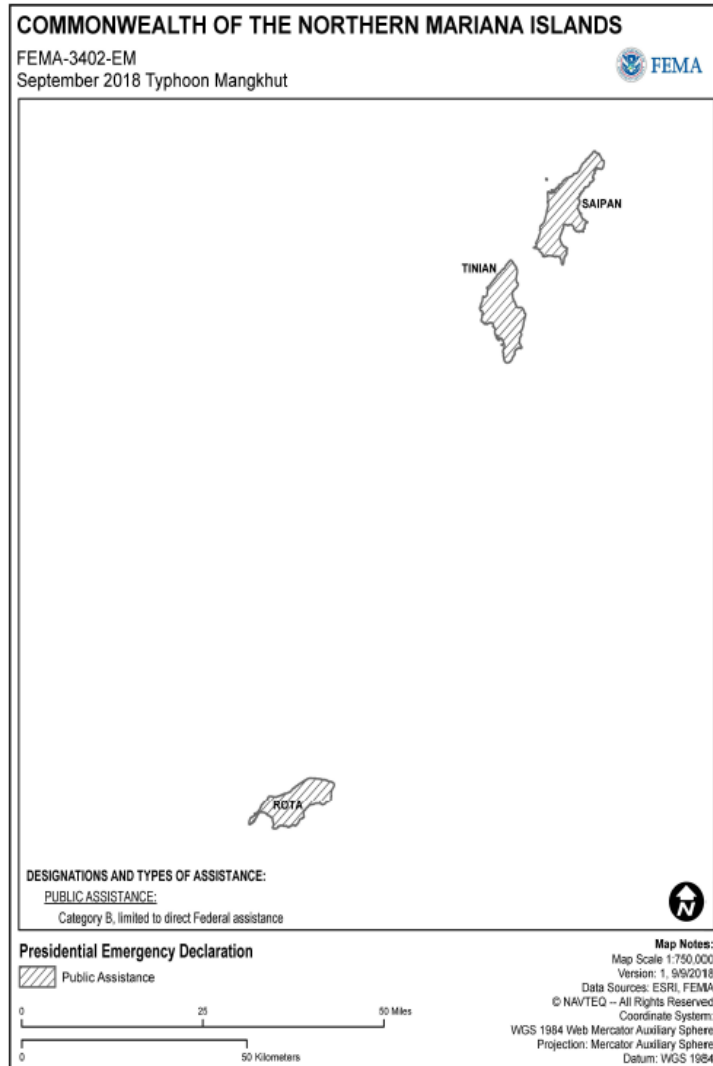

**7. Declaration Information:** Incident Period: September 16-18, 2018.  
On Monday, September 10, 2018 Typhoon Mangkhut made landfall in the Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas Islands as a category three typhoon. The eye of the storm went over the island of Rota, creating significant impacts. In addition, the typhoon caused damage to the power system on the islands of Saipan and Tinian. This impacted power to critical infrastructure facilities such as airports, roads, ports and medical facilities. Large amounts of debris made emergency routes impassable, making it difficult to reach additional areas that required route clearance.
