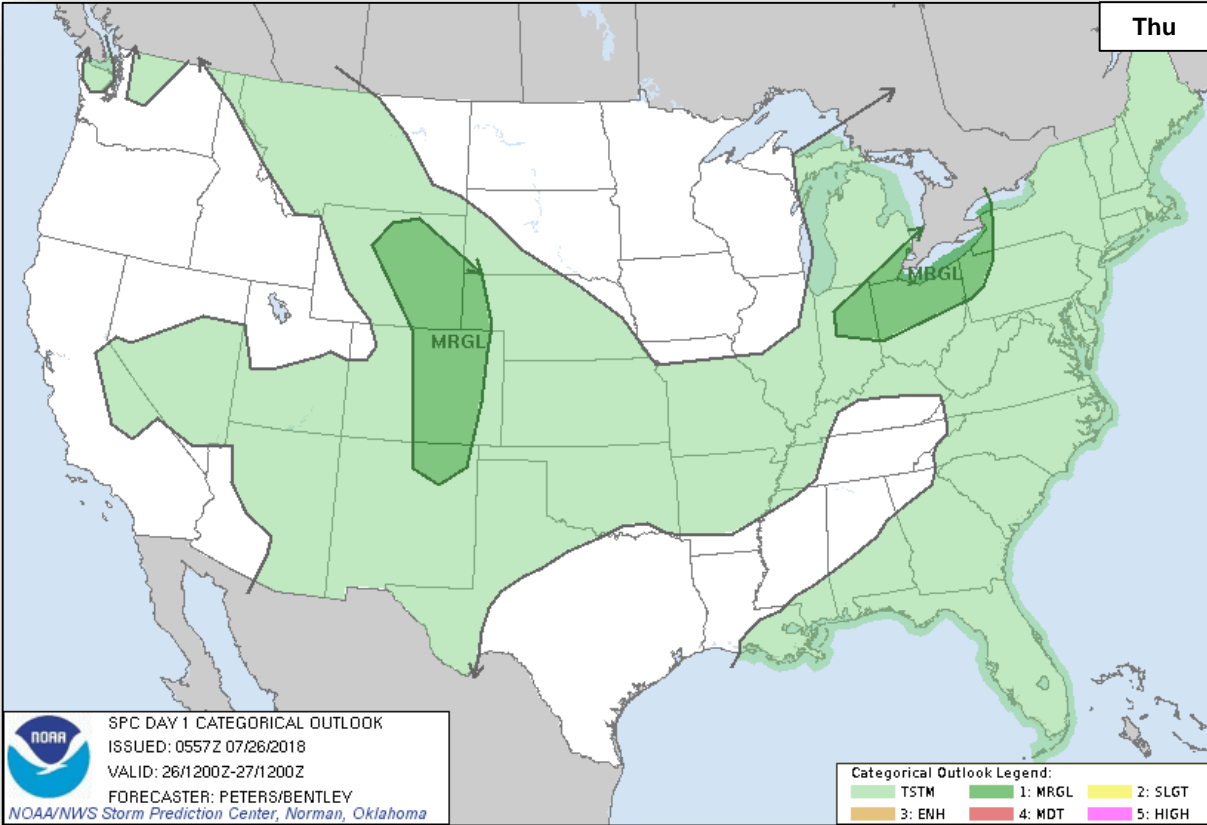
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Severe Weather Outlook



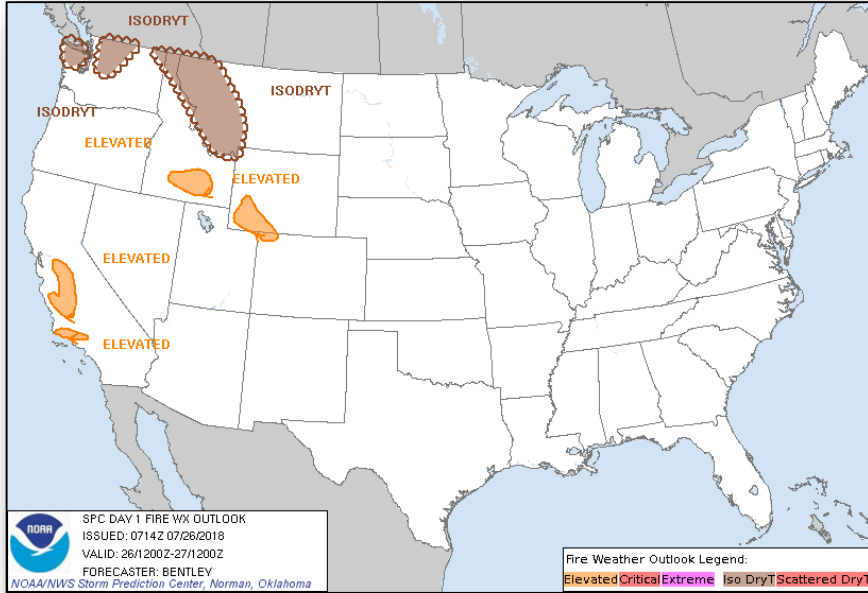
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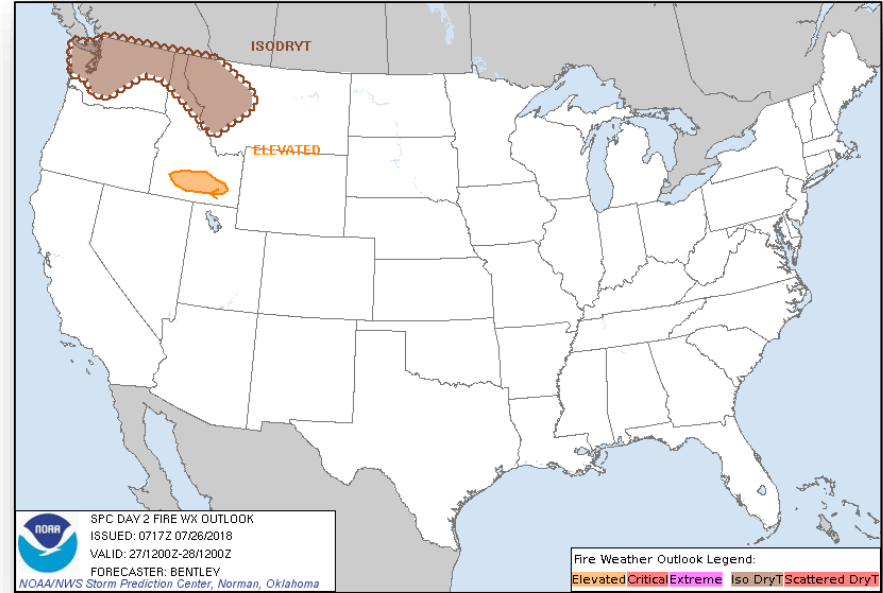
