




#### Tropical Cyclones

### **Situation:**

## Western Pacific

Typhoon Wutip (Advisory #12 as of 10:00 p.m. EST)

- 365 miles SSE of Guam; moving WNW at 14 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 110 mph
- Typhoon force winds extend outward to 50 miles
- Tropical storm force winds extend outward to 185 miles
- Expected to be a Category 3 typhoon by Saturday into Sunday ChST, 143 miles southwest of Guam
- Tropical Storm Warning/Flash Flood Watch in effect for Guam
- Tropical Storm Warning/Watch in effect for Rota, Tinian and Saipan



### **Impacts:**

- Current forecast indicates 3-6 inches of rain by Sunday afternoon (ChST)
- Flash Flood Watch is effect through early Monday morning

#### Lifelines:

- Food, Water, Sheltering
  - O Guam Department of Education (DOE) is opening 5 shelters (FEMA RIX SPOTREP)
- Transportation
  - o Port Condition Yankee (open with restrictions) has been set for Guam and Rota (USCG)
  - o Port Condition X-Ray has been set for Saipan and Tinian (USCG)
- Safety and Security
  - o Guam military bases are at Condition of Readiness (COR-2)


#### State/Local Response


- GUAM EOC is at Full Activation; Government of Guam is at Condition of Readiness (COR)
- CNMI is at Condition of Readiness (COR-3) (CNMI EMA)

#### **FEMA/Federal Response:**

- FEMA Region VI IMAT-1 deploying to Guam
- FEMA Region IX IMAT-2 deployed to Saipan; will flex a portion of the team to Guam
- FEMA HQ deploying 6 Logistics specialists to Guam
- MERS detachment for communications support
- All teams are expected to be in place Friday evening (ChST) / Friday morning (EST)
- FEMA Region IX and the NWC remain at Steady State and continue to monitor

- Winter Storm Warnings in effect throughout the Southwest and Central Great Basin. Through Saturday evening, forecast snowfall accumulations for portion of central Kansas into central Nebraska will range from 4-8 inches
- Heavy snow is forecast in Southwest region, total snow accumulations of 4-8 inches is expected. Traveling will be difficult with very low visibility are likely with blowing snow
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible from east TX to GA over the next 2 days; additional rainfall of 3-5 inches is expected through Saturday evening. Some of these locations are already flooded, so additional heavy rain may lead to significant flooding
- Flash Flood Watches and Warnings in effect for portions of the Lower Mississippi, Tennessee and Ohio Valleys to the Appalachians
