

Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Tropical wave forecast to move off the coast of Africa on Thursday
- Some development is possible over the weekend
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)



Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



Tropical Storm Miriam (Advisory #9 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)


- Located 1,480 miles ESE of Hilo, HI
- Moving W at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 65 mph
- Expected to become a hurricane today
- Tropical storm force winds extend 60 miles


Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

- · Located 550 miles south of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 10 mph
- Environmental conditions still conducive for development
- Tropical depression expected to form today or Wednesday
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (90%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (90%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located well southwest of Mexico
- Some gradual development is possible by end of week
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)






Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific



Tropical Depression Lane (Advisory #56 as of 2:00 a.m. EDT)

- · Located 555 miles WSW of Barking Sands, HI
- No longer a threat to Hawaii




Tropical Outlook – Western Pacific




Tropical Storm Jebi (25W) (as of 5:00 a.m. EDT Aug 28)


- · Located 765 miles east-northeast of Guam
- Moving northwest at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 40 miles
- Expected to turn toward west-northwest with a decrease in forward speed over the next few days
- · Could become a typhoon in the next 48 hours
- Tropical storm force winds extend outward up to 90 miles to the north and up to 65 miles to the south



National Weather Forecast









Precipitation / Excessive Rainfall Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook





- FCO is Constance C. Johnson-Cage








