


Hurricane Lane – Central Pacific

<u>Hurricane Lane – CAT 5</u> (Advisory #31A as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located 335 miles SEE of Kailua-Kona, Hawaii
- Moving WNW at 9 mph; turn toward the NW is expected today; center of Lane will move very close to / over Islands Thursday through Saturday
- Maximum sustained winds 160 mph
- Hurricane-force winds extend out 40 miles; tropical-storm-force winds extend out 140 miles
- Hurricane Watch in effect for Oahu and Maui County, including the islands of Maui, Lanai, Molokai and Kahoolawe; Hurricane Warning in effect for Hawaii County
- Hazards affecting land:
 - Expected to produce total rain accumulations of 10 to 15 inches with isolated amounts greater than 20 inches; flash flooding and landslides possible
 - Large swells, producing large and potentially damaging surf, will impact the Big Island and spread across the remainder of the island chain today



- The Governor declared a State of Emergency on August 21
- All public and charter schools and Hawaii State Department of Education offices on Hawaii Island and Maui County will be closed UFN








Severe Weather Outlook









Fire Weather Outlook








