A cold front will move into the state on Tuesday, but only a few isolated showers will be possible during its passage. Mainly dry conditions are expected to continue under mostly sunny skies and light north winds. Temperatures on Wednesday will be about 10 degrees cooler than Tuesday, but no freezing temperatures are anticipated.

7. General/Safety Message

With the impending chances of severe weather impacting the area we wanted to remind staff of precautions to take. It the event of severe weather the National Weather Service will broad cast emergency information over 1610 am on your radio dial.

Severe Weather Procedures

Tornado Watch: Tornadoes are likely to occur in the watch area. Be ready to act quickly and take shelter, and check supply kits. Monitor radio and television stations for more information.

Tornado Warning: Imminent threat – A tornado has been sighted in the area or has been indicated by radar. Take shelter immediately.

The following is a summary of typical tornadoes:

- They may strike quickly, with little or no warning.
- •They may appear nearly transparent until dust and debris are picked up or a cloud forms in the funnel.
- •The average tornado moves Southwest to Northeast in the U.S., but tornadoes have been known to move in any direction.
- •The average forward speed of a tornado is 30 miles per hour (48 km/h), but has varied from stationary to 70 mph (110 km/h).
- •Tornadoes can also accompany tropical storms and hurricanes as they move onto land.

Steps to take:

- •Be alert to the changing weather conditions.
- Listen to NOAA Weather, or to local commercial radio or television newscasts for the latest information.
- Watch various common danger signs, including:
- dark, often greenish-colored sky;
- large hail stones;
- a large, dark, low-lying cloud (particularly if rotating);
- loud roar of wind, sounding similar to a freight train.

Upon seeing an approaching storm or noticing any of the danger signs, they were advised to prepare to take shelter immediately, such as moving to a safe room, internal stairway, or other safe-haven area.

MESSAGE:

NO PLACE outside is safe when thunderstorms are in the area!!

If you hear thunder, lightning is close enough to strike you.

When you hear thunder, immediately move to safe shelter: a substantial building with electricity or plumbing or an enclosed, metal-topped vehicle with windows up.

Stay in safe shelter at least 30 minutes after you hear the last sound of thunder.

Indoor Lightning Safety

Stay off corded phones, computers and other electrical equipment that put you in direct contact with electricity.

Avoid plumbing, including sinks, baths and faucets.

Stay away from windows and doors and stay off porches.

Do not lie on concrete floors, and do not lean against concrete walls.

Last Resort Outdoor Risk Reduction Tips

If you are caught outside with no safe shelter anywhere nearby the following actions may reduce your risk:

Immediately get off elevated areas such as hills, mountain ridges or peaks

Never lie flat on the ground

Never shelter under an isolated tree

Never use a cliff or rocky overhang for shelter

Immediately get out and away from ponds, lakes and other bodies of water

Stay away from objects that conduct electricity (barbed wire fences, power lines, windmills, etc.)

Personal Safety in cars: Reported incidents and related injuries make it clear that a person inside a fully enclosed metal vehicle must not be touching metallic objects referenced to the outside of the car. Door and window handles, radio dials, CB microphones, gearshifts, steering wheels, and other inside-to-outside metal objects should be left alone during close-in lightning events. We suggest pulling off to the side of the road in a safe manner, turning on the emergency blinkers, turning off the engine, putting one's hands in one's lap, and waiting out the storm.
